3. All claims enumerated in Title 18 <u>Del. C.</u> § 5918(e) shall have priority over any claims a using from the rejection of an executory contract pursuant to paragraph 1 above.

4. The Order and this Supplemental Rehabilitation Order shall remain in effect until otherwise further modified by this Court.
