THIS INDENTURE, made November 5, 1992, between FIRST STATE BANK AND TRUST COMPANY OF PARK RIDGE, not personally but as Trustee under Trust Agreement dated April 10, 1990 and known as Trust Number 2120, (herein referred to as "Mortgagor") and BANK OF BUFFALO GROVE, an Illinois banking corporation (herein referred to as "Mortgagee") witnesseth:

All such payments on account of the indebtedness evidenced by said Note to be first applied to interest on the unpaid principal balance and the remainder to principal. All of said principal and interest being made payable at the principal office of the Mortgagee in Buffalo Grove, Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mortgagor to secure the payment of said Note in accordance with its terms and the terms, provisions and limitations of this Mortgage, and all extensions, modifications, and renewals thereof, together with interest and charges as therein provided, and the performance of the covenants and agreements herein contained and the terms and conditions of that certain Commitment Letter dated October 1, 1992 by the Mortgagor to be performed, and also in consideration of other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Mortgage and Warrant to the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described Real Estate in the County of Cook and State of Illinois, to wit:

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which, with the property hereinafter described, is referred to herein as the "premises".

TOGETHER with all improvements thereon situate and which may hereafter be erected or placed thereon, and all appurtenances, rights, royalties, mineral, oil and gas rights, and easements thereunto belonging and the rents, issues and profits thereof, which are hereby expressly conveyed and assigned to the Mortgages as additional security and as an equal and primary fund with the property herein conveyed for the repayment of the moneys secured by this Mortgage, and any and all appurtenances, fixtures and equipment in or that may at any time be placed in any building

is mutually covenanted and agreed, by and between the parties hereto that, in addition to all other things which at law or by convention are regarded as fixtures, and specifically but by way of limitation all shades and awnings, screens and gas and electric fixtures, radiators, carpets, shrubbery, engines and machinery, boilers, ranges, elevators and bathtubs, sinks, water-closets, basins, pipes, faucets heaters, bathtubs, sinks, motors, other plumbing and heating fixtures, mirrors, mantels, and refrigerating plants, iceboxes, electric refrigerators, air conditioning apparatus, cooking apparatus and appurtenances, and such other goods and chattels as may ever be furnished by a landlord in letting and operating an unfurnished building, similar to any building now or hereafter standing on said premises, whether or not the same are or shall be attached to said building by nails, screws, bolts, pipe connections, masonry, or in any other manner whatsoever, which are now or hereafter to be used upon said described premises shall be conclusively deemed to be "flxtures" and an accession to the freehold and a part of the realty, whether affixed or annexed or not, and conveyed by this Mortgage; and all the estate, right, title or interest of the said Mortgagor in and to said premises, property, improvements, furniture, apparatus, furnishings and fixtures, are hereby expressly conveyed assigned and pledged; and as to any of the property aforesaid, which does not so form a part and parcel of the Real Estate or does not constitute a "fixture" as such term is defined in the Uniform Commercial Code. This Mortgage is hereby deemed to be as well a Security Agreement under the Uniform Commercial Code for the purpose of creating hereby a security interest in such property, which Mortgagor hereby grants to the Mortgagee as Secured Party (as such term is defined in the Uniform Commercial Code). Uniform Commercial Code).

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described premises with the appurtenances and fixtures thereto appertaining or belonging unto the Mortgagee, it successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes herein set forth and for the security of the said obligations hereinbefore described, and interest thereon and free from all rights and benefits under and by virtue of the Homestead Exemption Laws of the State of Illinois, which said rights and benefits the said Mortgagor does hereby expressly remase and waive.

In addition, the Mortgagor covenants with the Mortgagee as follows:

- 1. Mortgagor shall promptly pay when due without set-off, recoupment, or deduction, the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the Note and any late charges as provided in the Note.
- 2. Mortgagor shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises

which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for lien not expreasly subordinated to the lien hereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and, upon request, exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Mortgagee; (4) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material altorations in the premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance.

