Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrue in audition theretal, shall be a lient in layor of the limited States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless enother date as specifically fixed by law the field imposed by section 5.5% shall arise all the time the assessment in made and shall continue until the lability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such rability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of times.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(A) Purchastir's, Holders Of Security Interests, Niechanic's Lienprs, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The tien imposed by section 8321 shall not be valid as significantly purchases, holder of a security interest, machanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor unit notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been liked by the Secretary.

(g) Refiling Of Notice.—For purposes of this section:

(1) GENERA RUID. —Unless notice of Kun is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required retiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as tiled on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such retiling period.

(2) PIACE FOR FILING.—A notice of then relited during the required refitting period shall be effective only-

(3) Required Refilling Period. —In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refilling period" means.

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 10 years after the date of the essessment of the tax, and

(8) the one-year partod ending with the expiration of 10 years after the close of the preceding required settling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such reguletions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not leter than 30 days after the day on which:

(1) Liability Satistied or Unenforceable. The Secretary finds that the liability to the amount assessed, togeth er with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully estisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a band that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in remain thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such terminants relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such accountaints.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien, if a notice of lien has been filled pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such use may be disclosed to any person who furnishes estimated written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lient or intends to obtain a right in such property.
