Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

if any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be alian flavor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien,

Unless another date is specifically fixed by Isw, the Han Imposed by section 0321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the Hability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such (spoility) is satisfied or becomes unantonce—able by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The Len Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, machanic's lienor, or judgment to its creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Sacretary.
