Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tex neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable pensity, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto; shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whisther real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is apecifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of auch inability) is satisfied or becomes unaniforceable by reason of tapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The lien imposed by Sector 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holdered of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment light reditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(p) Refilling Of Notice.—For purposes of this section:

(1) General Rule, —Unless notice of lian is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of lian shall be treated as fitted on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such refilling period.

(2) Place For Filing.—A notice of tien refited during the required refiting period shall be effective only-

(A) II-

(I) such notice of lien is refilled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, and the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the data of a refiling of notice of tien under subpartigraph (A), the Becretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations leaved by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if an accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refilling Period.—In the case of any notice of tien, the term "required refling period" nearest

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the axpiration of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the lax, and

(B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 10 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lieff, — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall leave a certificate of release of any iten imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which:

(1) Liability Satisfiec or Unerforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or

has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is lumished to the Setre ary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon it a payment of the amount assessed, together with all inserest in new set b seed, within the time prescribed by law (including any stane) in of such time), and that is in accordance with such require serin relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and survives thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien, it is notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 8323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such item may be disclosed to any person who furnishes assisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
