MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE IS DATED AUGUST 8, 1994, between Carmine Diffield and Franca R. Diffield, his wife, whose address is 9428 S. 69th Court, Oak Lawn, IL. 60453 (referred to below as "Grantor"); and First Colonial Bank Southwest, whose address is 5440 West 87th Street, Burbank, IL 60459 (referred to below as "Lender").

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For valuable consideration, Grantor mortgeges, warrants, and conveys to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following described real property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or affixed buildings, improvements and fixtures; all easements, rights of way, and appurtenances; all water, water rights, watercourses and ditch rights (including stock in utilities with ditch or irrigation rights); and all other rights, cytiles, and profits relating to the real property, including without limitation all minerals, oil, gas, genthermal and similar matters, located in Courty, State of illinois (the "Real Property");

The South 148 Feet of the North 188 Feet of the East 61 Feet of the West 253 Feet of the North 1/2 of the North 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 6, Township 37 North, Range 13, East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois.

The Real Property or its address is commonly known as 7143 W. 91st Street, Bridgeview, it. 60455. The Real Property lax identification number is 24-06-300.

Grantor presently assigns to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to all leases of the Property and all Rents from the Property, in addition, Grantor grants to Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in the Personal Property and Rents.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the roll of many meanings when used in this Mortgage. Terms not otherwise defined in this Mortgage shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Unit rm Commercial Code. All references to dollar amounts shall mean amounts in lawful money of the United States of America.

Existing indebtedness. The words "Existing indebtedness the indebtedness described below in the Existing indebtedness section of this Mortgage

Grantor, The word "Grantor" means Carmine Diffiele and Frunca 3. Diffiele. The Grantor is the mortgagor under this Mortgage.

Quarantor. The word "Quarantor" means and includes without limitation, each and all of the guarantors, sureties, and accommodation parties in connection with the indebtodness.

Improvements. The word "improvements" means and includes vithout limitation all existing and future improvements, fixtures, buildings, structures, mobile homes affixed on the Real Property, facilities, additions, epagements and other construction on the Real Property.

Indebtedness. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest or public under the Note and any amounts expanded or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Lender to enforce obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage, together with interest on such amounts approvided in this Mortgage.

means First Colonial Bank Southwest, its successors and assigns. The Lender is the mortgages under this Mortgage.

Mortpage. The word "Mortpage" means this Mortpage between Grantor and Lender, and includes without limitation all assignments and security interest provisions relating to the Personal Property and Rents.

Note. The word "Note" means the promissory note or credit agreement dated August 6, 1999, in the Original principal amount of \$15,000,00 from Grantor to Lender, together with all renewals of, extensions of, modifications of, refinancings of, consolidations of, and substitutions for the promissory note or agreement. The interest rate on the Note is 9,500%. The Note is payable in 84 monthly payments of

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, fixtures, and other articles of pr.so.\all property now or hereafter owned by Grantor, and now or hereafter allached or affixed to the Real Property; logether with all accessions, p.iris, and additions to, all replacements of, and all substitutions for, any of such property; and together with all proceeds (including without limitations) of currence proceeds and refunds of premiums) from any sale or other disposition of the Property.

Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the property, interests and rights described above in the "Grant of Microsege" section.

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include without limitation all promissory notes, oradit agreements, loan agreements, guaranties, security agreements, mortgages, deeds of trust, and all other instruments, agreements and documents, whether now or hereafter existing, executed in connection with the Indebtedness.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all present and future rents, revenues, income, issues, royalties, profits, and other benefits derived from the Property.

THIS MORTGAGE, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE RENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDEBTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THIS MORTGAGE AND THE RELATED DOCUMENTS. THIS MORTGAGE IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Mortgage, Grantor shall pay to Londer all amounts secured by this Mortgage as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations under this Mortgage.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Use. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Rants from the Property.

