- 8. Mortgage insurance. If Lender required mortgage insurance as a condition of making the loan secured by this Security Instrument, Borrower shall pay the premiums required to maintain the mortgage insurance in effect. If, for any reason, the average insurance coverage required by Lender lapses or ceases to be in effect, Borrower shall pay the premiums required to obtain coverage substantially equivalent to the mortgage insurance previously in effect, at a cost substantially equivalent to the cost to Borrower of the mortgage insurance previously in effect, from an alternate mortgage insurance approved by Lender. If substantially equivalent mortgage insurance coverage is not available, Borrower shall pay to Lender each month a sum equal to one-twelfth of the yearly mortgage insurance premium being paid by Borrower when the insurance coverage lapsed or ceased to be in effect. - 9. Inspection. Lender or its agent may make reasonable entries upon and inspections of the Property. Lender shall give Borrower notice at the time of or prior to an inspection specifying reasonable cause for the inspection.
- 10. Condemnation. The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, in connection with any condemnation or other taking of any part of the Property, or for conveyance in lieu of condemnation, are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender.

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In the event of a total taking of the Property, the proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due, with any excess paid to Borrower. In the event of a partial taking of the Property in which the fair market value of the Property immediately before the taking is equal to or greater than the amount of the sums secured by this Security Instrument immediately before the taking, unless Borrower and Lender otherwise agree in writing, the sums secured by this Security Instrument shall be reduced by the amount of the proceeds multiplied by the following fraction: (a) the total amount of the sums secured immediately before the taking, divided by (b) the fair market value of the Property immediately before the taking is less than the amount of the sums secured immediately before the taking, unless Borrower and Lender otherwise agree in writing or unless applicable law otherwise provides, the proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument whether or not the sums are then due.

Any forbearance by Lender in exercising any right or correly shall not be a waiver of or preclude the exercise of any right or remedy.
- 12. Successors of a passigns Bound; Joint and Several Liability; Co-signers. The covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument shall bind and one in the successors and assigns of Lender and Borrower, subject to the provisions of paragraph 17. Borrower's covenants and agreements shall be joint and several. Any Borrower who co-signs this Security Instrument but does not execute the Note:
  (a) is co-signing this Security Instrument; only to mortgage, grant and convey that Borrower's interest in the Property under the terms of this Security Instrument; (b) is not persocally obligated to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument; and (c) agrees that Lender and any other Borrower may agree to extend, we say, forbear or make any accommodations with regard to the terms of this Security Instrument or the Note without that Borrower's consent.
- 13. Loan Charges. If the loan secured by this Security Instrument is subject to a law which sets maximum loan charges, and that law is finally interpreted so that the interest or other han tharges collected or to be collected in connection with the loan exceed the permitted limits, then: (a) any such loan charge shall be reduced by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limit; and (b) any sums already collected from Borrower which exceeded permitted limits will be refunded to Borrower. Lender may choose to make this refund by reducing the principal owed under the Note or by making r direct payment to Borrower. If a refund reduces principal, the reduction will be treated as a partial prepayment without any prepayment charge under the Note.
- 14. Notices. Any notice to Borrower provided for in this Security Instrument shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first class mail unless applicable law requires use of another method. The non-e shall be directed to the Property Address or any other address Borrower designates by notice to Lender. Any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein or any other address Lender designates by notice to Borrower. Any notice provides for in this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given as provided in this paragraph.
- 15. Governing Law; Severability. This Security Instrument shall be governed by federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the York which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to be severable,
  - 16. Borrower's Copy. Borrower shall be given one conformed copy of the Note and of this Security Instrument.
- 17. Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial interest in Borrower. If all or any prit of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Lender's prior written consent. Lender may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Security Instrument.

