

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto, shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the tion imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assess-ment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount to assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. --- The tlen Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as equinst any purchasor, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of aubanction (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

() Place For Filing Notice; Form.--

(1) Place For Filing . The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be flied-(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situtated; and

(III) Personal Property-In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; except that State law merely conforming to reenacting Federal law establishing a national filing aystem does not constitute a second office for filing as designated by the laws of such State; or (B) With Clerk Of District Court-in the office of the

clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district In which the property subject to ilen is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the

requirements of subparagraph (A), or (C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columble - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lion . For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be altusted-(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its physical location; or

10 Personal Property in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayor at the timy the rotice of lien is filed.

Fo. ourposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partrurship shall be desmod to be the place at which the principal Car surve office of the Suriness is located, and the residence of a fuxrayer whose residence is without the United States shall be cer med to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be p ascribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid no. withstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or context of a notice of flen.

(v) Refiling Of Notice.—For purposes of this

(1) General Rule .- Unless notice of tien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required retiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with aubsection (f) after the expiration of such refiling period.

(2) Place For Filing.—A natice of then retiled during the required reliting period shall be affective only-

(A) II-

(i) such notice of lien is relied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(II) In the case of real property, and the fact of refiting is aniered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparacraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner, prescribed in regulations leaved by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, it a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is

(3) Required Refiling Period.—In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required rafiling period"

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the iax, and

(B) the one-year period ending with the expiration, of to years after the close of the preceding required Milling period for such notice of iten.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such requ-Island as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall leave a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, togethor with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unanforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Socrotery and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest its respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any oriensics of such time), and that is in accordance with such a quir ments relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and all edies thereon, as may be specified by such requistions.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien,-if a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation ascured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property,
