Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cride

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest. additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty together with any posts that may accrue in addition thereto, shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whather real or personal, belonging to

Sec. 6322. Period Qf Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien posed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the ababea-ment is made and shall continue until the flability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the texpayer arising out of such flability) is estisfied or becomes unenforce able by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditora. - The Hen Imposed by section 8321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment tien creditor until notice thereof which meets the facultsments of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

m Place For Filling Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subeaction (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws

(a) Under disse Laws (i) Real Property - in the case of roal property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is altutated; and

(ii) Personal Property-in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is aituated; except that State law merely conforming to reenacting Federal law establishing a national filing system does not constitute a second office for filing as designated by the laws of such State; or (B) With Clerk Of District Court-in the office of the

clock of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the

requirements of subparagraph (A), or (C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Co-lumbia - in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbie, if the property subject to the ilen is situated in the District of Columbia.

(a) Refiling Of Notice.—For purposes of this section-

- (1) General Rule, --- Unless notice of then is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such retiling period.
