AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this 20 day of 222.

A.D. 1976, by and between the STATE OF ILLINOIS, acting by and through its DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, hereinafter called the STATE, the COUNTY OF COOK of the State of Illinois, hereinafter called the COUNTY, and the VILLAGE OF NORTHBROOK, acting through its PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES, hereinafter called the VILLAGE.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, there presently exist three (3) separate sections of frontage road along the vesterly side of the Edens Expressway (FAI Route 94 and U.S. Route 41) between Lake-Cook Road and Sunset Ridge Road in the Village of Northbrook, Cook County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, said sections of frontage road are identified and described as follows:

A. <u>Dennis Drive</u>, from its connection with Vermont Avenue (approximately 300 feet south of Like-Cook Road) south-easterly to a point just north of the Tri-State Tollway Spur (FAI Route 94), and thence westerly to an intersection with Skokie Road.

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- B. <u>Henrici Drive</u>, from its intersection with Skokie Road (just south of the Tri-State Tollway Spur, upposite Northwood Drive) easterly and southeasterly to its connection with Elmwood Avenue (at Lincoln Drive), thence south along <u>Elmwood Avenue</u> to an intersection with Dundee Road (Illinois Route 68) just east of Skokie Road;
- C. Sunset Ridge Road, from its intersection with Skokic Road (approximately 0.2 mile south of Dundee Road) northerly to a point just south of Dundee Road, and thence westerly to a second intersection with Skokic Road, said section to be identified as "Sunset Ridge Road (Morth);

and

WHEREAS, under the terms of a Joint Agreement dated June 19, 1952, by and between the SCNTE, the COUNTY and the City of Chicago (a copy of which is attached hereto as "Exhibit A"), said sections of frontage road are presently under the jurisdiction and control of the STATE and/or the COUNTY, and are being maintained by the COUNTY; and

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE is desirous of assuming jurisdiction, control and maintenance of said sections of frontage road and the STATE and COUNTY have indicated willingness to approve such a cransfer of responsibilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

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- of this Agreement by all parties hereto, to promptly adopt an appropriate ordinance adding the sections of frontage road known as "Dennis Drive", "Henrici Drive Elmwood Avenue" and "Sunsat Ridge Road (North)", as hereinabove identified and described, to its municipal street system, said ordinance to be similar in format to the sample attached hereto as "Exhibit B", and to promptly forward one (1) certified copy each of said ordinance to the STATE and the COUNTY.
- 2. The STATE and the COUNTY jointly agree to relinquish to the VILLAGE, on the date of adoption of the Aforementioned ordinance by the VILLAGE, all jurisuitation and control of the sections of frontage road known as "Dennis Orive", "Henrici Drive Elmwood Avenue" and "Sunset Ridge Road (North)".
- 3. The COUNTY agrees to relinquish to the VILLAGE, on the date of adeption of the aforementioned ordinance by the VILLAGE, all maintenance responsibilities for the sections of frontage road known as "Dennis Drive", "Henrici Drive Elmwood Avenue" and "Sunset Ridge Road (North)".
- 4. The parties hereto agree to extend the provisions of this Agreement to Vermont Avenue, from its intersection with Skokie Road easterly to its connection with Dennis Drive, in the event and upon completion of currently proposed Lake-Cook Road and Edens Expressway improvements which will replace said portion of Vermont Avenue as part of the direct access from Skokie Road to southbound Edens Expressway.

Comprohensive Superhighmay System within the city of Chicago and in Gook County outside of the city of Chicago, as adopted by ordinances of the City Council and resolutions of the Board of Commissioners of Cook County and approved by the State, have been agreed by the parties hereto to be necessary highway improvements for the relief of congested traffic conditions in the Chicago Metropolitan Area and for safety and the acceleration of traffic movement in and through said area;

West Koute (Congress Street Superhighusy) from Lake Shore Drive to Cook-Durage County line.

West Route (Lake Street Connection) from a point on the Yout Route (Congress Street Superhighery) and extending in the Village of Hillside, Cook County, Illinois, in a northwesterly direction to a point on Lake Street near its intersection with the Cook-DuPage County line, described as follows:

Doginning at a point on the Congress Street Cuporhighway (Q.A.R. \$62) caid point being in the northeast quarter of Coetien 16.
Township 39 north, Range 12 cast of the Fri P.M., and thence running in a general northwesterly direction on a curve in the north half of Coetien 16 and the south half of Section 7 to a point on or near the west line of Coek County, and thence in a general northerly direction on or near said west line of Coek County, said line being in the west half of fractional Coetiens 7 and 6. Township 39 North, Range 12 cant of the 3rd P.H., to a sennection with Lake atreat (B.B.1. Boginning at a point in Section 33 at the city limits of the City of Chicago (Devon Avenus), Township 41 north, Range 13 east of the 3rd P.M., and extending thence northorly and northwesterly through Sections 33, 28, 29, 20, 21, 17, 16 and 9, Township 41 north, Range 13 east of the 3rd P.M. To the north line of Niles Township and continuating in a northorly and northwesterly direction through Sections 31, 30 and 19, Township 42 north, Range 13 east of the 3rd P.M. to the west line of Now Trier Township and continuing in a northwesterly direction through Sections 24, 13, 12, 11, 1 and 2. Township 42 north, Range 12 east of the 3rd P.M. to a point on the Lake-Gook County line;

