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AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING VILLAGE OF ELMWOOD PARK SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NUMBER SEVEN

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Elmwood Park, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. Authority.

Special Service Area Number Seven is established pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Sections 6A and 6L of the Constitution of the State of Illinois and pursuant to the "Special Service Area Tax Act", 35 ILCS 235/1 et seq.

Section 2. Findings.

A. The question of the establishment of the area hereinafter described as a special service area is considered by the Village Board pursuant to an Ordinance entitled: "An Ordinance Proposing the Establishment of Special Area Number Seven for Alley Improvements in the Village of Elmwood Park and Providing for a Public Hearing and Other procedures in Connection Therewith" adopted June 30, 1993, and is considered pursuant to a hearing held on July 22, 1993, by the Village Board pursuant to Notice duly published in the Elm Leaves, a newspaper published in the Village of Elmwood Park, at least fifteen (15) days prior to the hearing and pursuant to Notice by mail addressed to the person or persons in whose name the general taxes for the last preceding year were paid on each lot, block, tract or parcel of land lying within the special service area. Said Notice was given by depositing said Notice in the United States mails not less than ten (10) days prior to the time set for the public hearing. In the event taxes for the

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last preceding year were not paid, the said Notice was sent to the person last listed on the tax rolls prior to that year as the owner of said property. A Certificate of Publication of said Notice and an Affidavit of Mailing of said Notice are attached to this Ordinance as Exhibits 1 and 2. Said Notices conformed in all respects to the requirements of 35 ILCS, Section 235/1 of the aforesaid Act.

B. That a public hearing on the question set forth in the Notice was held on July 22, 1993. All interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard on the question of the creation of the special service area, the nature of the alley improvement project, the cost of construction of the project, and the levy of a direct annual tax to finance the construction of the project.

C. That after considering the data, as presented at the public hearing, the Board of Trustees finds that it is in the public interest and in the interest of the village of Elmwood Park Special Service Area Number Seven that said special service area, as hereinafter described, be established.

D. Said area is compact and contiguous and will be enhanced by the alley improvements in the project.

E. It is in the best interests of said special service area that the furnishing of the municipal services proposed herein be considered for the common interests and the safety and welfare of the residents.

F. Said area is zoned for residential purposes and will benefit specially from municipal services proposed to be provided. The proposed municipal services are unique and in addition to the

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municipal services provided to the Village of Elmwood Park as a whole.

Section 3. Village of Elmwood Park Special Service Area Number Seven Established.

A special service area to be known and designated as "Village of Elmwood Park Special Service Area Number Seven" is hereby established and shall consist of the following described territory:

Lots 1 thru 4, inclusive, and Lots 7 thru 10, inclusive, in Block 8 of Mills and Sons Greenfields Subdivision of the East 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4, also the South 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4, also the South 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 36, Township 40 North, Range 12 East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois.

Any existing alley lying within or contiguous to the above described properties.

An accurate map of said district is attached hereto as Exhibit 3.

Section 4. Purpose of Area.

Village of Elmwood Park Special Service Area Number Seven is established to provide special municipal services to said area in addition to services provided to the Village generally. Specifically, the special services shall consist of alley reconstruction, repaving and other alley improvements in the area. In addition, annual taxes may be levied to finance the cost of construction of said alley improvements and to pay the interest incurred in borrowing funds related to financing such costs of construction.

Section 5. Tax Levy.

There is hereby authorized, and there shall also be imposed,

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a special tax, at an annual rate not to exceed thirty-three hundredths (.33%) per cent of the assessed value, as equalized, said tax to be levied annually for a maximum of five (5) years. Said taxes shall be levied upon all taxable real property within said special service area, and said taxes are in addition to the annual real estate tax and all other taxes provided by law, and shall be levied pursuant to the provisions of the Revenue Act of 1939.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law, providing no petition is filed opposing the creation of the special service area pursuant to 35 ILCS 235/9.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 22nd day of July, at 7:30 P.M. in the Civic Center, 2 Conitl Parkway, Elmwood Park, Illinois, a hearing will be held by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Elmwood Park to consider forming a special service area consisting of the territory generally described as:

The area bounded by 78th Avenue, Dickans Avenue, 77th Court and the east west alley which lies south of and parallel to Armistage Avenue, in Elmwood Park, Illinois.

The legal description of the boundaries of said area is contained in Exhibit "A" attached hereto. An accurate map of said territory is on file in the office of the Village Clerk and available for public inspection.

All interested persons, including all persons owning taxable real property located within Special Service Area No. 7, will be given an opportunity to be heard regarding the formation of and the boundaries of the special service area and may object to the formation of the area, and the levy of taxes affecting said area.

The purpose of the formation of Elmwood Park Special Service Area Number 7 is generally to provide special municipal services to the area which will benefit the area, specifically the construction of improved alleys in this area and the costs of financing such improvements.

