MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE IS DATED OCTOBER 4, 1993, between GUADALUPE RIVERA and AVELINA M RIVERA, AS JOINT TENANTS, whose socress is 1319 PARK AVE, CHICAGO HEIGHTS, IL 60411 (referred to below as "Grantor"); and FIRST NATIONAL PLAZA, CHICAGO HEIGHTS, IL 60411 (referred to below as "Lender").

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For valuable consideration, Grantor mortgages, warrants, and conveys to Lander all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following described real property, toget at with all existing or subsequently erected or affixed buildings, improvements and fixtures; all essements, rights of way, and apputenances; all witer, water rights, watercourses and ditch rights (including stock in utilities with ditch or imigation rights); and all other rights, royalties, and profits relating to the real property, including without limitation all minerals, bit, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in COOK County, State of Illinoic (the "Real Property"):

Grantor presently assigns to Lender all of Grantor's right, the, and interest in any will leases of the Property and all Rents from the Property. In addition, Grantor grants to Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in the Personal Property and Rents.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Miringa; a. Terms not otherwise defined in this Morigage shall the meanings attributed to such terms in the Uniform Commercial Code. All references to driver amounts shall mean amounts in lawful money of the Unifed States of America.

Gradit Agreement. The words "Credit Agreement" mean the revolving line of credit agreement dated October 4, 1993, between Lender and Grantor With a credit limit of \$30,000,00, together with all renowals of, extensions of, modifications of, refinancings of, consolidations of, and substitutions for the Credit Agreement. The maturity date of this Mongage is October 4, 1996. The interest rate under the revolving line of credit is a variable interest rate based upon an index. The index currently is 8,000% per annum. The littlest rate to be applied to the outstanding account balance shall be at a rate 3,000 percentage points above the index, subject however to the following minimum and maximum rates. Under no circumstances shall the interest rate be less than 8,500% per annum or more than the lesser of \$1,000 per annum or the maximum rate allowed by applicable law.

Grantor, The word "Grantor" means GUADALUPE RIVERA and AVELINA M RIVERA. The Grantor is the mortgager and for this Mortgage.

Quarantor. The word "Guarantor" means and includes without limitation, each and all of the guarantors, sureties, and commodation parties in connection with the indebtedness.

improvements. The word "improvements" means and includes without limitation all existing and future improvements, fixtures, buildings, structures, mobile homes affixed on the Real Property, facilities, additions and other construction on the Real Property.

Indebtedress. The word "Indebtedress" means all principal and interest payable under the Credit Agreement and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Lender to entorce obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Mortgage. Specifically, without limitation, this Mortgage accures a revolving line of credit and shall secure not only the amount which Lender has presently advanced to Grantor under the Credit Agreement, but also any future amounts which Lender may advance to Grantor under the Credit Agreement within twenty (20) years from the date of this Mortgage to the same extent as it such future advance were made as of the date of the execution of this Mortgage. Such advances may be made, repaid, and remade from time to time, subject to the limitation that the total outstanding balance owing at any one time, not including finance charges on such balance at a fixed or variable rate or sum as provided in the Credit Agreement, any temporary overages, other charges, and any amounts expended or advanced as provided in this peragraph, shall not acceed the Credit Limit as provided in the Credit Agreement. PAYMENT AND PERFORMATURE Except as otherwise provided in this Mortgage, Grantor shall pay to Lander all amounts secured by this Mortgage as they become due, and shall across perform all of Grantor's obligations under this Mortgage.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Use. Until in default, Grentor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Rents from the Property.

Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in tenantable condition and promptly perform all repairs, replacements, and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Hazardous Substances. The terms "hazardous wrists" "hazardous aubstance," "disposal," "release," and "threatened release," as used in this Mortgage, shall have the same meanings as set forth at the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1990, as emended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9501, et eeq. (*CERCLA), or Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986, Pub. L. No. 99-400 ("SARA"), the Hazardous Majerials Transportation Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 1801, et seq., the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 6001, et seq., or other applicable state or Federal law, rube, or regulations adopted pursuant to any of the foregoing. The terms "hazardous waste" and "hazardous substance" shall also include, without limitation, petroleum and petroleum by-products or any fraction thereof and asbestos. Grantor represents and warrants to Lender that: (a) During the period of Grantor's ownership of the Property, there has been no use, generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or trivialened release of any hazardous waste or substance by any person on. under, or about the Property; (b) Grantor has no knowledge of, or reason, by believe that there has been, except as previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing. (I) any use, generation, manufacture, policies, treatment, disposal, release, or threatened release of any hazardous waste or substance by any prior owners or occupants of the Property of (iii) any actual or threatened litigation or claims of any kind by any person relating to such matters; and (c) Except as previously disclosed to any acknowledged by Lender in writing. (i) heither Grantor nor any tenant, contractor, agent or other authorized user of the Property shall use, generale, manufacture, store, treat, dispose of, or release any hazardous waste or substance on, under, or about the Property and (ii) any such actuity shall be conducted in compliance with all applicable lederal, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances, including without limitation those in a regulatione, and ordinances described above. The provisions of this section of the Mortgage, including the obligation to indemnity, shall survive the payment of the indebtedness and the satisfaction and reconveyance of the lies of th not be affected by Lender's acquisition of any interest in the Property, whether by foreclosure or otherwise.

