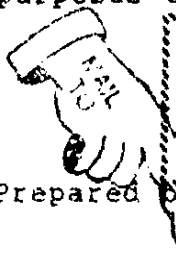

REPORT OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES  
 CONCERNING THE PROVISIONS OF THE CHILD WELFARE ACT OF 1960  
 AS APPLIED TO THE CARE OF CHILDREN IN THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT  
 AND THE NEED FOR A REVISION OF THE ACT

The Commission on the Child Welfare Act of 1960 was organized in 1961 to study the operation of the Act and to recommend such changes as might be necessary to improve the care of children in the State of Connecticut. The Commission has held numerous public hearings and has received many suggestions from the public. It has also conducted extensive research into the various aspects of child welfare in Connecticut.

The Commission has concluded that the Child Welfare Act of 1960 is generally sound but requires certain amendments to better meet the needs of the State. These amendments are necessary to clarify the law, to provide for the more effective administration of the Act, and to address the growing problem of child abuse.

The Commission recommends that the following amendments be made to the Child Welfare Act of 1960:

1. Amend Section 37-200 to provide for the appointment of a guardian for the person of a child who is in the custody of the State.

2. Amend Section 37-201 to provide for the appointment of a guardian for the estate of a child who is in the custody of the State.

3. Amend Section 37-202 to provide for the appointment of a guardian for the property of a child who is in the custody of the State.

4. Amend Section 37-203 to provide for the appointment of a guardian for the person of a child who is in the custody of a private agency.

5. Amend Section 37-204 to provide for the appointment of a guardian for the estate of a child who is in the custody of a private agency.

6. Amend Section 37-205 to provide for the appointment of a guardian for the property of a child who is in the custody of a private agency.
