93674052 22. RIGHTS OF LENDER ON DEFAULT. If there is a default under this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to exercise one or more of the following remedies without notice or demand (except as required by law):

(a) to terminate or suspend further advances or reduce the credit limit under the promissory notes or agreements evidencing the obligations;
 (b) to declare the Obligations immediately due and payable in full;
 (c) to collect the outstanding Obligations with or without resorting to judicial process;

(d) to require Grantor to deliver and make available to Lender any personal property constituting the Property at a place reasonably convenient to Grantor and Lender;

(e) to collect all of the rents, issues, and profits from the Property from the date of default and thereafter;
(f) to apply for and obtain the appointment of a receiver for the Property without regard to Grantor's financial condition or solvency, the adequacy of the Property to secure the payment or performance of the Obligations, or the existence of any waste to the Property;
