Definitions; Purpose and Security. In this Mortgage, the words "you"and "your"and "Borrower" mean the person or persons, jointly and severally, who have signed below as borrower(s), and the words "we", "us", and "our" mean the Lender identified above. The word "Mortgagor" shall mean, join ly and severally, each borrower signing below, and if title to the Property is held in an Illinois Land Trust, the Land Trustee identified above. This means that if Lender performs for any Mortgagor any of Mortgagor's obligations under the Superior Mortgage, then Lender will have the same rights against each Mortgagor regarding such default as the Superior Lender would have against each Mortgagor regarding such default. However, this will be in addition to all other rights and remedies that Lender will have under the Agreement and this Mortgage regarding such default. Although Lender may take action under the conditions described in this Paragraph, Lender does not have to do so.