Nulsance, Waste. Grantor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nulsance nor commit, permit, or suffer any stripping of or waste on or to the Property or any portion of the Property. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other party the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior written consent of Lander.

Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any Improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Lender. As a condition to the removal of any Improvements, Lender may require Grantor to make arrangements satisfactory to Lender to replace such Improvements with Improvements of at least equal value.

Lander's Right to Enter. Lender and its agents and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all reasonable times to attend to Lender's interests and to inspect the Property for purposes of Grantor's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Mortgage.

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all lews, ordinances, and regulations, now or herselfer in effect, of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good latth any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long as, in Lender's sole opinion, Lender's interests in the Property are not jeopardized. Lender may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surety bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lender, to protect Lender's interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor agrees neither to abandon not leave unattended the Property. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to these acts set forth above in this section, which from the character and use of the Property are reasonably recessary to protect and preserve the Property.

DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at its option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Mortgage upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of Real Property or any right, title or interest therein; whether legal or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract to check, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-colors contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any lend trust holding title to the fine fine.

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other method of conveyance of Real Property interest. If any Grantor is a corporation or partnership, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the voting stock or partnership interests, as the case may be, of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender II such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by Illinois law.

TAXES AND LIERS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and liens on the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

Right To Contest. Granter may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lander's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lien arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Granter shall within fitteen (15) days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filed, within fitteen (15) days after Granter has notice of the filing, secure the discharge of the lien, or if requested by Lander, deposit with Lander cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lander in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs and attorneys' fees or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien. In any contest, Granter shall defend itself and Lander and shall satisfy any adverse judgment before enforcement against the Property. Granter shall name Lander as anyedditional obliges under any surety bond furnished in the contest proceedings.

Evidence of Psymbols. Grantor shall upon demand turnish to Lander satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lander at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lender at least fifteen (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the [50] enty, if any mechanic's lien, materials are supplied to the [50] enty, if any mechanic's lien, or other tien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials. Grantor will upon request of Lender furnish to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE, The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Maintenance of insurance. Grantor shall not are and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any colineurance clause, and with a standard mortgar se clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such torm as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender and not containing any discisimer of the insurer's liability for failure to give such notice. Should the Real Property at any time become located in an area designated by the Director of the Federal Emergency Management has as a special flood hazard area, Grantor agrees to obtain and maintain Federal Flood insurance, to the extent such insurance is required and is or becomes available, for the term of the loan and for the full unpaid principal balance of the loan, or the maximum limit of coverage that is available, whichever is less.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of arm loss or damage to the Property. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor falls to do so within fifteen (15) days of the casuality. Whether or not Lender's security is impaired, Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness, payment of any lien affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the demaged or destroyed improvements in a manner satisfactory to be under. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reint urra Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been discurred within 180 days after their receipt and which Lander has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used first to play any amount owing to Lender under this Mortgage, then to prepay accrued interest, and the remainder, if any, shall be applied to the proceeds after payment in full of the indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor falls to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, or if any action of proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, the any action that Lender expends in so doing will bear interest at the rate charged under the Credit Agreement from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayment by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable of semand. (b) be added to the balance of the credit line and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due draing either. (i) the term of any applicable insurance policy or (ii) the remaining term of the Credit Agreement, or (c) be treated as a balloon payment while will be due and payable at the Credit Agreement's maturity. This Mortgage also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in the paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lander shall not be construed as curing the default so as to ber Lander from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in tee simple, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances other than those set torth in the Real Property description or in any title insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion issued in favor of, and accepted by, Lender in connection with this Mortgage, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever delend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Lander under this Mortgago, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lander shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Lander's own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lander such instruments as Lander may request from time to time to permit such participation.

Compilance With Laws. Grantor warrants that the Property and Grantor's use of the Property compiles with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

CONDEMNATION. The lobowing provisions relating to condemnation of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Application of Net Proceeds. It all or any part of the Property is condemned by eminent domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in lieu of condemnation, Lander may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' tees incurred by Lander in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condomnation is filed, Granter shall promptly holdly Landar to writing, and Granter shall promptly take small

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steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the eward. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions relating to governmental taxes, fees and charges are a part of this Mortgage:

Current Taxes, Fees and Charges. Upon request by Lander, Granior shall execute such documents in addition to this Mortgage and take whatever other action is requested by Lander to perfect and continue Lander's item on the Real Property. Granior shall reimbures Lander for all taxes, as described below, together with all expenses incurred in recording, perfecting or continuing this Mortgage, including without limitation all taxes, fees, documentary stamps, and other charges for recording or registering this Mortgage.