A special tax, in addition to the tax to retire general obligation bonds, will be considered at the public hearing to be levied for a period not to exceed five (5) years and not to exceed an amount of thirty-three hundredths (33%) percent per annum of assessed value, as equalized, to be levied against the real property included in the special service area.

At the hearing, all interested person affected by the formation of such special service area, including all persons owning taxable real estate therein, will be given an opportunity to be heard. The hearing may be adjourned by the Board to another date without further notice other than a motion to be entered upon the minutes of its meeting fixing the time and place of its adjournment.

If a petition signed by at least 51% of the electors residing within the special service area and by at least 51% of the owners of record of the land included within the boundaries of the special service area is filed with the municipal clerk within 60 days following the final adjournment of the public hearing objecting to the creation of the special service district, the enforcement thereof, the levy or imposition of a tax or to a proposed increase in the tax rate on such special service district as proposed may be created or enlarged, or tax may be levied or imposed nor the rate increased except as otherwise permitted by law.

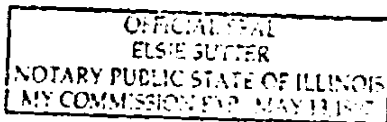

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

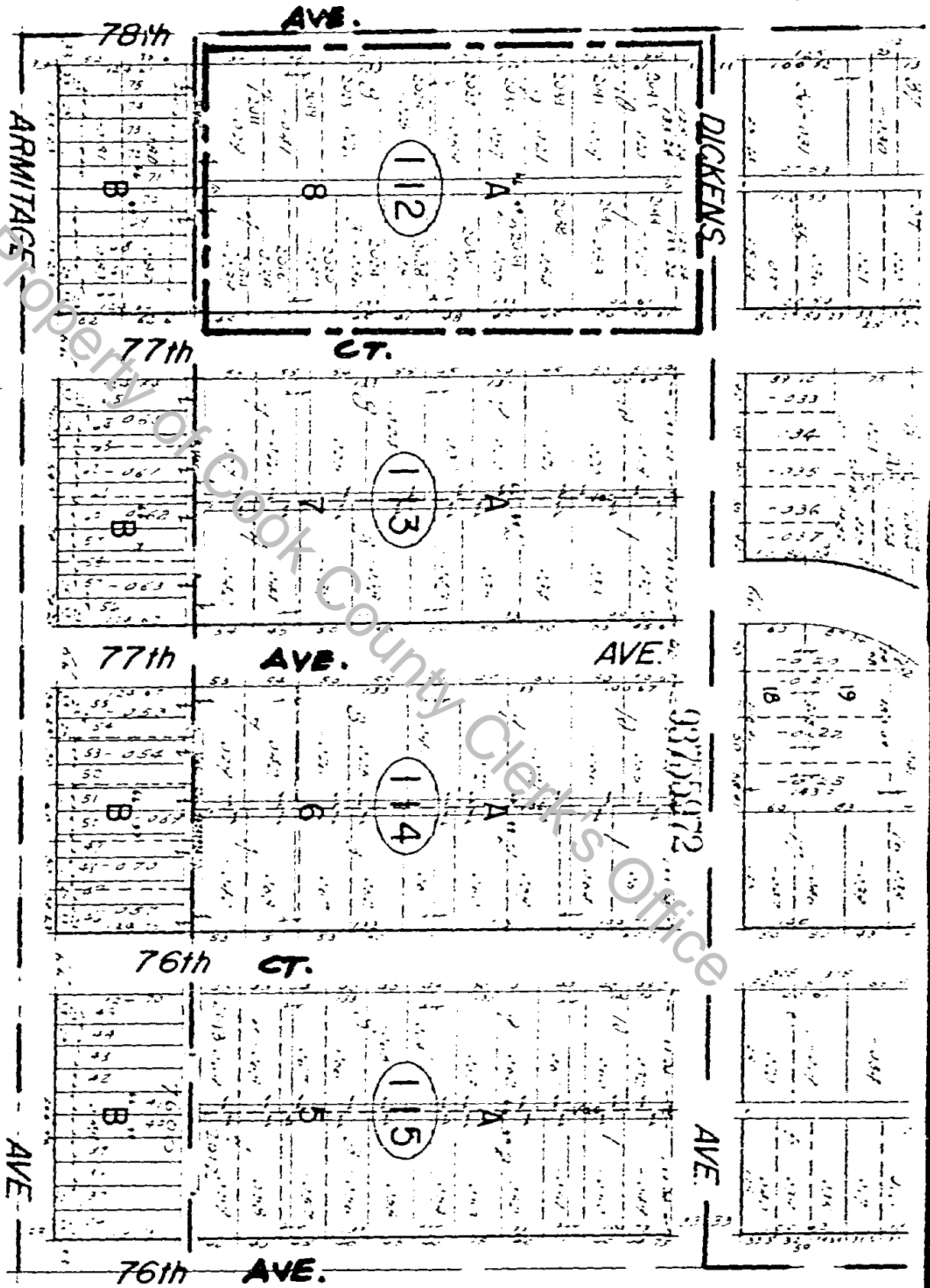
