PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT RIDER 3RD day of THIS PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT RIDER is made this FEBRUARY , and is incorporated into and shall be deemed to amend and supplement the Mortgage, Deed of Trust or Security Deed (the "Security Instrument") of the same date, given by the undersigned (the "Borrower") to secure Borrower's Note to FIRST QUALITY MORTGAGE COMPANY (the "Lender") of the same date and covering the Property described in the Security. Instrument and located at: 6022 NORTH WINTHPOD-UNIT C, CHICAGO, ILLINOIS 60660 The Property includes, but is not limited to, a parcel of land improved with a dwelling, together with other such parcels and certain common areas and facilities, as described in Sillion 1994 THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS OF RECORD (the "Declaration"). The Property is a part of a planned unit development known as (Nume of Planned Unit Development) (the "PUD"). The Property also includes Borrower's interest in the homeowners association or equivalent en its owning or managing the common areas and facilities of the PUD (the "Owners Association") and the uses, benefits and proceeds of Borrower's interest. PUD COVENANTS. In addition to the covenants and agreements made in the Security Instrument, Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows: A. PUD OBLIGATIONS. Borrower shall perform all of Borrower's obligations under the PUD's Constituent Documents. The "Constituent Documents" are the: (i) Declaration; (ii) articles of incorporation, trust instrument or any equivalent document which creates the Owners Association; and (iii) any by-laws or other rules corregulations of the Owners Association. Borrower shall promptly pay, when due, all dues and assessments imposed pursuant to the Constituent Documents. B. HAZARD INSURANCE. - E. LENDER'S PRIOR CONSENT. Borrower shall not, except after notice to Lent'er and with Lender's prior written consent, either partition or subdivide the Property or consent to:
- (I) the abandonment or termination of the PUD, except for abandonment or termination required by law in the case of substantial destruction by fire or other casualty or in the case of a taking by condemnation or aminent domain;

(ii) any amendment to any provision of the "Constituent Documents" if the provision is for the express benefit of Lender;

(III) termination of professional management and assumption of self-management of the Owners Association; or

(iv) any action which would have the effect of rendering the public liability insurance coverage maintained by the Owners Association unacceptable to Lender.

F. REMEDIES. If Borrower does not pay PUD dues and assessments when due, then Lender may pay them. Any amounts disbursed by Lender under this paragraph F shall become additional debt of Borrower secured by the Security Instrument. Unless Borrower and Lender agree to other terms of payment, these amounts shall bear interest from the date of disbursement at the Note rate and shall be payable, with interest, upon notice from Lender to Borrower requesting payment.
