Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person hable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount findfuding any interest additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty logather with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto; shall be a iten in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether rest or personal, belonging to

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 8321 shall erise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the taypayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And

Judgment Lien Creditors. - The Hen Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, helder of a security interest, mechanic's flenor, or judge mention creditor until notice thereof which means the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or par nen hip shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal of mative office of the business is located, and the tasidence of a tangeyer whose residence is without the United States shall brid lamed to be in the District of Columbia

(3) Form . The Issue and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shift be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be vaild not lithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

(A) the one-year period anding 30 days after the expiration of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and

(B) the one-year pariod anding with the expulsion of 10 years after the close of the preceding required refiting period for such notice of tien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day
