the north 20 feet of Lot 25 in Block 52 in Notre Dame Addition to South Chicago, being a subdivision of the south three quarters of fractional Section 7, Township 37 North, Range 15 East of the Third Principal Meridian,

as colored in yellow and indicated by the words "To Be Dedicated" on the aforementioned drawing.

SECTION 3. The City of Chicago hereby reserves for the benefit of Commonwealth Edison Company, Ameritech and Chicago Cable T.V. their successors or assigns, an easement to operate, maintain, construct, replace, and renew overhead poles, wires, and associated equipment and underground conduit, cables, and associated equipment for the transmission and distribution of electrical energy and telephonic and associated services under, over, and along that part of public alley as herein vacated, with the right of ingress and egress.

SECTION 4. The vacation herein provided for is made upon the passage of this ordinance, Krishan Chand, Krishna Pahuja and the South Folland Trust and Savings Bank, as Trustee, Trust Number 9260, shall pay or cause to be paid to the City of Chicago as compensation for the benefits which will accrue to the owners of the property abutting said part of public alley hereby vacated, the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$2,500.00), which sum in the judgment of this body will be equal to such benefits; and further, shall within ninety (90) days after the passage of this ordinance, deposit in the City Treasury of the City of Chicago a sum sufficient to defray the costs of removing, paving and curb returns and constructing sidewalk and curbs across the entrance to that part of public alley hereby vacated, similar to the sidewalk and curbs in East 106th Street and constructing paving and curbs in and to the alley herein dedicated. The



precise amount of the sum so deposited shall be ascertained by the Commissioner of Transportation after such investigation as is requisite.

SECTION 5. The vacation herein provided for is made upon the express condition that within 90 days after the passage of this ordinance, Krishan Chand, Krishna Pahuje and the South Holland Trust and Savings Bank, as Trustee, Trust Number 9:60 shall file or cause to be filed for record in the Office of the Recorder of Decds of Cook County, Illinois, a certified copy of this ordinance, together with an attached drawing approved by the Superintendent of Maps.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.


