

SATISFACTION OF REAL ESTATE MORTGAGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

The Director of the Office of Thrift Supervision issued Order number(s) 90-7 dated January 3, 1990, placing Midwest Federal Savings Bank in receivership and appointing the Resolution Trust Corporation as Receiver of Midwest Federal Savings Bank pursuant to subdivision (F) of Section 5(d) of the Home Owners' Loan Act, as amended.

The Director of the Office of Thrift Supervision, by Order number(s) 90-8 and 90-9 dated January 3, 1990, incorporated a new federal savings association, Midwest Federal Savings Bank of Minot, and issued its charter appointing the Resolution Trust Corporation as Conservator for Midwest Federal Savings Bank of Minot, to have "all the powers of a conservator or receiver, as appropriate, granted under the Federal Deposit Insurance Act."

Certain assets of Midwest Federal Savings Bank, including the asset which is the subject of this document, have been transferred from Midwest Federal Savings Bank to Midwest Federal Savings Bank of Minot; and, for the purposes of confirming said transfer, Midwest Federal Savings Bank does hereby grant, sell, assign, transfer, set over and convey to Midwest Federal Savings Bank of Minot, its successors and assigns, without recourse or warranty, any interest Midwest Federal Savings Bank may have in the security document which is the subject of this document, together with the note, debt and claim secured by such security document and the covenants contained in such security document.

The Director of the Office of Thrift Supervision issued Order number(s) 90-1754 dated September 21, 1990, placing Midwest Federal Savings Bank of Minot in receivership and replacing the Conservator of Midwest Federal Savings Bank of Minot with the Resolution Trust Corporation as Receiver of Midwest Federal Savings Bank of Minot pursuant to subdivision (F) of Section 5(d) of the Home Owners' Loan Act, as amended.

RESOLUTION TRUST CORPORATION, in its capacity as Receiver of Midwest Federal Savings Bank of Minot, having a mailing address of 4900 Main Street, Suite 200, P.O. Box 419570, Kansas City, Mo. 64141, is the owner and holder of a certain Mortgage, dated October 31, 1986, executed by Henri Brice & Mildred Sykes a/k/a Mildred Brice, as Mortgagor, in favor of THE DARTMOUTH PLAN, INC., as Mortgagee, recorded February 9, 1987 under Document Number 87078583, of the Public Records of COOK County, Illinois.
