receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents CONVEY and WARRANT unto the Trustee, its successors and assigns, the following described Real Estate
and all of their estate, right, title and interest therein, situate, lying and being in the City of Chicago

which, with the property hereinafter described, is referred to herein as the "premises."
TOGETHER with improvements and fixtures now attached together with easements, rights, privileges, interests, rents and profits.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises unto the said Trustee, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes, and upon the uses and trusts herein set forth, free
from all rights and benefits under and by virtue of the Homestead Exemption Laws of the State of Illinois, which said rights and benefits the Grantors do hereby expressly
release and waive.

COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS

- Grantors shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanical or other liens or claims for lien or otherwise, subordinate to the lien hereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior liens to Trustee or to Beneficiary; (4) comply within a reasonable time any building or building now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations at said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance.
- Grantors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to Trustee or to Beneficiary duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder Grantors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Grantors may become liable to pay.
- Grantors shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning or windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all as companies satisfactory to the Beneficiary, under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to Trustee for the benefit of the Beneficiary, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy, and shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to Beneficiary, and in case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration.
- In case of default thereon, Trustee or Beneficiary may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereunder required of Grantors in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior mortgages, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or foreclosure affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorney's fees, and any other moneys advanced by Trustee or Beneficiary to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, shall be with such additional indebtedness secured hereby, and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the annual percentage rate stated in the Contract this Trust Deed secures. Execution of Trustee or Beneficiary shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to them on account of any default hereunder on the part of Grantors.

This Trust Deed consists of two pages. The covenants, conditions and provisions appearing on page 2 (the reverse side) of this trust deed) are incorporated herein by reference and are a part hereof and shall be binding on the Grantors, their heirs, successors and assigns.
