

- b) Pay immediately when due and payable all general taxes, special taxes, apacial assessments, water charges, sewer service charges and other taxes and charges against the property, inclining those heretofore due, (the monthly payments provided in the Note in anticipation of such taxes and charges to be applied thereto, and to furnish the Nottagague, upon request, with the original or duplicate receipts thereof, and all such items extended against said property shall be conclusively deemed valid for the purpose of this requirement.
- c) Keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the property insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning, wind storm or such other hazards, as the Mortgagee may reasonably require to be insured against under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of monies sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, in such companies through such agents or brokers and in such form as shall be satisfactory to the Mortgagee, until said indebtedness is fully paid, or in the case of foreclosure, until expiration of the period of redemption; such insurance policies, including additional and renewal policies shall be delivered to and kept by the Mortgagee and shall contain a clause satisfactory to the Mortgagee making them payable to the Mortgagee, as its interest may appear, and in case of loss under such policies, the Mortgagee is authorized to adjust, collect and compromise, in its discretion, all claims thereunder and the Mortgager agrees to sign, upon demand, all receipts, vonchers and releases required of him by the insurance companies; application by the Mortgagee of any of the proceeds of such insurance to the indebtedness hereby secured shall not excuse the Mortgager from making all monthly payments until the indebtedness is paid in full. In the event of a loss, Mortgager shall give prompt notice to the insurance carrier and Mortgagee. Mortgages may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Mortgagor. All renewal policies shall be delivered at least 10 days before such insurance shall expire. All policies shall provide further that Mortgages shall receive 10 days notice prior to cancellation.

In the case of a failure to perform any of the covenants herein, or if any action or proceeding is commenced which materially affects Mortgagee's interest in the Premises, including, but not limited to, eminent domain, insolvency, code enforcer and, or arrangements or proceedings involving a bankrupt or decedent, the Mortgagee may do on the Mortgager's behalf everything so convenanted; the Mortgage may also do any act it may deem necessary to protect the lien hereof; and the Mortgager will repay upon demand any monies paid or dishursed, including reasonable and expenses, by the Mortgagee for any of the above purposes and such monies together with interest thereon at the rate set forth in the Note secured hereby shall become so much additional indebtedness hereby secured and may be included in any decree foreclosing this mortgage and be paid out of the rents or proceeds of said Premises if not otherwise paid. It shall not be obligatory upon the Mortgagee to inquire into the validity of any lien, encumbrance, or claim in a vivancing monies as above authorized, but nothing herein contained shall be construed as requiring the Mortgagee to advance any monies for any purpose not to do any act hereunder; and the Mortgagee shall not incur any personal liability because of anything it may do or omit to do hereunder nor shall any acts of Mortgage act as a waiver of Mortgagee's right to accelerate the maturity of the indebtedness secured by this mortgage or to proceed to foreclose this mortgage.

- 6. Time is of the essence hereof, and if default be made in performance of any covenant herein contained or contained in the Note or in making any payment under said Note or obligation or any extension or renewal thereof, or if proceedings he instituted to enforce any other lien or charge upon ray. The Premises, or upon the filing of a proceeding in bankruptcy by or against the Mortgagor, or if the Mortgagor shail make an assignment for the benefit of nir creditors or if his property be placed under control of or in custody of any court or officer of the government, or if the Mortgagor shandons the Premises, or falls to pay when due any charge or assessment (whether for insurance premiums, maintenance, taxes, capital improvements, purchase of another unit, or otherwise) imposed by any condominium, townhouse, cooperative or similar owners' group, then and in any of said events, the Mortgage is hereby authorized and empowered, at his option, and without affecting the lien hereby created or the priority of said lien or any right of the Mortgage hereunder, to declare, without notice all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable, whether or not such default be remedied by Mortgagor, and apply toward the payment of said mortgage indebtedness any monies of the Mortgagor held by the Mortgagee, and said Mortgagee may also immediately proceed to foreclose this mortgage, and in any foreclosure a sale may be made of the Premises on masse without the offering of the several parts separately.
- 7. Upon the commencement of any foreclosure proceeding hereunder, the court in which such hill if filed may at any time, either before or after sale, and without notice to the Mortgagor, or any party claiming under him, and without regard to the solvency of the Mortgagor or the then value of said Premises, or whether the same shall then be occupied by the owner of the equity of redemption as a homestead, appoint a receiver, with power to manage and rent and to collect the rents, issues and profits of said Premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and the statutory period of redemption, and such rents, issues and profits, when collected, may be applied before as well as after the foreclosure sale, towards the payment of the indebtedness, costs, taxes, insurance or other items necessary for the protection and preservation of the Premises, including the expenses of such receivership, or on any deficiency decree whether there be a decree therefore in persons or not, and if a receiver shall be appointed be shall remain in possession until the expiration of the full period allowed by statute for redemption, whether there be redemption or not, and until the issuance of a deed in case of sale, but if not deed be issued, until the expiration of the statutory period during which it may be issued and no lease of said Premises shall be multified by the appointment or entry in possession of a receiver but he may elect to terminate any lease junior to the lien hereof; and upon foreclosure of said Premises, there shall be allowed and included as an additional indebtedness in the decree of sale all expenditures and expenses together with interest thereon at the rate of full procession of a receiver but he may elect to the sale of sale all expenditures and expenses together with interest thereon at the rate of full procession of a receiver but he case defined in the Adjustable Rate Commercical Installment Note which may be paid or incurred by or in behalf of the Mortgagor for attorneys' fees, Mortgagoe's fees, appra

