# UNOFFICIAL COPY

IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED between the parties hereto, to the intent and purpose of this trust, to be hereby conveyed to the beneficiary interest under this trust, that the interest of any beneficiary hereunder shall consist of the full present and future income and profits of the said real estate and to manage, control and real estate as hereunder provided, and the right to receive the proceeds from rents, and from mortgages, sales or other disposition of said real estate, and that in the event of the death of any beneficiary hereunder, death to be deemed to be personal property, and may be assigned and transferred as such, that on the death of any beneficiary hereunder, during the existence of this trust, his or her right and interest hereunder shall, except as herein otherwise specially provided, pass to his or her executor or administrator, and not to his or her heirs at law, and that no beneficiary hereunder at any time shall have any right, title or interest in or to any portion of said real estate, or any other legal or equitable, but only in the earnings, assets and proceeds as aforesaid. Nothing herein contained shall be construed as imposing any obligation on the trustee to file any income, profit or other tax reports or schedules, it being expressly understood that the beneficiaries hereunder from time to time will individually make all such reports and pay any and all taxes growing out of their interest under this Trust Agreement. The death of any beneficiary hereunder shall not terminate the trust nor in any manner affect the powers of the Trustee hereunder. Any assignment of any beneficial interest hereunder shall be binding on the Trustee until the original or a duplicate copy of the assignment in such form as the Trustee may approve is lodged with the Trustee and its acceptance indicated thereon, and the reasonable fees of the Trustee for the acceptance thereof paid, and every assignment of any beneficial interest hereunder, the original or duplicate of which shall not have been lodged with the Trustee, shall be void as to all subsequent assignees or purchasers without notice.

In case said Trustee shall be required in its discretion to make any advances of money on account of this trust or shall be made a party to any litigation on account of holding title to said real estate or in connection with this trust, or in case said Trustee shall be compelled to pay any sum of money on account of this trust, whether on account of breach of contract, injury to person or property, fines or penalties under any law, judgments or decrees, or otherwise, or in case the Trustee shall find it necessary on account of this trust, to consult or retain counsel and shall thereby incur attorneys' fees, or in the event the Trustee shall be compelled to place a claim insurance for its protection hereunder, the beneficiaries hereunder do hereby jointly and severally agree as follows: (1) that they will on demand pay to the said Trustee, with interest thereon at the rate of 10% per annum, all such disbursements or advances or payments made by said Trustee, together with its expenses, including reasonable attorneys' fees; (2) that the said Trustee shall not be required to convey or otherwise deal with said property at any time held hereunder until all of said disbursements, payments, advances and expenses made or incurred by said Trustee shall have been fully paid, together with interest thereon as aforesaid; and (3) that in case of non-payment within ten (10) days after demand said Trustee may sell all or any part of said real estate at public or private sale on such terms as it may see fit, and retain from the proceeds of said sale a sufficient sum to reimburse itself for all such disbursements, payments, advances and interest thereon and expenses, including the attorneys' fees of such sale and attorneys' fees, rendering the surplus of any sale to the beneficiaries who are entitled there to. However, nothing herein contained shall be construed as requiring the Trustee to advance or pay out any money on account of this trust or to prosecute or defend any legal proceeding involving this trust or any property or interest thereunder. The sole duty of the Trustee with reference to any such legal proceeding shall be to give timely notice thereof to the beneficiaries hereunder after the Trustee is served with process therein and to bring such legal proceeding to be brought or defended in its name, provided that it shall be indemnified in respect thereto in a manner satisfactory to it.

Notwithstanding anything hereinbefore contained, the Trustee, at any time and without notice of any kind, may resign as to all or part of the trust property if the trust property or any part thereof is used, or the use thereof is authorized or contemplated, for any purpose (including, but not limited to, the use at wholesale, retail or otherwise, giving away, or other disposition of intoxicating liquors of any kind, or as a tavern, liquor store or other establishment for the sale of intoxicating liquors for use or consumption on the premises or otherwise, or for any purpose which may be within the scope of the Dram Shop Act of Illinois or any similar law of any State in which the trust property or any part thereof may be located), such in the opinion of the Trustee, may subject the Trustee, within its sole determination, to embarrassment, insecurity, liability, hazard or litigation. Such resignation as to all or part of the trust property shall be fully effected by the conveyance of the trust property, or the part thereof, to which the Trustee desires to resign the trust hereunder, by the Trustee to the beneficiaries in accordance with their respective interests hereunder. The Trustee notwithstanding any resignation hereunder, shall continue to have a first lien on the trust property, for its costs, expenses and attorneys' fees and for its reasonable compensation.

This Trust Agreement shall not be placed on record in the Recorder's Office or filed in the office of the Registrar of Titles of the County in which the real estate is situated, or elsewhere, and the recording of the name shall not be considered as notice of the rights of any person hereunder, derogatory to the title or powers of said Trustee.
