6. Occupancy, Preservation, Maintenance and Protection of Property; Borrower's Loan Application; Leaseholds.

Borrower shall occupy, establish, and use the Property as Borrower's principal residence within sixty days after the execution of this Security Instrument and shall continue to occupy the Property as Borrower's principal residence for at least one year after the date of occupanct, unless Lender otherwise agrees in writing, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, or unless extenuating circumstances exist which are beyond Borrower's control. Borrower shall not destroy, damage or impair the Property, allow the Property to deteriorate, or commit wasta on the Property. Borrower shall be in default if any forfeiture action or proceeding, whether civil or criminal, is begun that in Lender's good faith judgement could result in forfeiture of the Property or otherwise materially impair the lien created by this Security Instrument or Lender's security interest. 8. MORTGAGE INSURANCE. Any forbearance by Lender in exercising any right or remedy shall not be a walver of or preclude the exercises of any right or remedy.

12. Successors and Assigns Bound; Joint and Several Liability; Co-signs s. The covenants and agreements of this Security instrument shall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Lender and Borrow v. subject to the provisions of paragraph 17. Borrow er's covenants and agreements shall be joint and several. Any Borrower who co-signs a this Security Instrument but does not execute the Note: (a) is co-signing this Security Instrument only to mortgage, grant and convey that Corrower's interest in the Property under the terms of this Security Instrument; (b) is not personally obligated to pay the sums secured by instrument; and (c) agrees that Lender and any other Borrower may agree to extend, modify, forbear or make any according with regard to the terms of this Security Instrument or the Note without that Borrower's consent.

13. Loan Charges. If the loan secured by this Security Instrument is subject to a law which sets maximum loan charges, and that law is finelity interpreted so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to be collected in connection with the loan exceed the permitted limits, then: (a) any such loan charge shall be reduced by the amount necessary to refur the charge to the permitted limit; and (b) any sums already collected from Borrower which exceeded permitted limits will be refur use to Borrower. Lander may choose to make this refund by reducing the principal owed under the Note or by making a direct payment to Sorrower. If a refund reduces principal, the reduction will be treated as a partial prepayment without any prepayment charge under the Note.

14. Notices. Any notice to Borrower provided for in this Security Instrument shall be given by delivering to or by mailing it by first class mail unless applicable law requires use of another method. The notice shall be directed to the Property Address or any other address Borrower designates by notice to Lender. Any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein or any other address Lender designates by notice to Borrower. Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given as provided in this paragraph.

15. Governing Law; Severability. This Security Instrument shall be governed by federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to be severable.

18. Borrower's Copy. Sorrower shall be given one conformed copy of the Note and of this Security Instument.

17. Transfer of the Property or a Seneficial Interest in Borrower. If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Lander's prior written consent, Lander may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lander if exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Security Instrument.

If Lander exercises this option, Lender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration. 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- 13. Borrower's Right to Reinstate. Those conditions are that Borrower: (a) pays Lender all sums which then would be due under this Security Instrument and the Note as if no acceleration had occurred; (b) cures any default of any other covenants or agreements; (c) pays all expenses incurred in enforcing this Security Instrument, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees; and (d) takes such action as Lender may reasonably require to secure that the lien of this Security Instrument, Lender's rights in the Property and Borrower's obligation to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument shall continue unchanged. Upon reinetatement by Borrower, this Security Instrument and the obligations escured hereby shall remain fully offective as if no acceleration had occurred. However, this right to reinstate shall not apply in the case of acceleration under paragraph 17.
- 19. SALE OF NOTE; CHANGE OF LOAN SERVICER. The Note or a partial interest in the Note (together with this Security Instrument) may be sold one or more times without prior notice to Borrower. A sale may result in the entity (known as the "Loan Servicer") that collects monthly payments due under the Note and this Security Instrument. There also may be one or more changes of the Loan Servicer unrelated to a sale of the Note. If there is a change of the Loan Service, Borrower will be given written notice of the change in accordance with paragraph 14 above and applicable law. The notice will state the name and address of the new Loan Servicer and the address to which payments should be made. The notice will also contain any other information required by applicable law.
- 20. HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES. Borrower shall not cause or permit the presence, use, disposal, storage, or release of any Hazardous Substances on or in the Property. Borrower shall not do, nor allow snyone else to do, anything effecting the Property that is in violation of any Environmental Law. The preceding two sentences shall not apply to the presence, use, or storage on the Property of small out, ities of Hazardous Substances that are generally recognized to be appropriate to normal residential uses and to maintenance of the Nuperty.

Borrower shall promptly give Lender written notice of any investigation, claim, demand, lawsuit or other action by any governmental or regulator, agency or private party involving the Property and any Hazardous Substance or Environmental Law of which Borrower has actual and violedge. If Borrower learns, or is notified by any governmental or regulatory authority, that any removal or other remodiation of any degradous Substance affecting the Property is necessary, Borrower shall promptly take all necessary remodial actions in accordance with Environmental Law.

No long as the Owners Association maintains, with a generally accepted insurance carrier, a "master" or "blanket" policy on the Condominium Project which is satisfactory to Lender and which provides insurance coverage in the amounts, for the periods, and consist the hazards Lender requires, including fire and hazards included within the term "extended coverage", then:

(i) Lender waives the provision in Uniform Covenant 2 for the monthly payment to Lender of the yearly premium installments

for hazard insurance on the Property, en-

(ii) Borrower's obligation under Uniform Covenant 5 to maintain hazard insurance coverage on the Property is deemed satisfied to the extent that the required coverage is provided by the Owners Association policy.

Borrower shall give Lender prompt notics of any lapse in required hazard insurance coverage.

In the event of a distribution of hazard insurar se proceeds in lieu of restoration or repair following a loss to the Property, whether to the unit or to common elements, any proceeds payable to Borrower are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender for application to the sums secured by the Security Instrument, with any excess paid to Borrower.

C. Public Liability Insurance. Borrower shall tale such actions as may be reasonable to insure that the Owners Association

maintains a public liability insurance policy acceptable in form, amount, and extent of coverage to Lender.

D. Condemnation. The proceeds of any award or claim for durages, direct or consequential, payable to Borrower in connection with any condemnation or other taking of all or any part of the Property, whether of the unit or of the common elements, or for any conveyance in lieu of condemnation, are hereby assigned and share to paid to Londer. Such proceeds shall be applied by Lender to the sums secured by the Security Instrument as provided in Uniform Covenant 10.

E. Lender's Prior Consent. Borrower shall not, except after notice to Lender and with Lender's prior written consent, either

partition or subdivide the Property or consent to:

Any amounts disbursed by Lender under this paragraph F shall become additional debt of Borrower secure i by the Security Instrument. Unless Borrower and Lender agree to other terms of payment, these amounts shall bear interest from the date of disbursement at the Noteco rate and shall be payable, with interest, upon notice from Lender to Borrower requesting payment.