Taxes. The following shall constitute taxes to which this section applies: (a) a specific tax upon this type of Morigage or upon all or any part of the indebtedness secured by this Morigage; (b) a specific tax on Grantor which Grantor is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the indebtedness secured by this type of Morigage; (c) a tax on this type of Morigage chargeable against the Lender or the holder of the Credit Agreement; and (d) a specific tax on all or any portion of the indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made by Grantor.

Subsequent Taxes. If any tax to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, this event shall have the same effect as an Event of Default (as defined below), and Lender may exercise any or all of its available remedies for an Event of Default as provided below unless Granic, either (a) pays the tax before it becomes delinquent, or (b) contests the tax as provided above in the Taxes and Liens section and deposits with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surely bond or other security satisfactory to Lender.

SECURITY AGREEMENT; SPANCING STATEMENTS. The following provisions relating to this Mortgage as a security agreement are a part of this Mortgage.

Security Agreement. This introment shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes follures or other personal property, and Lander shall have ut of the rights of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code as amended from time to time.

Security interest. Upon request by finder, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Lander to perfect and continue Lender's security interest in the Rents and Personal Property. In addition to recording this Mortgage in the real property records, Lender may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, the executed counterparts, copies or reproductions of this Mortgage as a financing statement. Grantor she'll re-imburse Lender for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Person i Property in a manner and at a place reasonably convenient to Grantor and Lender and make it available to Lender within three (3) days after receipt or written demand from Lender.

Addresses. The mailing addresses of Grantor (debtor) and Lander (secured party), from which information concerning the security interest granted by this Mortgage may be obtained (each as required by the Uniform Commercial Code), are as stated on the first page of this Mortgage.

FURTHER ASSURANCES; ATTORNEY-IN-FACT. The following provisions relating to further assurances and attorney-in-fact are a part of this Mortgage.

Further Assurances. At any time, and from time to time, upon request of Lender, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Lender's designee, any when requested by Lender, cause to be filled, recorded, reflect, or rerecorded, as the case may be, at such times and in such officer and process as Lender may deem appropriate, any and all such mortgages, deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, constitution statements, instruments of further assurance, certificates, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Lender, be necessary of delegation in order to effectuate, complete, perfect, continue, or preserve. (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Credit Agreement, this Mortgage, and the Related Documents, and. (b) the liens and security interests created by this Mortgage as first and prior liens on the Property, whether now while it or herselfer acquired by Grantor. Unless prohibited by law or agreed to the contrary by Lender in writing, Grantor shall reimburse Lender of costs and expenses incurred in connection with the matters referred to in this paragraph.

Attorney-in-Fact. If Grantor falls to do any of the things referred to in the preceding paragrap*. Lender may do so for and in the name of Grantor and at Grantor's expense. For such purposes, Grantor hereby irrevocably appoints Lender as Grantor's atterney-in-fact for the purpose of making, executing, delivering, filing, recording, and doing all other things as may be necessary or desirable, in Lender's sole opinion, to accomplish the matters referred to in the preceding paragraph.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all the Indebtedness when due, terminates the credit line account, and othe wide performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Mortgage, Lender shall execute and deliver to Grantor a suitable satisfaction of this Mortgage and suitable statements of termination of any financing statement on file evidencing Lander's accurity interest in the Rents and the Persons Frequency. Grantor will pay, if permitted by applicable law, any reasonable termination (see as determined by Lander from time to time).

DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under the Nortgage: (a) Grantor commits fraud or makes a material misrepresentation at any time in connection with the credit line account. This can include, for example, a false statement about Grantor's income, assets, liabilities, or any other aspects of Grantor's financial condition. (b) Grantor does not meet the repayment terms of the credit line account. (c) Grantor's action or inaction adversely affects the collateral for the credit line account or Landar's rights in the collateral. This can include, for example, failure to maintain required insurance, waste or destructive use of the dwelling, failure to pay taxes, death of all persons liable on the account, transfer of title or sale of the dwelling, creation of a lien on the dwelling without Landar's permission, foreclosure by the holder of another lien, or the use of funds or the dwelling for prohibited purposes.

AIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter, Lender, at its option, may everoles any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by lew:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Lender shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code.