Duty to Maintain. Granior shall maintain the Property in tenantable condition and promptly perform all repairs, replacements, and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Hazardous Substances. The terms "hazardous waste," "hazardous substance," "disposal," "release," and "threatened release," as used in this Mortgage, shall have the same meanings as set forth in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9801, et seq. ("CERCLA"), the Superfund Amendments and Resultorization Act of 1988, Pub. L. No. 99–499 ("SARA"), the Hazardous Materials Transportation Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 1801, et seq., the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 6901, et seq., or other applicable state or Federal laws, rules, or regulations adopted pursuant to any of the foregoing. The terms "hazardous waste" and "hazardous substance" shall also include, without limitation, petroleum and petroleum by-products or any fraction thereof and asbestos. Grantor represents and warrants to Lander that: (a) During the period of Grantor's ownership of the Property, there has been no use, generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or threatened release of any hazardous waste or substance by any person on, under, or about the Property; (b) Grantor has no knowledge of, or reason to believe that there has been, except as previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing. (i) any use, generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release, or threatened release of any hazardous waste or substance by any prior owners or occupants of the Property or (li) any actual or threatened lingation or claims of any kind by

any person relating to such mattershand. (c) Except as previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing. (i) notither Grantor nor any tenant, contractor, agent or other latitionized fuser of the Property shall use, generate, manufacture, store, treat, dispose of, or release any hazardous waste or substance on, under, or about the Property and. (ii) any such activity shall be conducted in compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances, including without limitation those laws, regulations, and ordinances described above. Grantor authorizes Lender and its agents to enter upon the Property to make such inspections and basts, at Grantor's expense, as Lender may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this section of the Mortgage. Any inspections or tests made by Lender shall be for Lender's purposes only and shall not be construed to create any responsibility or liability on the part of Lender to Grantor or to any other person. The representations and warranties contained herein are based on Grantor's flips, diligence in investigating the Property for hazardous wasts. Grantor hereby (a) releases and waives any future claims against Lender-for indemptity or centribution in the event Grantor becomes liable for cleanup or other costs under any such laws, and (b) agrees to indemnify and half herefulls Lender against any and all claims, losses, liabilities, damages, penalties, and expenses which Lender may directly or indirectly statism or sufficient from a breach of this section of the Mortgage or as a consequence of any use, generation, manufacture, storage, disposal, release or five tests or out of the section of the Mortgage, including the obligation to indemnify, shall survive the payment of the Indebtedness and the satisfaction and reconveyance of the lien of this Mortgage and shall not be affected by Lender's acquisition of any interest in the Property, whether or not the same was or should have been inflowed to Grantor.

Nulsance, Waste. Grantor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit, permit, or suffer any stripping of or waste on or to the Property or any portion of the Property. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other party the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior written consent of Lender.

Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any Improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Lender. As a condition to the removal of any Improvements, Lender may require Grantor to make arrangements satisfactory to Lender to replace such Improvements of at least equal value.

Lender's Right to Enter. Lender and its agents and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all reasonable times to attend to Lender's interests and conditions of this Mortgage.

Compliance with Covirmmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations, now or hereafter in effect, of all governments, authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property, including without limitation, the //mericans With Disabilities Act. Grantor risk contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appricts so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long as, in Lender's sole opinion, Lender's Interests in the Frozer's are not jeopardized. Lender may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surety bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lender, to protest Lender's interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor agrees in all her to abandon nor leave unattended the Property. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

DUE ON SALE -- CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at its option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written conserve, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of Real Property or any right, title or interest therein; whether legal, beneficial or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, deed, installment sale colliract land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, ease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Real Property or by any other method of conveyance of Real Property interest. If any Grantor is a corporation, partnership or limited liability company, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-five percent (25 // of the voting stock, partnership interests or limited liability company interests, as the case may be, of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised. By Lender if such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by litinois law.

TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the town a and liens on the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to di linquency) all taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of tile Property, and shall pay when due all oldsims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall multiple, the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the lien of taxes and assetsments not due, except for the Existing Indebtedness referred to below, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any lax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lender's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lien rate a or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within fifteen (15) days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filed, within fifteen (15) days after fire iter has notice of the filing, secure the discharge of the lien, or if requested by Lender, deposit with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surely below or other security satisfactory to Lender in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs and attorneys' fees or other charges that could example as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien. In any contest, Grantor shall defend itself and Lender and shall satisfy any adverse judy ment before enforcement against the Property. Grantor shall name Lender as an additional obligee under any surety bond furnished in the contest proceedings.