- owing, all general taxes, special taxes, special assessments, water charges sewer service charges, and other charges which may be levied against the premises, and furnish to Mortgages duplicate receipts thereof within thirty (30) days after payment thereof.
- or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning and such other risks and hazards that are insurable under the present and future forms of all-risk insurance policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient to pay the greater of either the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the Mortgagee, under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to Mortgagee, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy, and shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to Mortgagee, and in case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration. All policies of insurance shall contain a provision requiring that the coverage evidenced thereby shall not be terminated or materially modifies without thirty (30) days prior written notice to the Mortgagee. If the insurance policies referenced herein contain a co-insurance clause or provision, Mortgagor agrees to maintain insurance coverage which is at all times in compliance with the clause or provision.

Mortgagor shall furnish Mortgagee with evidence satisfactory to Mortgagee that flood insurance is in effect if Mortgagor has failed to demonstrate to Mortgagee that the premises are not located in an area designated by the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development as having special flood hazards.

5. In case of loss by fire or other casualty, the Mortgagee (or after entry of decree of foreclosure, purchaser at the sale, or the decree creditor, as the case may be) is hereby authorized either (i) to settle and adjust any claim under such insurance policies without consent of Mortgagor, or (ii) to allow

Mortgagor to agree with the insurance company or companies on the amount to be paid upon the loss. In either case Mortgagee is authorized to collect and receipt for any such insurance money. In the event Mortgagee elects to apply said insurance prodeeds in reduction of the indebtedness secured hereby, all expenses and fees of collection shall first be deducted and paid to Mortgagee, and it is further covenanted and agreed that should the net insurance prodeeds be insufficient to pay the then existing indebtedness secured hereby, together with all accrued interest thereon, fees and charges, Mortgagee may, at its sole election, declare the entire unpaid balance of the debt socured hereby to be immediately due and payable, and the failure of the payment thereof shall be a default hereunder.

In the event Mortgagee elects to permit such insurance proceeds to be applied to pay for the cost of rebuilding or restoration of the building and improvements on the premises, such funds will be made available for disbursement by Mortgagee.

In the every such proceeds are applied toward restoration or rebuilding, the buildings and improvements shall be so restored or rebuilt as to be of at least equal value and substantially the character as prior to such damage or destruction. proceeds shall be made available, from time to time, upon the Mortgagee being furnlehed with satisfactory evidence of the estimated cost of completion thereof and with such architect's certificates, waivers of Uen, contractor's sworn statements and other evidence of cost and of payments, including insurance against mechanic's liens and/or a performance bond or bonds in form satisfactory to Mortgagee which shall be the sole or a dual obligee, and which bonds shall be written with such surety company or companies as may be satisfactory to Mortgagee. plans and specifications for such rebylding or restoration shall be presented to and approved by Mortgagee prior to the commencement of any such repair or rebuilding. At all times the undisbursed balance of said proceeds remaining in the hands of the Mortgagee shall be at least sufficient to pay for the cost of completion of the work free and clear of lieus

6. In addition to the monthly payments required under the Note, when requested by Mortgagee, Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagee monthly at the time when such monthly payment is payable, an amount equal to one-twelfth (1/12) of the annual premiums for such fire and extended coverage insurance and such annual real estate taxes, water and sewer rents, special assessments, and any other tax, assessment, claim, ligh, or encumbrance which may at any time be or become a lien upon the premises prior to the lien of this Mortgage, and on demand from time to time shall pay to the Mortgagee additional sums necessary to pay such premiums and other payments, all as estimated by the Mortgagee, the amounts so paid to be security for such premiums and other payments and to be used in payment thereof. At the Mortgagee's option, the Mortgagee may make such payments available to the Mortgagor for the payments required under Sections 3 and 4, or may make such payments on the Mortgagor's