If Lender exercises this option, Lender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration. - 18. Borrower's Right to Reinstate. Those conditions are that Borrower: (a) pays Lender all sums which then would be due under aris Security Instrument and the Note as if no acceleration had occurred; (b) cures any default of any other covenants or agreements; (c) pays—is expenses incurred in enforcing this Security Instrument, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys\* fees; and (d) takes such action as Lender may reasonably require to assure that the lien of this Security Instrument, Lender's rights in the Property and Borrower's obligation to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument shall continue unchanged. Upon reinstatement by Borrower, this Security Instrument and the obligations secured hereby shall remain fully effective as if no acceleration had occurred. THIS ADJUSTABLE RATE RIDER is made this 24th day of August, 1994 , and is incorporated into and shall be desmed to amend and supplement the Nortgage, Deed of Trust or Security Deed (the "Security Instrument") of the same date given by the undersigned (the "Borrower") to secure Borrower's Adjustable Rate Note (the "Note") to

HARRIS BANK WILMETTE, N.A.

THE NOTE CONTAINS PROVISIONS ALLOWING FOR CHANGES IN THE INTEREST RATE AND THE MONTHLY PAYMENT. THE NOTE LIMITS THE AMOUNT THE BORROWER'S ADJUSTABLE INTEREST RATE CAN CHANGE AT ANY ONE TIME AND THE MAXIMUM RATE THE BORROWER MUST PAY. THE NOTE ALSO CONTAINS THE OPTION TO CONVERT THE ADJUSTABLE RATE TO A FIXED RATE.

ADDITIONIAL COVENANTS. In addition to the covenants and agreements made in the Security Instrument, Borrower and Certain further covenant and agree as follows:

#### A. ADJUSTABLE RATE AND MONTHLY PAYMENT CHANGES

The Note provides for an initial interest rate of 6.625 in the adjustable interest rate and the monthly payments, as follows:

#### 4. ADJUSTABLE INTEREST RATE AND MONTHLY PAYMENT CHANGES

#### (A) Change Dates

The adjustable interest rate; will pay may change on the first day of September, 1995 , and on that day every 12th month thereafter. Each date on which my adjustable interest rate could change is called a "Change Date."

#### (B) The Index

Beginning with the first Change Dite my adjustable interest rate will be based on an Index. The "Index" is the weekly average yield on United States I was ury securities adjusted to a constant maturity of 1 year, as made available by the Federal Reserve Board. The max' recent Index figure available as of the date 45 days before each Change Date is called the "Current Index."

If the Index is no longe available, the No.e Yolder will choose a new index which is based upon comparable information. The Note Holder will give me notice of this choice.

#### (C) Calculation of Changes

Before each Change Date, the Note Holder will calculate my new interest rate by adding

Two and Three Quarters

percentage points ( 2.750 %) to the Current Index.

The Note Holder will then round the result of this addition to the nearest one-eighth of one percentage point (0.125%). Subject to the limits stated in Section 4(D) below, this rounded amount will be my new interest rate

until the next Change Date.

The Note Holder will then determine the amount of the monthly navme it that would be sufficient to repay the unpaid principal that I am expected to one at the Change Date in full on the meturity date at my new interest rate in substantially equal payments. The result of this calculation will be the less amount of my monthly payment.

#### (D) Limits on Interest Rate Changes

The interest rate I am required to pay at the first Change Date will not be greater than 8.625 % or less than 4.625 %. Thereafter, my adjustable interest rate will not be greater than 8.625 % or less than 4.625 %. Thereafter, my adjustable interest rate will not be greater than 6.625 % or less than 4.625 %. Thereafter, my adjustable interest rate will not be greater than 6.625 % percentage points (2.000 %) from the rate of interest I have been paying for the preceding 12 months. My interest rate will never be greater than 6.625 %, which is called the "Maximum Rate".

#### (E) Effective Date of Changes

My new interest rate will become effective each Change Date. I will pay the amount or ay new monthly payment beginning on the first monthly payment date after the Change Date until the amount of my monthly payment changes again.

#### (F) Notice of Changes

The Note Holder will deliver or mail to me a notice of any changes in my adjustable interest rate and the amount of my monthly payment before the effective date of any change. The notice will include information required by law to be given me and also the title and telephone number of a person who will ensure any question I may have regarding the notice.

#### R. FIXED INTEREST RATE OPTION

The Note provides for the Borrower's option to convert from an adjustable interest rate with interest rate limits to a fixed interest rate, as follows:

#### 5. FIXED INTEREST RATE CONVERSION OPTION

#### (A) Option to Convert to Fixed Rate

I have a Conversion Option which I can exercise unless I am in default or this Section 5A will not permit me to do so. The "Conversion Option" is my option to convert the interest rate I am required to pay by this Note from an adjustable rate with interest rate limits to a fixed rate calculated under Section 5(8) below.

