BORROWER COVENANTS that Borrower is lawfully seised of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to mortgage, grant and convey the Property and that the Property is unencumbered, except for encumbrances of record. 2. Funds for Taxes and Insurance. Subject to applicable law or to a written waiver by Lender.
