

Excerpts From Internal Nevenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

It any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount fincluding any oterest additional amount, addition to tax, or essesse to penalty fogether with any costs that may accrue in addition thereta) shall be a field in fevor of the United States upon all implesty and rights to property, whether real or personal, belong to such parson.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the sagesament is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such tlability) is satisfied or becomes unenforce-able by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The here imposed by section 8321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lies creditor until notice thereof which masts the require-ments of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

η Place For Filling Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsaction (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws

(f) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the test of such State, in which the property subject to the Hen is situtated; and

(iii) Personal Property-In the case of personal property, whether tengible or intengible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other pareminental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; except that State law merely conforming to reenacting Federal law establishing a national filing system does not constitute a second office for filing e designated by the laws of such State; or

(8) With Clark Of District Court-In the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial utstrict In which the property subject to lian is altuated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the

requirements of aubparagraph (A), or (C) With Recorder Of Diseda Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Doeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the

District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of phs (1) and (4); property shall be d (A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its physical focation; or

(8) Personal Property-In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpeyer at the

time the notice of lien is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the Susiness is located, and the residence of a texpayor whose realdence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice reterred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such incline shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of tear

rige ding the form or content of a notice of flan.

(1) General Rule, --- Unless notice of tien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filled (in apportance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such retiting period.
