EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. Breaches. Any warranty, representation or statement made or furnished to Lender by or on behalf of Granfor under this Morigage, the Note of the Related Documents is, or at the time made or furnished was, take in any material respect.

Insolvency. The insolvency of Grantor, appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against Grantor, or the dissolution or termination of Grantor's existence as a going business (if Grantor is a business). Except to the extent prohibited by federal law or Unios law, the death of Grantor (if Grantor is an individual) also shall constitute an Event of Default under this Mortgage.

Foreclosure, Forfetture, atc. Commencement of foreclosure or forfeiture proceedings, whether by judicial proceeding, self-help, repossession or any other method, by any creditor of Grantor or by any governmental agency against any of the Property. However, this subsection shall not apply in the event of a good faith dispute by Grantor as to the validity or reasonableness of the claim which is the basis of the foreclosure or forefeiture proceeding, provided that Grantor gives Lender written notice of such claim and turnishes reserves or a surety bond for the claim satisfactory to Lender.

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Breach of Other Agreement. Events Affecting Guarantor. Any of the preceding events occurs with respect to any Guarantor of any of the Indebtedness or such Guarantor des or becomes incompetent or any Guarantor revokes any guaranty of the Indebtedness.

Insecurity, Lender reasonably deems itself insecure.

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter, Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Mortgages in Possession. Lender shall have the right to be placed as mortgages in possession or to have a receivor appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and precurve the Property, to operate the Property praceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness. The mortgages in the session or receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Lender's right to the appointment of a receiver shall tools whether or not the appraient value of the Property exceeds the indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lender shall not disqualify a person from serving an a receiver.

Judicial Foreclosure. Letiral may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Property.

Deficiency Judgment. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency romaining in the Indebtedness due to Lender after application of all and units received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section.

Other Flemedies, Lender shaking of a other rights and remedies provided in this Mongage or the Note or available at law or in equity.

Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten (10) days before the time of the sale or disposition.

Walver; Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict compliance yith that provision or any other provision. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election is not expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Lender's right 1/2 declare a default and exercise its remedies under this Mortgage.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. Grantor also will pay any court costs, in addition to all other sums provided by law.

Any notice under this Mortgage, including without limitation any notice of default and any notice of sale to Grantor, shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or, if notice, shall be deemed effective when deposited in the United States mail first class, registered mail, postage prepaid, directed to the addresses shown ner. Any party may change its address for notices under this Mortgage by giving formal written notice to the other parties specifing that the purpose of the notice is to change the party's address. All copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any tien which has prio. The rest this Mortgage shall be sent to Lander's address, as shown near the beginning of this Mortgage. For notice purposes, Grantor agrees to keep Lenter informed at all times of Grantor's current address.

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Severability.
