11. Borrower Not Released; Forbearanc, by Lender Not a Waiver. Extension of the time for payment or modification of amortization of the same secured F_2 this Security Instrument granted by Lender to any successor in interest of Borrower shall not operate to release the livinity of the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest, Lender shall not be required to commence proceedings against any successor in interest or refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify amortization of the same secured by this Security Instrument by reason of any demand made by the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest, Any forbearance by Lender in exercising

any right or remedy shall not be a waiver of or preclude the exercise of any right or remedy.

12. Successors and Assigns Bound; Joint and Several Liability; Co-signers. The covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument shall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Lender and Borrower, subject to the provisions of paragraph 17. 13. I can Charges. If the loan secured by this Security Instrument is subject to a lay which sets maximum loan charges, and that law is finally interpreted so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to be collected in connection with the loan exceed the permitted limits, then: (a) any such loan charge shall be redoced by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limit; and (b) any sums already collected from Borrower which exceeded permitted limits will be refunded to Borrower. 17 Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower, If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Lander's prior written consent, Lander may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. 21. Acceleration; Remedies, Lender shall give notice to Borrower prior to acceleration following Borrower's breach of any covenant or agreement in this Security Instrument(but not prior to acceleration under paragraph 17 unless applicable law provides otherwise). The notice shall specify: (a) the default; (b) the action required to cure the default; (c) a date, not less than 30 days from the date the notice is given to Borrower, by which the default must be cured; and (d) that failure to cure the default on or before the date specified in the notice may result in acceleration of the sums secured by this Security Instrument, foreclosure by judicial proceeding and sale of the Property. The notice shall further inform Borrower of the right to reinstate after acceleration and the right to assert in the forcelosure proceeding the non-existence of a default or any other defense of Borrower to acceleration and forcelosure. If the default is not cured on or before the date specified in the notice. A. INTEREST RATE AND MONTHLY PAYMENT CHANGES

The Note provides for an initial interest rate of 4.125 %. The Note provides for changes in the interest rate and the monthly payments as follows:

2. INTEREST

(A) Interest Rate

Interest will be charged on unpaid Principal (plus any sums added to Principal, as described below) until the full amount of Principal has been paid, I will pay interest at an initial yearly rate of 4, 125. %. This initial rate is not based on the index referred to in Section 2(C) below. The interest rate I will pay will change in accordance with Section 2 of this Note.

The interest rate required by this Section 2 of this Note is the rate I will pay both before and after any default described in Section 7(B) of this Note.

(B) Interest Rate Change Dates

The interest rate I will pay may change on the first day of FEBRUARY 1995 and on the first day of each month thereafter. Each date on which my interest rate could change is called an "Interest Rate Change Date." The new interest rate will become effective on each Interest Rate Change Date.

(C) Index

Beginning with the first Interest Rate Change Date, my interest rate will be based on an Index. The "Index" is the average of interbank offered rates for one month U.S. dollar "denominated deposits in the

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London market ("LIBOR"), as published in <u>The Wall Street Journal</u>, from time to time. The most recent Index figure available as of 15 days before each interest Rate Change Date is called the "Current Index."

If the Index is no longer available, the Note Holder will choose a new index. The Note Holder will give me notice of this choice.

(D) Calculation of Interest Rate Changes

Before each Interest Rate Change Date, the Note Holder will calculate my new interest rate by adding TWO AND 875/1000 percentage point(s) (2,875%) to the Current Index. The Note Holder will then round the result of this addition up to the nearest one eighth of one percentage point (0,125%). The result of this addition will be my new interest rate until the next Interest Rate Change Date. My interest rate will never be greater than 11,875 %.

3. PAYMENTS

(A) Time and Place of Payments

I will pay Principal and interest by making payments every month. I will make my monthly payments on the first day of each month beginning on DECEMBER 01, 1994. I will make these payments every month until I have paid all the Principal and interest and any other charges described below that I may owe under this Note. My monthly payments will be applied to interest before Principal. If, on NOVEMBER 01, 2024. I still owe amounts under this Note, I will pay those amounts in full on that date, which is called the "Maturity Date."

or at a different place if required by the Note Holder,

(B) Amount of My Initial Monthly Payments

Each of my initial payments will be US. \$ 599.75. This amount may change from time to time.