Evidence of Psyment. Granior shall upon demand furnish to Lender satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lender at least fifteen (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's lien, materialmen's lien, or other lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials. Grantor will upon request of Lender furnish to Lender advance assurances satisfactor; (3) Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mor/grays.

Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount suidefant to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgages clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from such insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of thirty (30) days' prior written notice to be and not containing any disclaimer of the insurer's liability for faiture to give such notice. Should the Real Property at any time become tooked in an area designated by the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency as a special flood hazard area, Grantor agrees to obtain and maintain Federal Flood insurance, to the extent such insurance is required by Lender and is or becomes available, for the term of the loan and for the full unpaid principal balance of the loan, or the maximum limit of coverage that is available, whichever is less.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within filteen (15) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is impaired, Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness, payment of any item affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lender has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used first to pay any amount owing to Lender under this Mortgage, then to prepay accrued interest, and the remainder, if any, shall be applied to the principal balance of the Indebtedness. If Lender holds any proceeds after payment in full of the Indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor.

Unexpired insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Mortgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

Compliance with Existing Indebtedness. During the period in which any Existing Indebtedness described below is in effect, compliance with the Insurance provisions contained in the Instrument evidencing such Existing Indebtedness shall constitute compliance with the Insurance provisions under this Mortgage, to the extent compliance with the terms of this Mortgage would constitute a duplication of insurance requirement. If any proceeds from the insurance become payable on loss, the provisions in this Mortgage for division of proceeds shall apply only to the? portion of the proceeds not payable to the holder of the Existing Indebtedness.

Grantor's Report on Insurance. Upon request of Lender, however not more than once a year, Grantor shall furnish to Lender a report on each existing policy of insurance showing: (a) the name of the insurer; (b) the risks insured; (c) the amount of the policy; (d) the property insured, the then current replacement value of such property, and the manner of determining that value; and (e) the expiration date of the policy. Grantor shall, upon request of Lender, have an independent appraiser satisfactory to Lender determine the cash value replacement cost of the Property.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor falls to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, including any obligation to maintain Existing Indebtedness in good standing as required below, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will bear interest at the rate charged under the Note from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayment by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable on demand, (b) be added to the balance of the Note and be apportioned among and be payable with any

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installment payments to become due during either. (i) the term of any applicable insurance policy or. (ii) the remaining term of the Note, or. (c) be treated as a billion payment which will be due and payable at the Note's maturity. This Mortgage also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled an account of the default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construed as curing the default so as to bar Lender from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in les simple, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Real Property description or in the Existing Indebtedness section below or in any file insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion lessed in lever of, and accepted by, Lender in connection with this Mortgage, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Lander under this Mortgage, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lander shall be entitled to perficipate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Lander's own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lander such instruments as Lander may request from time to time to permit such participation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrants that the Property and Grantor's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

EXISTING INDESTEDNESS. The following provisions concerning existing indebtedness (the "Existing Indebtedness") are a part of this Mortgage.

Existing tilen. The lien of this Morigage securing the indebtedness may be secondary and inferior to the lien securing payment of an existing obligation to Burbank State Bank. The existing obligation has a current principal balance of approximately \$64,000.00 and is in the original principal amount of \$108,000.00. Grantor expressly coverants and agrees to pay, or see to the payment of, the Existing Indebtedness and to prevent any default in such indebtedness, any default under the instruments evidencing such indebtedness, or any default under any security documents for such indebtedness.

Default. If the payme is of any installment of principal or any interest on the Existing Indebtedness is not made within the time required by the note evidencing such indebtedness, or should a default occur under the instrument securing such indebtedness and not be cured during any applicable grace period inersin, then, at the option of Lender, the Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage shall become immediately due and payable, and this Mortgage shall be in default.

No Modification. Grantor about rist enter into any agreement with the holder of any mortgage, deed of trust, or other security agreement which has priority over this Mortgage by visich that agreement is modified, amended, extended, or renewed without the prior written consent of Lander. Grantor shall neither request nor a coupt any future advances under any such security agreement without the prior written consent of Lander.

CONDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to condemnation of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned by eminent domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in lieu of condemnation, Lender may at its explication require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. The participants of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees incurred by Lender in conne illon with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take auch steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be required by it from time to time to permit such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNM INTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions relating to governmental taxes, fees and charges are a part of this Mortgage:

Current Taxes, Fees and Charges. Upon request by Lender Grantor shall execute such documents in addition to this Mortgage and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's lian on the Real Property. Grantor shall reinibures Lender for all taxes, as described below, together with all expenses incurred in recording or continuing this Mortgage, including without limitation all taxes, fees, documentary stamps, and other charges for recording or registring this Mortgage.

Taxes. The following shall constitute taxes to which this section applies: (a) a specific tax upon this type of Mortgage or upon all or any part of the Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage; (b) a specific tax on Grantor which Grantor is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by this type of Mortgage; (c) a tax on this type of Mortgage chargeable against the Lender or the holder of the Note; and (d) a specific tax on all or any portion of the Indebtedness or on payments of pilosipal and Interest made by Grantor.

Subsequent Taxes, if any lox to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the delp of this Mortgage, this ovent shall have the same effect as an Event of Default (as defined below), and Lender may exercise any or all of "s rivalable remedies for an Event of Default as provided below unless Grantor either (a) pays the tax before it becomes delinquant, or (b) contarts the tax as provided above in the Taxes and Liens section and deposits with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security substantially to Lender.

SECURITY AGREEMENT; FINANCING STATEMENTS. The following provisions relating to this fact sage as a security agreement are a part of this Mortgage.

Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes or other personal property, and Lender shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code as amended from time to time.

Security Interest. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's security interest in the Rents and Personal Property. In addition to recording the Mortgage in the real property records, Lender may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, the executed counterparts, copies or reproductions of this Mortgage as a financing statement. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all expanses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property in a manner and at a place reasonably convenient to Grantor and Lender and make it available to Lender within three (3) days after receipt of written demand from Lender.

Addresses. The mailing addresses of Grantor (debtor) and Lender (secured party), from which information concerning the security interest granted by this Mortgage may be obtained (each as required by the Uniform Commercial Code), are as stated on the first page of this Mortgage.

FURTHER ASSURANCES: ATTORNEY-IN-FACT. The following provisions relating to further assurances and altorney-in-fact are a part of this Mortgage.

Further Assurances. At any time, and from time to time, upon request of Lender, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Lender's designee, and when requested by Lender, ocuse to be Med, recorded, refiled, or rerecorded, as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and places as Lender may deem appropriate, any and all such mortgages, deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, continuation statements, instruments of further assurance, certificates, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Lender, be necessary or destrable in order to effectuate, complete, perfect, continue, or preserve (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Note, this Mortgage, and the Related Documents, and (b) the tiens and security interests created by this Mortgage on the Property, whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Grantor. Unless prohibited by law or agreed to the contrary by Lender in writing, Grantor shall relimburse Lender for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the matters referred to in this paragraph.

Attorney-in-Fact. If Grantor falls to do any of the things referred to in the preceding paragraph, Lender may do so for and in the name of Grantor and at Grantor's expense. For such purposes, Grantor hereby trevocably appoints Lender as Grantor's attorney-in-fact for the purpose of making, executing, delivering, filing, recording, and doing all other things as may be necessary or desirable, in Lender's sole opinion, to accomplish the matters referred to in the preceding paragraph.

FULL PERFORMANCE. Breaches. Any warranty, representation or statement made or furnished to Lender by or on behalf of Grantor under this Mortgage, the Note or the Related Documents is, or at the time made or furnished was, false in any material respect.

inacivency. The insolvency of Grantor, appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency taws by or against Grantor, or the dissolution or termination of Grantor's existence as a going business (if Grantor is a business). Except to the extent prohibited by federal law or thinois law, the death of Grantor (if Grantor is an individual) also shall constitute an Event of Datault under this Mortgage.

Forectosure, Forfetture, etc. Commencement of foreclosure or forfetture proceedings, whether by judicial proceeding, self-help, repossession or any other method, by any creditor of Grantor or by any governmental agency against any of the Property. However, this subsection shall not apply in the event of a good faith dispute by Grantor as to the validity or reasonableness of the claim which is the basis of the foreclosure or forefellure proceeding, provided that Grantor gives Lender written notice of such claim and furnishes reserves or a surely bond for the claim satisfactory to Lender.