Collect Rents. Lander shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Rents, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Lander's costs, against the Indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Lander may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of rent or use fear directly to Lander. If the Rents are collected by Lander, then Grantor irrevocably designates Lander as Grantor's attorney-in-fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to Lander in response to Lander's demand shall satisfy the obligations for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Lander may exercise its rights under this subparagraph ofther in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Mortgages in Possession. Lander shall have the right to be placed as mortgages in possession or to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding functionals or

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sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the indebtedrass. The mortgages in possession or receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Lender's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apparent value of the Property exceeds the indebtedrass by a substantial amount. Employment by Lender shall not disquality a person from serving as a receiver.

Judicial Foreclosure, Lender may obtain a judicial decrea foreclosing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Property.

Deficiency Judgment. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section.

Other Remedies. Lender shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the Credit Agreement or available at law or in equity.

Sale of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Granior hereby welves any and all right to have the property marshalled. In exercising its rights and remades, Lender shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Lender shall be shifted to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

Notice of Sale. Lander shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private state or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at feast ten (10) days before the time of the sale or disposition.

Waiver; Election of Fiermaties. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to remand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after failure of Grantor to perform a half not affect Lender's right to declare a default and exercise its remedies under this Mortgage.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. It Lond's institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge resonable as attorneys' tees, at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all resonable expenses incurred by Lander that in Lender's opinion are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Inde'se-Iness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the Credit Agreement rate. Expenses covered or this paragraph include, without limitation, however subject to any limits under applicable law, Lender's attorneys' fees and Lender's legal expenses whether or not there is a lawsuit, including attorneys' fees for bankruptcy proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automa is stay or injunction), appeals and any anticipated post-judgment collection services, the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including efforts), surveyors' reports, and appraisal fees, and title insurance, to the extent permitted by applicable law. Granter also will pay any cost costs, in addition to all other sums provided by law.

NOTICES TO GRANTOR AND OTHER PARTIES. Any notice of this Mortgage, including without limitation any notice of default and any notice of sale to Grantor, shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or, if mailed, shall be deemed effective when deposited in the United States mail first class, registered mail, postage prepaid, directed to the addresses shown near the beginning of this Mortgage. Any party may change its address for notices under this Mortgage by giving formal written notice to the other parties, specifying that the purpose of the notice is to change the party's address. All copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any flor which has priority over this Mortgage shall be sent to Lander's address, as shown near the beginning of this Mortgage. For notice purposes, Grantor a greek to keep Lender informed at all times of Grantor's current address.

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS. The following miscellaneous provisions are a part of this Mortgage:

Amendments. This Mortgage, together with any Related Documents, constitutes the online understanding and agreement of the parties as to the matters set forth in this Mortgage. No attention of or amendment to this Mortgage shows be effective unless given in writing and signed by the party or parties sought to be charged or bound by the attention or amendment.

Applicable Law. This Mortgage has been delivered to Lender and accepted by Lender in the State of Illinois. This Mortgage shall be coverned by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.

Caption Headings. Caption headings in this Mortgage are for convenience purposes only and to be used to interpret or define the provisions of this Mortgage.

Merger. There shall be no merger of the interest or estate created by this Mortgage with any other interest or estate in the Property at any time held by or for the benefit of Lender in any capacity, without the written consent of Lender.

Multiple Parties. All obligations of Grantor under this Morigage shall be joint and several, and all references to Cantor shall mean each and every Grantor. This means that each of the persons signing below is responsible for all obligations in this Morigage.

Severability. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provision of this Mortgage to be invalid or unenforces: as to any person or circumstance, such finding shall not render that provision invalid or unenforceable as to any other persons or circumstance. If feasible, any such offending provision shall be deemed to be modified to be within the limits of enforceability or validity; however, if the offending provision cannot be so modified, it shall be stricken and all other provisions of this Mortgage in all other respects shall remain valid and enforceable.

Successors and Assigns. Subject to the limitations stated in this Mortgage on transfer of Grantor's interest, this Mortgage shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns. If ownership of the Property becomes vested in a person other than Grantor, Lender, without notice to Grantor, may deal with Grantor's successors with reference to this Mortgage and the Indebtedness by way of torbearance or extension without releasing Grantor from the obligations of this Mortgage or liability under the Indebtedness.

Time is of the Essence. Time is of the essence in the performance of this Mortgage.

Walver of Homestead Exemption. Grantor hereby releases and walves all rights and benefits of the homestead exemption lews of the State of Illinois as to all Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage.

Walvers and Consents. Lender shall not be deemed to have walved any rights under this Mortgage (or under the Related Documents) unless such walver is in writing and signed by Lender. No delay or omission on the part of Lender in exercising any right shall operate as a walver of such right or any other right. A walver by any party of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a walver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior walver by Lender, nor any course of dealing between Lender and Grantor, shall constitute a walver of any of Lender's rights or any of Grantor's obligations as to any future transactions. Whenever consent by Lender is required in this Mortgage, the granting of such consent by Lender in any instance shall not constitute continuing consent to subsequent instances where such consent is required.