(C) Payment Change Dates

My monthly payment may change as required by Section 3(D) below beginning on the first day of DECEMBER . 1995, and on that day every 12th month thereafter. Each of these dates is called a "Payment Change Date." My monthly payment also will bringe at any time Section 3(P) or 3(G) below requires me to pay a different monthly payment.

I will pay the amount of my new monthly payment exch month beginning on each Payment

Change Date or as provided in Section 3(F) or 3(G) below.

(D) Calculation of Monthly Payment Changes

At least 30 days before each Payment Change Date, the Note Hotor will calculate the amount of the monthly payment of Principal and interest (at the interest rate effective during the month preceding the Payment Change Date) that would be sufficient to repay, in full, in substitutially equal installments the unpaid principal that I am expected to owe at the Payment Change Date on the Maturity Date. The result of this calculation is called the "Full Payment." The Note Holder will then calculate the amount of my monthly payment due the month preceding the Payment Change Date multiplied by the number 1.075. The result of this calculation is called the "Limited Payment." Unless Sections 3(F) or 3(O) below requires me to pay a different amount, my new monthly payment will be in the amount of the Full Payment, except that I may choose to pay the Limited Payment. If I choose the Limited Payment as my monthly payment, I must give the Note Holder notice that I am doing so at least 30 days before my first new monthly payment is due.

(E) Additions to My Unpaid Principal

My monthly payment could be less than the amount of the interest portion of the monthly payment that would be sufficient to repay the unpaid Principal I owe at the monthly payment date in full on the Maturity Date in substantial equal payments. If so, each month that my monthly payment is less than the interest portion, the Note Holder will subtract the amount of my monthly payment from the amount of the interest portion and will add the difference to my unpaid Principal. The Note Holder also will add interest on the amount of this difference to my unpaid Principal each month. The interest rate on the interest added to Principal will be the rate required by Section 2 above.

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(F) Limits on My Unpaid Principal; Increased Monthly Payment

Notwithstanding anything contained in Sections 3(D) or 3(E) above, my unpaid Principal can never exceed a maximum amount equal to one hundred ten percent (110%) of the Principal amount I originally borrowed. In the event my unpaid Principal would exceed 110% of the principal amount I originally borrowed, on the date that the payment of my monthly payment would cause me to exceed 110% of the Principal amount I originally borrowed. I will instead pay a new monthly payment. The new monthly payment will be in an amount that would be sufficient to repay the then outstanding Principal amount I owe, in full, on the Maturity Date in substantially equal installments of principal and interest at the then current Interest rate.

(G) Required Full Payment

Notwithstanding anything contained in Section 3(D) above, on the 5th Payment change Date and on each succeeding 5th Payment Change Date thereafter, my monthly payment shall be adjusted to be the Pull Payment until the next Payment Change Date. I also will be paying the Pull Payment as my monthly payment on the final Payment Change Date.

4. Notice of Changes

The Note Holder will deliver or mail to me a notice of the amount of my monthly payment before the effective late of any change. The notice will include information required by law to be given me and also the title and the telephone number of a person who will answer any question I may have regarding the notice.

B. TRANSFER OF THE PROPERTY OR A BENEFICIAL INTEREST IN BORROWE R Covenant 17 of the Security Instrument is amended to read as follows:

Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower. If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Lender's prior written consent, Lender may, at its option, require immediate payment in fail of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise in prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Security Instrument. Lender also shall also not exercise this option if; (a) Borrower causes to be submitted to Lender information required by Lender to evaluate the intended transferce as if a new loan were being made to the transferce; and (b) Lender reasonably determines that Lenders security will not be impaired by the loan assumption and that the risk of a breach of any coverant or agreement in this Security Instrument is acceptable to lender.

To the extent permitted by applicable law, Lender may charge a reasonable fee as a condition to Lender's consent to the loan assumption. Lender may also require the transferee to sign an assumption agreement that is acceptable to Lender and that obligates the transferee to keep all the promises and agreements made in the Note and in this Security Instrument. Bo rower will continue to be obligated

under the Note and this Security Instrument unless Lender releases Borrowra in writing.

If Lender exercises the option to require immediate payment in fall, Lender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration. The notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is delivered or mailed within which Borrower must pay all sums secured by this Security Instrument. If Borrower fails to pay these sums prior to the expiration of this period, Lender may invoke any remedies permitted by this Security Instrument without further notice of demand on Borrower.

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
