FINAL CLOSING: Buyer shall be entitled to delivery of the Deed of conveyance aforesaid Affidavit of Title and a Bill of Sale to the personal property to be transferred to Buyer under this Agreement at any time upon payment of all amounts due hereunder in the form of cashier's or certified check made payable to Seller, which amount shall be without premium or penalty. At the time fluver provides notice to Seller that he is prepared to prepay all amounts due hereunder, Seller forthwith either shall produce and record at his expense a release deed for the prior mortgage, or obtain a currently dated loar, repayment letter reflecting the amount necessary to discuss due hereunder from Buyer.
