Other Defaults. Failure of Grantor to comply with any term, obligation, covenant, or condition contained in any other agreement between Grantor and Lender.

Death or Insolvency. The death of Grantor, the Insolvency of Grantor, the appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, any type of creditor workout, or the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against Grantor.

Foreclosure, Forfeiture, etc. Commencement of foreclosure or forfeiture proceedings, whether by judicial proceeding, self-holp, repossession or any other method, by any creditor of Grantor or by any governmental agency against any of the Property. Mortgagee in Possession.
