COMMENCEMENT OF CASE. A petition for liquidation under chapte, 7 of the Bankruptcy Code has been filled in this court by or against the person or persons named above as the debtor, and an order for relief has been entered. You will not receive notice of all documents filled in this case. All documents filled with this court, including lists of the debtor's property, debts, and property slaimed as exempt are available for inspection at the office of the clerk or the bankruptcy court.

CREDITORS MAY NOT TAKE CERTAIN ACTIONS. A creditor is anyone to whom the debtor owes money or property. Under the Bankruptcy Code, the debtor is granted certain protection against creditors. Common examples of prohibited actions by creditors are contacting the debtor to demand repayment, taking action against the debtor to collect money owed to creditors or to take property of the debtor, and starting or continuing foreclosure actions, repossessions, or age deductions. If unauthorized actions are taken by a creditor against a debtor, the court may penalize that creditor. A creditor who is considering taking action against the debtor or the property of the debtor should review section 362 of the Bankruptcy Code and may wish to seek legal advice. The staff of the clerk of the bankruptcy court is not permitted to give legal advice.

MEETING OF CREDITORS. The debtor both husband and wife in a joint case) is required to appear at the meeting of creditors on the date and at the place set forth above for the purpose of being exemined under oath. Attendener by creditors at the meeting is welcomed, but not required. At the meeting, the creditors may elect a trustee other than the one included above, elect a committee of creditors, examine the debtor, and transact such other business as may properly come before the meeting. The meeting may he continued or adjourned from time to time by notice at the meeting, without further written notice to anothers.

LIQUIDATION OF THE DESTOR'S PROPERTY. The trustee will collect the debtor's property and turn any that is not exempt into money. At this time, however, it appears from the schedules of the debtor that there are no assets from which any distribution can be paid to creditors. If at a later date it appears that there are assets from which a distribution may be paid, the creditors will be notified and given an opportunity to file claims.

EXEMPT PROPERTY. Under state and federal law, the debtor is permitted to keep certain money or property as exempt. If a creditor believes that an exemption of money or property is not authorized by law, the creditor may file an objection. An objection must be filed:not later than 30 days after the conclusion of the meeting of creditors.

DISCHARGE OF DEBTS. The debtor is seeking a discharge of debts. A discharge means that certain debts are made unenforceable against the debtor personally. Creditors whose claims against the debtor are discharged may never take action against the debtor to collect the discharge debts.