Morthwest Superhighway from city limits of Chicago at S. Canfield Head to a connection with the Tri-Dtate Highway (Houte 83), described as follows:

Boginning at a point on Canfield Road in Bostion 1, Township 40 North, Range 12 east of the 3rd P.H. in the City of Chicago and thence in a northwester-ly direction through Sections 2, 3 and 4, Township 40 north, Range 12 east of the 3rd P.H. and continuing in a northwesterly direction through Sections 33, 32 and 31, Township 41 morth, Range 12 east, and continuing in a northwesterly direction through Sections 36, 26 and 28, Township 41 north, Range 11 east of the 3rd P.H. to a connocation with the Tri-State SuperMichway, Route 83;

Wacker Drive Extension (Fooder to Congress Street) from W. Jongress Street to W. Lake Street;

Southwast Routo (I.& H. Canal) from the interaction of said routo with the South Routo of the Comprohensive Superhighway System near W. 24th Street in the off; of Chicago and extending southwesterly to a point on the city limits of Chicago between 5. Lamon and C. LaGrosse Avenuos:

Illinois and Hichigan Ganal Route from the city limits of Chicago between S. Lamon and S. LaGrosse Avenues southwesterly to approximately the intersection with Laundale Avenue, together with a connection with 55th Street in Euralt and a connection with Route V.S. 66 in McGook, described as follows:

From the city limits of Chicago between 5. Lamon and 0. LaGrosse Avenues southwesterly to approximately the intersection with Laundale Avenue, together with a connection with 55th Street in Cummit and a connection with Route U.S. 66 in Negleok;

South Route from the intercection of said route with the West Route (Congress Street) between S. Halsted Street and S. Deeplaines Street and extending southerly and southwesterly to an intersection with W. 119th Street between S. Ashland Avenue and the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railroad; and a branch thereof extending easterly along the general location of E. 100th Street between S. State Street and S. Stony Island Avenue and caushorly along S. Stony Island Avenue, S. Dety Avenue, and S. Dety Avenue extended to an intersection with U. 13Cth Street on the south corporate limit of Chicago;

Galumot Superhighway from E. 138th Street in the city of of the Cook-Will County line, described as applications:

Posinning at a point on 136th Stroot at the city limits of the City of Chicago near the Couthoust corner of Section 35, Journalip 37 north, Range 14 east of the 3rd P.M.; thence is a couthorly direction along the east line of Sections 2 and 11 and through the east half of Sections 2 and 11 and through the east half of Sections 14, 23, 26 and 35, Township 36 north, Range 14 east of the 3rd P.M. to a point on 163rd Stroit near the south east corner of the couthwest quester of said Section 35; thence continuing in a couthorly direction through the east half of Sections 2, 11 and 14, Township 35 north, Hange 14 east of the 3rd P.M. to a point at the intersection of Stony Island Avenue and the north line of said Section 23; mear the northeast corner of said Section 23; thence continuing in a southerly direction along the east line of Sections 23, 26 and 35, Your-ship 35 north, Range 14 cast of the 3rd P.M., to a point on the Vill-Sect Sounty 1:no;

Tri-State Superhighway from the Calume: Euperhighway casterly to the Indiana State line, described as follows:

Doginning at the intersection or the Tri-State Duporhighway and Calumot Euperhighway in the couthonet quarter of Section 26, Tounghip 36 north, Range 14 east of the 3rd P.M., and continuing in an easterly direction through Section: 26 and 25, Tounghip 36 north, Range 14 east of the 3rd P.M., and continuing in an easterly direction through Ecotions 30 and 29, Tounghip 36 north, Range 15 east of the 3rd P.M. to a point on the Indiana Otate line:

Tri-Diato Euporhighway from Kodzio Avenue (Route 054) eastorly to the Univer Euporhighway, described as follows:

Doginning at a point on Kedele Avenue at or near the east and uset quarter line of Beetlen 25, Tetmohip 36 North, range 13 Mast of the 3rd P.H., and continuing in an easterly direction along or near the east and west quarter line of Section 25, Township 36 north, Range 13 east of the 3rd P.H., thence canterly along or near the east and west quarter line of Dections 30, 29, 28 and 27, Tetmohip 36 north, Range 14 east of the 3rd P.H. to a point 143 feet east of Chicago Read in the Couthoust quarter of Beetlen 27, thence extending

in a southeasterly and easterly direction in the south half of Section 27 and 26, Township 36 north, Range 14 east of the 3rd P.M., to the intersection of the Calumet Superhighway;

WHEREAS, The maintenance, repair and operation of the aforesaid portions of the Comprehensive Superhighway System will be of great and lasting benefit to the people of the entire State of Illinois and the County of Cook as well as the City of Chicago;

WHEREAS. Under the road and bridge laws of the State of Illinots, all of the Comprehensive Superhighway System described herein is in a classification that requires the maintenance thereof to be performed by the State;

