1. Payment of Principal and Liter's: Prefayment and Late Charges. Borrower shall promptly not when due the principal of and interest on the debt evidenced by the Note and any preparant and late charges due under the Lote.

2. Funds for Taxes and Insurance. Supplicable law or to a written waiver by Lender, Borrower shall pay to Lender, on the day
