(92-15P) THIS ORDINANCE MAY

BE CITE AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO AND USE OF THE OPERATION OF A LIGHOP FEMALE. CONTINUE THE OPERATION OF A LIQUOR ESTABLISHMENT AND USE OF THE SECOND FLOOR APARTMENT AT 7887 LINCOLN AVENUE, SKOKIE, ILLINOIS AS A MIXED USE RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT CATEGORY IN THE B-5 DOWNTOWN DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the owner of the following described real estate:

Lots 29 and 30 in Block 2 in Circuit Court Partition of Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18 in William Lill Adminstrators Subdivision of the Northeast Quarter of Section 28, Township 41 North, Range 13, East of the Third Principal Meridian, except therefrom that portion thereof falling within Lots 5 and 6 of County Clerk's Unision of Section 28, aforesaid, in Cook County, Illinois

more commonly described as 7887 Lincoln Avenue, Skokie, Illinois, petitioned the Skokie Plan Commission for a Special Use Permit to continue the operation of a liquor establishment and the use of the second floor apartment at the aforesaid locacion; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission, after public hearing duly held, made appropriate findings of fact as required under Section 13.4.5.5 of the Skokie Zoning Ordinance and recommended to the Mayor and Board of Trustees that the requested Special Use Permit be granted subject to various conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees, after public hearing duly held, concurred in the aforesaid recommendations and findings of fact of the Plan Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Skokie, Cook County, Illinois:

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Section 1: That the Special Use Permit requested by the petitioner to continue the operation of a liquor establishment and the use of the second floor apartment at 7887 Lincoln Avenue, Skokie, Illinois, as a mixed use residential/commercial development category in the B-5 Downtown District is hereby granted and approved subject to each of the conditions set forth below:

- 1. That the subject use shall be operated in conformance with the parking layout prepared by the Traffic Engineering Division, dated September 23, 1992.
- 2. That the hullding exterior shall be renovated as indicated in the Building Flevations, dated September 4, 1992, that were approved by the Appearance Commission.
- 3. That the lounge and second floor apartment shall be operated in substantial compliance with the first and second floor plans, received September 23, 1992.
- 4. That the second floor apartment shall not be subdivided without an amendment to the Special Use Permit granted by this ordinance.
- 5. That the cooking of food, any cooking process which creates grease-laden vapors and any open frame cooking device, at the lounge, shall be allowed only by an amendment to the Special Use Permit granted by this ordinance.
- 6. That the northwest room of the lounge, with a rear exit to the outside of the building, must be maintained free of any storage or use.
- 7. That the garbage corral shall be kept clean and refuse containers shall be stored in the corral.
- 8. That no more than three (3) coin-operated amusement devices shall be allowed in the lounge.
- 9. That no patron of the lounge shall make or cause to be made any loud or unnecessary noise or disturbance upon the premises in violation of the Village Code and Ordinances.
- 10. That if the lounge is closed for more than six (6) months, there shall be a rebuttable presumption of an intention to abandon the use of the premises for such use.
- 11. That the use shall comply with all Village Codes and Ordinances, including applicable Special Use requirements.

- 12. That all Federal, State and local regulations, codes and ordinances must be complied with.
- 13. That the owner of the subject property shall post under glass in a conspicuous location within the lounge, the specific conditions under which the Special Use Permit was granted; and any Special Use Permit which is granted shall be recorded at the Petitioner's expense with the Cook County Recorder of Deeds.
- 14. That failure to abide by any and all terms of this Special Use shall be cause for the Village to initiate hearings to determine whether the subject Special Use should be revoked, as were as any applicable business license.

<u>Section 2.</u> That a notice of the enactment of this Ordinance incorporating the conditions contained herein be approved by the owner of the property in writing and duly recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds for Cook County at the owner's expense.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and recordation as provided by law.