The conversion can only take place on a date(s) specified by the Note Holder during the period beginning on the first Change Date and ending on the fifth Change Date. Each date on which my adjustable interest rate can convert to the new fixed rate is called the "Conversion Date."

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If I want to exercise the Conversion Option, I must first meet certain conditions. Those conditions are that: (i) I must give the Note Holder notice that I want to do so; (ii) on the Conversion Date, I must not be in default under the Note or the Security Instrument; (iii) by a date specified by the Note Holder, I must pay the Note Holder a conversion fee of U.S.S 250.00; and (iv) I must sign and give the Note Holder any documents the Note Holder requires to effect the conversion.

#### (B) Calculation of Fixed Rate

My new, fixed interest rate will be equal to the Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation's required net yield as of a date and time of day specified by the Note Holder for (i) if the original term of this Note is greater than 15 years, 30-year fixed rate mortgages covered by applicable 60-day mendatory delivery commitments, plus three-eighths of one percentage point (0.375%), rounded to the nearest one-eighth of one percentage point (0.125%), or (ii) if the original term of this Note is 15 years or less, 15-year fixed rate mortgages covered by applicable 60-day mandatory delivery commitments, plus three-eighths of one percentage point (0.375%), rounded to one-eighth of one percentage point (0.125%). the nearest

If this required net yield cannot be determined because the applicable commitments are not available, the Note Holder will determine my interest rate by using comparable information. My new rate calculated under this Section 5(B) will

not be greater than the Maximum Rate stated in Section 4(D) above.
(C) New Payment Amount and Effective Date

If I choose to exercise the Conversion Option, the Note Holder will determine the amount of the monthly payment that would be sufficient to repay the unpaid principal I am expected to one on the Conversion Date in full on the maturicy date at my new fixed interest rate in substantially equal payments. The result of this celculation will be the new amount of my monthly payment. Beginning with my first monthly payment after the Conversion Date, 1 will pay the new amount as my monthly payment until the maturity date.

#### C. TRANSFER OF THE PROPERTY OR A BENEFICIAL INTEREST IN BORROWER

1. Until Boyrowar exercises the Conversion Option under the conditions stated in Section B of this Adjustable Rate Rider, Uniform Commant 17 of the Security Instrument is amended to read as follows:

Transfer of the Property or a Be reficial Interest in Borrower. If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (n) if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Lender's prior written consent, Lender may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Society Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Security Instrument. Lender also shall not exercise this option if: (a) Borrower causes to be submitted to Lender information required by Lender to evaluate the intended transferee as if a new loan were being made to the transferee; and (b) Lender reasonably determines that Lender's security will not be impaired by the loan assumption and that the risk of a breach of any covenant or agree-

ment in this Security Instrument is accepted a to lender.

To the extent permitted by applicable to Lender may charge a reasonable fee as a condition to Lender's to the loan assumption. Lender may also require the transferee to sign an assumption agreement that is acceptable to Lender and that obligates the transfer a to keep all the promises and agreements made in the Note and in this Security Instrument. Borrower will continue to be obligated under the Note and this Security Instrument unless Lender releases Borrower in writing.

If Lender exercises the option to require immediate rayment in full, Lender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration. The notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is delivered or mailed within which Borrower must pay all sums secured by thir sicurity Instrument. If Borrower fails to pay these sums prior to the expiration of this period, Lender may invoke by, remedies permitted by this Security Instrument without further notice or demand on Borrower.

2. If Borrower exercises the Conversion Option under the exactions stated in Section 8 of this Adjustable Rate Rider, the amendment to Uniform Covenant 17 of the Security In trument contained in Section C1 above shall then cease to be in effect, and the provisions of Uniform Covenant 17 of the Security Instrument shall instead be in effect, as tollows:

Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower.

If all or any percontine Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Lender's prior written consent, Lender may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option (half not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Security Instrument.

If Lender exercises this option, Lender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration.