- behalf. All amounts so paid shall be deemed to be trust funds, but no interest shall be payable thereon. If, pursuant to any provisions of this Mortgage, the whole amount of said principal debt remaining becomes due and payable, the Mortgagee shall have the right at its election to apply any amounts so held against the entire indebtedness secured hereby.
- 7. In the event that the Mortgagor fails to make any payment or perform any act required hereunder, Mortgagee may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore required of Mortgagor in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and other moneys advanced by Mortgagee (c protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, plus reasonable compensation to Mortgagee for each matter concerning which aitlen herein authorized may be taken, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate stated in the Note unless payment of interest at such rate would be contrary to applicable law, in which event such amounts shall bear interest at the highest rate permissible under applicable law. Inaction of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any cight accruing to it on account of any default hereunder on the part of Mortgagor.
 - 8. The Mortgagee making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien, or title or claim thereof.
 - At the option of Mortgagee, and without notice to Mortgagor, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this Mortgage shail, notwithstanding anything in the Note or in this Mortgage to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the the contrary, case of default under the terms of the Note; (b) immediately without the prior consent event Mortgagor shall, Mortgagee, sell, transfer, convey, encumber, or assign the title to all or any portion of the premises, or the rents, issues, or profits therefrom, whether by operation of law, voluntarily or otherwise, or shall contract to do any of the foregoing, or in the event the owner, or if there be more than one, any of the owners, of any beneficial interest in any trust of which is title holder (any such owner being herein referred to as a "Beneficial Owner") shall, without the prior written consent of Mortgagee, transfer or assign all or any portion of such beneficial interest, or the rents, issues, or profits from the premises (including, without being limited to, a collateral

assignment), whether by operation of law, voluntarily or otherwise, or shall contract to do any of the foregoing; (c) immediately in the event Mortgagor files for bankruptcy or bankruptcy proceedings are instituted against Mortgagor and not dismissed within thirty (30) calendar days, under any provision of any state or federal bankruptcy law in effect at the time of filing; (d) immediately in the event Mortgagor makes an assignment for the benefit of creditors, becomes insolvent or becomes unable to meet his obligations as they become due; or (e) immediately in the event of any levy or lien including, but not limited to, levies or liens arising from failure to pay any federal tax being filed against the Mortgagor or the premises; or (f) when default shall occur and continue for three days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagor contained herein or in any other agreement of the Mortgagor with the Mortgagoe.

- 10. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become whether by acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagee shall have right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indeptedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses relating thereto which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee, including but not limited to attorneys' fees, Mortgagee's fees, appraiser's fees, broker's commissions, advertising expenses, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all abutracts of title, title searches and examinations, guarantee policies, Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Mortgagee may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable, with interest thereon at the rate stated in the Note (unless payment of interest at such rate would be contrary to applicable law, in which event such amounts shall bear interest at the highest rate permissible under applicable law), when paid or incurred by Mortgagee in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which either of them shall be a party, either as plaintiff, claimant or defendant, by reason this Mortgage or any indebtedness hereby secured; preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure hereof after accrual of such right to foreclose whether or not actually commenced; or (c) preparations for the defense of any threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof, whether or not actually commenced.
- 11. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: first, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including, but not limited to,

- all such items as are mentioned in the precesding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof, constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest, remaining unpaid on the Note; fourth, any overplus to Mortgagor, its successors or assigns, as their rights may appear.
- 12. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a bill to foreclose this Mortgage, the court in which such bill is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagor at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and the Mortgages may be appointed as such receiver. The court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (1) the indebtedness secured hereby, or any decree foreclosing this Mortgage, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.
- 13. No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the Note hereby secured.
- 14. Mortgagee shall have tre right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.
- 15. As further security for payment of the indebtedness and performance of the obligations, coverants, and agreements secured hereby, the Mortgagor hereby assigns to the Mortgages all ready in existence and to be creaced in the future, with all rents to become due and under existing or leases already together future leases. This assignment, however, shall be operative only in the event of the occurrence of a default hereunder, or under the Note or other instrument collateral hereto; and in any such the Note or other instrument collateral hereto; case the Mortgagor hereby confers on the Mortgagee to exclusive power, to be used or not be used in its sole discretion, to act or to appoint a third person to act as agent for the agent, with power to take possession of, and collect all Mortgagor, the rents arising from, the premises and apply such rents, at the option of the Mortgagee, to the payment of the mortgage debt, costs of maintenance, repairs, expenses incident to and other expenses, in such order of priority as the see may in its sole discretion determine, and to turn any taxes, managing, Mortgagee may in its sole discretion determine, balance remaining over to the Mortgagor; but such collection rents shall not operate an affirmance of the tenant or lease of in the event the Mortgagor's title to the premises should be acquired by the Mortgagee. The Mortgagee shall be