Breach of Other Agreement. Any breach by Grantor under the terms of any other agreement between Grantor and Lender that is not remedied within any grace period provided therein, including without limitation any agreement concerning any indebtedness or other obligation of Grantor to Lender, whether existing now or later.

Existing Indebtedness. A default shall occur under any Existing Indebtedness or under any Instrument on the Property securing any Existing Indebtedness, or commencement of any suit or other action to foreutose any existing flen on the Property.

Events Affecting Guerantor. Any of the preceding events occurs with respect to any Guerantor of any of the Indebtedness or such Guerantor dies or becomes incompetent.

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter, Lander, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the coloning rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in ren on, by agent, or through a receiver.

Mortgages in Possession. Lender shull have the right to be placed as mortgages in possession or to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with inc power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness. The mortgages in possession or receiver may save without bond it permitted by law. Lender's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apparent value of the Property excelled the Indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lender shall not disquality a person from serving as a receiver.

Judicial Forectosure. Lender may obtain a judicial decrea fureclosing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Property.

Deficiency Judgment. It permitted by applicable law, Len ier may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of till e rights provided in this section.

Other Remedies. Lender shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Morigage or the Note or available at law or in equity.

Sale of the Property. To the extent parmitted by applicable law, fire for hereby waives any and all right to have the property marshalled. In exercising its rights and remedies, Lender shall be tree to sell all or any port of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Lender shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any pontour. The Property.

Notice of Sale. Lender shall give Granior reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property (4 in be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ion (10) days before the time of the sale or disposition.

Watver; Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of it is Micrigage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other playsion. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expanditures or take action to nerform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Lender's right to declare a default and exercise its remedies under this Mortgage.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Lender institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees, at trial and on any appeal. ""insther or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender that in Lender's opinion are necessary at any time for the projection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the fals of expenditure unit repaid at the Note rate. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without limitation, however subject to any limits under applicable law, Lender's attorneys' fees and Lender's legal exponses whether or not there is a leweuit, including attorneys' less for bankruptcy proceedings (including efforts to modity or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), appeals and any anticipated post-judgment collection services, it is could of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foredesure reports), surveyors' reports, and appraisal fees, and title insurance, to the art into services by applicable law.

Annual Reports. If the Property is used for purposes other than Grantor's residence, Grantor shall furnish to Lender, upon request, a certified statement of net operating income received from the Property during Grantor's previous fiscal year in such form and detail as Lender shall require. "Net operating income" shall mean all cash receipts from the Property less all cash expenditures made in connection with the operation of the Property.

Applicable Law. This Mortgage has been delivered to Lender and accepted by Lender in the State of Illinois. This Mortgage shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.

Caption Headings. Caption headings in this Mortgage are for convenience purposes only and are not to be used to interpret or define the provisions of this Mortgage.

Merger. There shall be no merger of the interest or estate created by this Mortgage with any other interest or estate in the Property at any time held by or for the benefit of Lender in any capacity, without the written consent of Lender.

Multiple Parties. All obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage shall be joint and several, and all references to Grantor shall mean each and every Grantor. This means that each of the persons signing below is responsible for all obligations in this Mortgage.

Severability. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provision of this Morigage to be invalid or unenforceable as to any person or of coumstance, such finding shall not render that provision invalid or unenforceable as to any other persons or droumstances. If feasible, any such offending provision shall be deemed to be modified to be within the limits of enforceability or validity; however, if the offending provision cannot be so modified, it shall be stricken and all other provisions of this Morigage in all other respects shall remain valid and enforceable.

Successors and Assigns. Subject to the limitations stated in this Mortgage on transfer of Grantor's Interest, this Mortgage shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns. If ownership of the Property becomes vested in a person other than Grantor,

Walvers and Consents. Lender shall not be deemed to have waived any rights under this Mortgage (or under the Related Documents) unless such waiver is in writing and signed by Lender. No delay or omission on the part of Lender in exercising any right shall operate as a weiver of such right or any other right. A waiver by any party of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand shick compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior waiver by Lender, nor any course of dealing between Lender and Grantor, shall constitute a waiver of any of Lender's rights or any of Grantor's obligations as to any future transactions. Whenever consent by Lender is required in this Mortgage, the granting of such consent by Lender in any instance shall not constitute continuing consent to subsequent instances where such consent is required.
