#### SUBORDINATION AGREEMENT

THIS SUBORDINATION AGREEMENT, made in the City of Chicago, State of Illinois this 23rd day of September, 1993 by The First National Bank of Chicago, a national banking association organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the United States of America, and doing business and having its principal office in the City of Chicago, County of Cook, and State of Illinois ("Bank").

WHEREAS, The First National Bank of Chicago, its successors &/or assigns ("Mortgagee") has refused to make a loan to the Borrowers of \$ 350,000.00, except upon condition that the Mortgage be subordinate to said mortgage lien of Mortgagee.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars in hand paid by each of the parties hereto to the other, and of other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged and in order to induce Mortgagee to make the loan to Borrowers, it is hereby mutually agreed, as follows:

- I. That the Bank covenants and consents that the lien of its Mortgage shall be subject and subordinate to the lien of Mortgagee's mortgage dated 921-93 as doc 33794379 reflecting and securing the loan made by Mortgagee to Borrowers, in the amount of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand and no/100 Dollars, and to all renewals, extensions or replacements of said mortgage; and
- II. That this Agreement shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.