- taken by eminent domain or condemnation, the Mortgagee is hereby empowered to collect and receive all compensation which may be paid for any property taken or for damages to any property not taken and all compensation so received shall be forthwith applied by the Mortgagee as it may elect, to the immediate reduction of the injectedness secured hereby, or to the repair and restoration of any property so damaged, provided that any excess over the amount of the indebtedness shall be delivered to the Mortgagors or their assignee.
- 17. Mortgagee has no duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the premises, nor shall Mortgagee be obligated to record this Mortgage or to exercise any power herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be liable for any acts or omissions hereunder, and it may require indemnities satisfactory to it before exercising any power herein given.
- 18. Mortgagee shall release this Mortgage and the lien thereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that all indebtedness secured by this Mortgage has been fully paid.
- 19. This Mortgage and all provisions hereof, shall extend to and be binding upon Mortgagor and all persons claiming under or through Mortgagor, and the word "fortgagor" when used herein shall include all such persons and all persons liable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have executed the Note of this Mortgage. The use of any gender applies to all genders. If more than one party is named as the Mortgagor, the obligation hereunder of each such party is joint and several. Mortgagee may assign all or any portion of its rights and interests under this Mortgage without the consent of Mortgagor.
- 20. In the event of the passage after the data of this Mortgage of any law changing in any way the laws now in force for the taxation of mortgages, or debts secured thereby, or the manner of operation of such taxes, so as to affect the interest of Bank, then and in such event Mortgagor shall pay the full amount of such taxes.
- 21. To the fullest extent permitted by law, Mortgagor shall not and will not at any time apply for or in any manner attempt to claim or avail itself of any homestead, appraisement, valuation, or any so-called "moratorium laws," now existing or hereafter enacted, in order to prevent or hinder the enforcement

or foreclosure of this Mortgage, but hereby waives the benefit of such laws. To the fullest extent permitted by law, Mortgagor, for itself and all who may claim through or under it, waives any and all right to have the property and estates comprising the premises marshalled upon any foreclosure of the lien hereof and agrees that any court having juridiction to foreclose such lien may order the premises sold as an entirety. To the fullest extent permitted by law, Mortgagor hereby waives any and all rights of redemption from the foreclosure, for itself, the trust estate, and all persons beneficially interested therein, and each and every person acquiring any interest in or title to the premises described herein subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, and on behalf of all other persons to the extent permitted by Illinois law.

- 22. This Mortgage shall be governed by and interpreted according to the laws of the State of Illinois. In the event any provision of the Mortgage, or the Note, conflict with said law, such conflict shall not affect any other provision of the Mortgage, or the Note which can be given effect without reference to the conflict. In this regard, the provisions of the Mortgage and the Note shall be deemed severable.
- 23. Any notice, demand, request or other communications desired to be given or required pursuant to the terms hereof shall be in writing and shall be deemed given when personally serviced or on the second (201) day following deposit of the same in the United States Mail via registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, addressed to the Mortgagor at the address set forth below or to the Mortgagee at the Bank's main office or to such other address as either the Mortgagor or the Mortgagee notifies the other party in writing.
- 24. The rights and remedies of Mortgagee under this Mortgage are cumulative and are not in lieu of, but are in addition to any other rights or remedies which Mortgagee shall have under the Note or any other instrument constituting security for the Note, or at law or in equity.
- 25. This Mortgage shall not be amended, modified or changed nor shall any waiver of any provision hereof to effective as against Mortgagee, except only by an instrument in writing and signed by the party against whom enforcement of any waiver, amendment, change, modification or discharge is sought.
- 26. Mortgagor, at its expense, will execute, acknowledge and deliver such instruments and take such actions as Mortgagee from time to time may reasonably request to carry out the intent and purpose of this Mortgage.
- 27. Mortgagor represents and warrants that: (i) Mortgagor has not used Hazardous Material (as defined hereinafter) on or affecting the premises in any manner which violates federal, state or local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations, or policies governing the use, storage, treatment, transportation,

