AN ORDINANCE

1993-35

ANNEXING PROPERTY GENERALLY LOCATED AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF BALLARD AND GREENWOOD AVENUE

WHEREAS, the Village of Niles did, by Ordinance No. 1993-27 express a desire to annex the property generally located at the Northwest corner of Ballard Road and Greenwood Avenue, as legally described in said Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Niles did cause a Petition to be filed in the Circuit Court of Cook County, Clerk's Cause No. 93 CO 00317, for a hearing to be held on the annexation of said territory to the Village of Niles; and

WHEREE, a hearing was held on August 24, 1993 before Her Honor, Judge Dorothy Kirie Kinnaird, who found that the Petition and procedures of the Village of Niles relative to said annexation fully complied with the statutory mandates; and

WHEREAS, Judge Kinnaird ordered that the question of the annexation of the territory to the Village of Niles be referred to the corporate authorities of the Village of Niles for final action; and 95740020

whereas, the President and Poard of Trustees of the Village of Niles find and believe it to be in the best interests of the said Village of Niles that said land and territory be annexed thereto.


