

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321, Lien For Taxes

If any person habis to pay any tax neglects of refuses to bay the same after demand, the amount (locluding any interest additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to Buch person

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the ken imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the masses-ment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the texpayer analog out of such lisbility) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapes of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judge ment tian anaditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filled by the Secretary

(1] Place For Filing - The notice reterred to in aubsection (1) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws

(ii) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to

the lien is aitutated, and

(iii) Personal Property-in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the ilen is situated, except that State law merely conforming to reenacting Federal law establishing a national filing system dose not constitute a second office for filing as designated by the laws of such State; or (B) With Clerk Of District Countin the office of the

clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district In which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the

State has not by taw designated one office which meets the requirements of subparentaph (#), or (C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The firm and content of the notice reterred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwill starding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

(1) General Rule.—Unless notice of lier is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (i) after the expiration of such refiling period.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall leaus a cartificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day

(to Disclosure of Certain Returns) and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.-

(2) Diactosure of amount of outstanding lien, if a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such tien or intends to obtain a right in such property,