WHEREAS, The aforesid portions of the Comprehensive Superhighway System are comprised of State-Aid roads or extensions thereof within the corporate limits of a city, village or town and/or State highways, arterial streets or thoroughfares, in conformity with all applicable laws;

WHEREAS, In accordance with the provisions of the Motor Fuel Tax Law of the State of Illinois any County may by resolution of the County Board with the approval of the Department of Public Works and Buildings, use monies allotted to it under the said law for the purpose of improving, constructing, reconstructing or maintaining State-Aid roads and the extensions thereof within the corporate limits of any city, village or town;

WHEREAS, In accordance with the provisions of the Motor Fuel Tax Law a municipality may use monies allotted to it under the said law for the construction, reconstruction and maintenance of State highways, arterial streets or thoroughfares in the municipality as may be designated by the City Council or procident and board of trustees, as the case may be, and approved by the Dopartment of Public Works and Suildings;

NOW, THEREFORE, In consideration of the premiers and of the mutual undertakings and agreements of the parties huroto and in conformity with all applicable laws, it is agreed that:

- 1. The State shall, with its funds, bush the dust of printing and operating (except the enforcement of particulars, rules and regulations) the aforesaid portions of the supprehensive Superhighway System except as hereinafter provided;
- 2. The City shall, with its funds, bear the cost of repairing, maintaining and operating all frontage roads within the city
 of Chicago that are a part of the Comprehensive Superhighway
 Systom whether such frontage roads are constructed as an integral
 part of the superhighway project or whether they are existing
 roads or streets used as frontage roads; and the portion of those
 roads or streets (including street surfaces, sidewalks, and
 handrails), under the jurisdiction of the City, which pass over
 or under the superhighway;
- 3. The County shall, with ite funds, bear the cost of ropairing, maintaining and operating all frontage roads outside the city of Chicago that are a part of the Comprehensive Superhighway System whether such frontage roads are constructed as an integral part of the superhighway project or whether they are existing roads or streets used as frontage roads; and the portion of those roads or streets (including street surfaces, sidewalks, and handrails) under the jurisdiction of the County, which pass over or under the superhighway;
- Trom the superhighway the repair, maintenance and operation of the frontage reads shall extend from the right-of-way line to the right-of-way line of those frontage reads. Where frontage reads are located on the superhighway right-of-way the repair, maintenance and operation of frontage reads shall extend from the right-of-way line of the superhighways to the edge of uncurbed frontage read pavement or back of frontage read ourb nearest the center line of the superhighway or to any fence which may be constructed between the frontage read and the expressive pavements of the superhighway;

The upper level of that portion of Wacker Drive Extension that is being constructed under the agreement of the State, County and City dated April 17, 1950 shall be considered a street which passes over the Superhighways as set forth in paragraphs 2 and 3 above;

- 6. This agreement shall be in effect on any portion of the Comprehensive Superhighway System when it is epened to public use.

ORDINANCE NO. 78-11

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Northbrook, County of Cook and State of Illinois THAT:

AN ORDINANCE ADDING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF EDENS EXPRESS-WAY FRONTAGE ROADS TO THE MUNICIPAL STREET SYSTEM

be and is hereby adopted as follows:

Section 1. BACKGROUND.

The fragmented frontage roads as described in Section 2 below are presently under the jurisdiction and control of both the State of Illinois and the County of Cook in accordance with a Joint Agreement dated June 19, 1952. The said sections of frontage roads serve no regional purpose; are strictly local in use and utility; and can be more feasibly maintained by the Vallage.

The Village of Northbrook; the State of Illinois, acting through its Department of Transportation; and the County of Cook have entered into an agreement for the purpose of transferring the jurisdiction, control and maintenance of said reparate sections of frontage road, all lying west of Edens Expressway between Lake-Cook Road and Sunset Ridge Road along Skokie Boulevard.

Section 2. ADDITION TO MUNICIPAL STREET SYSTEM.

The following sections of frontage roads lying between Edens Expressway and Skokie Boulevard are hereby added to the Public Street System of the Village of Northbrook:

- A) Dennie Drive from its connection with Vermont Avenue (approximately 300 feet south of Lake-Cook Road) south-emsterly to a point tast north of the Tri-State Tollway Spur, thence westerly to an intersection with Skokie Boulevard;
- B) Henrict Drive from its incorrection with Skokie Boulevard (just wouth of the Tri-State Tollway Spur, opposite Northwood Drive) easterly and wouthensterly to its connection with Elmwood Avenue (n. Lincoln Drive), thence south along Elmwood Avenue to an intorsection with Dundee Road east of Skokie Boulevard; and
- C) Sunset Ridge Road (North) northerly from its intersection with Skokie Boulevard and though posterly to Skokie Boulevard immediately adjacent to and parallel with Dundee Road (Illinois Routs 68),

Section 3. NOTIFICATION.

The Village Clerk is hereby directed to transmit a carcified copy of this Ordinance to the State of Illinois, through its District Engineer's office at Schaumburg, Illinois, and to the County of Cook, through the office of its Superintendent of Highways in Chicago, Illinois.