in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate or hankruptcy proceedings to which either party hereto shall be a party by reason of this mortgage or the Note hereby secured; or (b) preparations for the accrual of the right to foreclose, whether or not actually commenced; or (c) preparations for the defense of or intervention in any suit or proceeding or any threatened or contemplated suit or proceeding, which might affect the Premises or the security hereof. In the event of a foreclosure said of said Premises there shall first be paid out the proceeds thereof all of the aforesaid items, then the entire indebtedness whether due and payable by the terms hereof or not and the interest due thereon up to the time of such sale, and the overplus, if any, shall be paid to the Mortgagor, and the purchaser shall not be obliged to see to the application of the purchaser and one.

- 8. Extension of the time for payment or modification or amerization of the sums secured by this mortgage granted to Mortgages to any successor in interest of Mortgagor shall not operate to release in any manner the liability of the original Mortgagor and Mortgagor's successor in interest. Mortgages shall not be required to commence proceedings against such successor or refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify amortization of the sum section by this mortgage by reason of any demand made by the original Mortgagor and Mortgagor's successors in interest.
- 9. If the payment of the indebtedness hereby secured, or any part thereof, by extended or varied, or if any part of the security or guaranties thereof be released, all persons now or at any time hereafter liable therefor, or interested in the Premises, shall be held to assent to such extension, variation or release, and their liability, and the lien riod all provisions hereof, shall continue in full force and effect; the right of recourse against all such persons being expressly reserved by Mortgages, not of standing any such extension, variation or release. Any person, firm or corporation taking a junior mortgage, or other lien upon the Premises or any part thereof of any interest therein, shall take the said lien subject to the rights of Mortgages to amend (including, without limitation, changing the rate of interest or narraer of computation thereof), modify, extend or ralease the Note, this mortgage, or any other document or instrument evidencing, securing or guarante-on, the independent hereby secured, in each and every case without obtaining the consent of the holder of such junior lien and without the lien of this mortgage folion, become and the rights of any such junior lien except as otherwise expressly provided in a separate Subordination Agreement by and between Mortgages and the holder of such junior lien.
- 10. Any foreboarance by Mortgagee in exercising any right or remedy hereunder or otherwise afforded by applicable law, shall not be a waiver of or preclude the exercise of any such right or remedy. The pre-arement of insurance or the payment of taxes or other liens or charges by Mortgagee shall not be a waiver of Mortgagee's right to accolerate the indebtedness seed red by this mortgage.
- 11. All remedies provided in this mortgage are distinct and cump ladys to any other right or remedy under this mortgage or afforded by law or equity and may be exercised concurrently, independently or successively.
- 12. The covenants contained herein shall bind and the rights bersum for shall inure to, the respective successors and assigns of Mortgages and Mortgages subject to the provision of paragraph 3 hereof. All covenants and agreements of Mortgages shall be joint and several.
- 13. Except to the extent any notice shall be required under applicable law to be given in another manner, any notice to Morgagor shall be given by mailing such notice by certified mail addressed to Morgagor at the property address or at 1 ich other address as Mortgagor may designate by notice to Mortgager as provided herein and any notice to Mortgagee shall be given by certified mail, return receipt advested to Mortgagee's address stated herein or to such other address as Mortgagee may designate by notice to Mortgagor as provided herein. Any notice provided for in this mortgage shall be deemed to have been given to Mortgagor or Mortgagee when given in the manner designated herein.
- 14. Upon payment of all sums secured by this mortgage, Mortgages shall release this mortgage with all charge to Mortgagor. Mortgagor shall pay all costs of recordations of any documentation necessary to release this mortgage.
- 15. Mortgagor assigns to Mortgagoe and authorizes the Mortgagoe to negotiate for and collect any awar (for condemnation of all or any part of the Premises. The Mortgagoe may, in its discretion, apply any such award to amounts due hereunder, or for restoration of the Premises.
- 16. Mortgagor shall not and will not apply for or avail itself of any appraisement, valuation, stay extension or exemption laws, or any so-called "Moratorium Laws", now existing or hereafter enacted, in order to prevent or hinder the enforcement or foreclosure of this mortgage, or thereby waives the benefit of such laws.

  Mortgagor does hereby expressly waive any and all rights of redemption from sale under any order or decree of forecle sure of this mortgage on behalf of Mortgagor and each and every person except decree or judgment creditors of the Mortgagor in its representative capacity and of the trust estate, acquiring any interest in or title to the Premises subsequent to the date of this mortgage.
- 17. This mortgage shall be governed by the law of the jurisdiction in which the Premises are located. In the event one or more of the revisions contained in this mortgage shall be prohibited or invalid under applicable law, such provision shall be ineffective only to the extent of such prohibition or invalidity, without invalidating the remainder of such provision or the remaining provision of this mortgage.
