Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 8021 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the texpayor stising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The flon imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, machanic's lienor, or judgment lien craditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

O Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in sub--bell ad lishs (a) nolices

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situtated; and

(ii) Personal Property-in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental aubdivision), se designated by the fawe of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; except that State law merely conforming to

(3) Form - he form and content of the notice referred to

in subsection (a) shall be trescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid a midital anding any other provision of law regarding the form or contrat of a notice of lian.

(g) Refilling Of Notice.—For purposes of this

(1) General Rule, -- Unless notice of tien is relied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such retiling period.

(3) Required Refilling Period.—in the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refilling period"

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and

(B) the one-year patiod ending with the expiration of 10 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of lien

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property,

(a) Release Of Lien .- Subject to such requtations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall isous a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the fiability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thursel, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is lumished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest n respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any stendor of such time), and that is in accordance with suci raqui ements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the born and autebos thereon, as may be epecified by such regulation.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return information.

No Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.-

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding flen, if a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 5323(f), the amount of the putstanding obligation secured by such tien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes estistactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
