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

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects of refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable panalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto; shall be a lien in favor of the United Stales upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien ed by section 6321/shall arise at the time the assetsment is made and abali continue until the liability for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the lampayer ng out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judament Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interset, mechanic's llenor, or judg-ment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding tien, if a notice of tien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such tien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes as in evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intende to obtain a right in such property.
