Any violation or breach or attempted violation or breach of the provisions of this paragraph by Buyer, or any acis inconsistent herewith, shall yes no right, title or interest herein or hereunder, or in the said premises in any such transferee, pledgee, assignee, lessee or sub-lesses, but Seller may, at Seller's option, declare this Agreement roll and void and invoke the provisions of this Agreement relating to Jorleiture hereof.

28. FINAL CLOSING: Buyer shall be entitled to delivery of the Deed of conveyance aloresaid Altidavit of Title and a titll of Sale to the personal property to be transferred to Buyer under this Agreement at any time upon payment of all amounts due betstinder in the form of cash or cashier's or certified check made payable to Seller, which amount shall be without premium or penalty. At the time fluyer provides notice to Seller that he is prepared to prepay all amounts due hereunder, Seller forthwith either shall produce and record at his expense a release deed for the prior mortgage, or obtain a currently dated loan repayment letter reflecting the amount necessary to discharge and release the prior mortgage. Seller shall have the right to repay and discharge such prior mortgage in whole or in part from sums due hereunder from Buyer. The repayment of the prior mortgage shall be supervised and administered by Buyer's mortgage lender, if any. Upon repayment of the prior mortgage Seller shall receive the cancelled note and a release deed in form satisfactory for recording if any. Upon repayment of the prior mortgage belief shall receive the cancelled note and a release deed in turn satisfactory for recording such which, shall be delivered to Buyer. Seller shall give Buyer a credit against the balance of the purchase price for the cost of recording such release. In the event Buyer does not have a mortgage lender, then the delivery of the cancelled note to Seller shall be simultaneous with the delivery of the Deed from Seller to Buyer, and to facilitate the delivery of documents and the payment of the prior mortgage and the balance of the amount due hereunder, the parties agree to complete such exchange at the offices of the holder of the note secured by the prior mortgage. At the time of delivery of the Deed, Buyer and Seller shall execute and furnish such real estate transfer declarations as may be required to comply with State, County or local law. Seller shall pay the amount of any stamp tax then imposed by State or County faw on the transfer of title to Buyer, and Buyer shall pay any such stamp rax and meet other requirements as then may be established by any local ordinance with regard to the transfer of title to Buyer unless otherwise provided in the local ordinance.

29. TITLE IN TRUST:

(a) In the event that title to the premises is held in or conveyed into a trust prior to the initial closing, it shall be conveyed to Buyer when and if appropriate under the terms of this Agreement in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2, except that the conveyance shall be by Trustee's Deed. In such case, the names and addresses of each and every beneficiary of and person with a power to direct the Title Holder is attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein as Exhibit A.

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(b) The beneficiary or beneficiaries of and the person or persons with the power to three the Trustee shall cumulatively be deemed to jointly and severally have all of the rights, benefits, obligations and dunes by the Selfer to be enjoyed or performed hereinider and such person or persons with the power to direct the Trustee jointly and severally agree to direct the Trustee to perform such obligations and duties as such persons or the beneficiaries may not under the terms of the Trust Agreement do or perform shinnselves directly.

(c) If, at the time of execution of this Agreement, title to the premises is not held in a trust, bellier agrees that upon the written request of the Buyer any time prior to the linal closing, Seller shall convey title into a trust and comply with subparagraphs (a) and (b) of this paragraph 29 with Buyer paying all trust lees and recording cost resulting thereby.

- 30, RECORDING: The parties shall record this Agreement or a memorandum thereof at Buyer's expense.
- 31, RIDERS; The provision contained in any rider attached hereto are and for all purposes shall be deemed to be part of this Agreement as though herein fully set forth.
- 32. CAPTIONS AND FRONOUNS: The captions and headings of the various sections or paragraphs of this Agreement are for convenience only, and are not to be construed as confining or limiting in any way the scape or intent of the provisions hereof. Whenever the context requires or permits, the singular shall include the plural, the plural shall include the singular and the masculine, feminine and neuter shall be treely interchangeable.
- 33. PROVISIONS SEVERABLE: The unenforceability or invalidity of any provision or provisions hereof shall not render any other provisions or provisions herein contained unenforceable or invalid.
- 34, BINDING ON HEIRS, TIME OF ESSENCE: This Agreement shall stigle to the benefit of and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the Seller and Buyer. Time is of the essence in this Agreement.
- 35, JOINT AND SEVERAL OBLIGATIONS: The obligations of two or more persons designated "Sellier" or "Buyer" in this Agreement shall be joint and several, and in such case each hereby authorizes the other or others of the same designation as his or her attorney-in-fact to do or perform any act or agreement with respect to this Agreement or the premises.