manufacture, refinement, handling, production or disposal of Hazardous Materials, and that, to the best of Mortgagor's knowledge, no prior owner of the premises or any tenant, subtenant, occupant, prior tenant, prior subtenant or prior occupant has used Hazardous Materials on or affecting the premises in any manner which violated federal, state or local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations or policies governing the use, storage, treatment, transportation, manufacture, refinement, handling, production or disposal of Hazardous Materials; (ii) Mortgagor has never received any notice of any violations of federal, state or local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations or policies governing the use, storage, treatment, transportation, manufacture, refinement, handling, production or disposal of Hazardous Materials and, to the best of Mortgagor's knowledge, there have been no actions commenced or threatened by any party for noncompliance. For purposes of this Mortgage, "Hazardous Materials" include, without limitation, any flammable explosives, radioactive materials, hazardous materials, hazardous wastes, hazardous or toxic substances or related materials defined in any federal, state or local governmental, law, ordinance, rule, or regulations.

Mortgagor shall keep or cause the premises to be kept free of Hazardous Materials, and, without limiting the foregoing, Mortgagor shall not cause or permit the premises to be used to generate, manufacture, refine, transport, treat, store, handle, dispose of, transfer, produce, or process Hazardous Materials, except in compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations, nor shall Mortgagor cause or permit, as a result of any intentional or unintentional act or omission on the part of Mortgagor or any tenant, subtenant or occupant, a release of Hazardous Materials onto the premises or onto any other property.

Mortgagor shall: (i) conduct and complete all investigations, studies, sampling and terting, and all remedial, removal and other actions necessary to clean up and remove all Hazardous Materials, on, under, from or affecting the premises in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and policies, to the reasonable satisfaction of Mortgagee, and in accordance with the orders and directives of all federal, state and local governmental authorities, and (ii) defend, indemnify and hold harmless Mortgagee, its employees, agents, officers and directors, from and against any claims, demands, penalties, fines, liabilities, settlements, damages, costs or expenses of whatever kind or nature, known or unknown, contingent or otherwise, arising out of, or in any way related to, (a) the presence, disposal, release or threatened release of any Hazardous Materials on, over, under, from, or affecting the premises or the soil, water vegetation, buildings, personal property, persons or animals thereon; (b) any personal injury (including wrongful death) or property damage (real or personal) arising out of or related to such Hazardous Materials; (c) any lawsuit brought or threatened, settlement reached or government order relating to such Hazardous Materials,

and/or (d) any violation of laws, orders, regulations, requirements or demands of government authorities, or any policies or requirements of Mortgagee, which are based upon or in any way related to such Hazardous Materials including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys' and consultant's fees, investigation and laboratory fees, court costs, and litigation expenses.

If the Mortgagor is a corporation, Mortgagor represents and warrants to Mortgagee that the execution and delivery of this Mortgage has been duly authorized by resolutions heretofore adopted by its Board of Directors and Shareholders in accordance with law and its bylaws, that said resolutions have not been amended nor rescinded, are in full force and effect, that the officers executing and delivering this Mortgage for and on behalf the selving of Columns Clarks Office of Mortgagor, are duly authorized so to act. Mortgagee is expressly relying upon the aforesaid representations and warranties.
