

# Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax peolects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty. together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in layer of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person

### Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Cértain Persons.

(e) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The lien impos-ed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgmont lien creditor until notice thorself which meats the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

#### m Place For Filling Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The natice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situtated; and

(ii) Personal Property-in the case of personal rty, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; except that State law merely conforming to reenecting Federal law establishing a national filling system does not constitute a second office for filling as decignated by the laws of such State; or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court-in the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Cotumble . In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the flen is situated in the

District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), properly shall be deemed to be altuated-(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location, or

(DIPParsonal Property-In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the color of hen is filed

Fol purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal marriage office of the business is located, and the maidance of a truptiver whose residence is without the United States shall be dire med to be in the District of Columbia,

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be priscribed by the Secretary, Such notice shall be valid not withstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or conter ( of ), notice of lien.

(a) Refilling Of Notice.—For purposes of this

(1) General Rule .- Unless notice of then is rollied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of tien shall be treated as flied on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such refiling period.

(2) Place For Filling .- A notice of then retiled during the required refilling period shall be affective only-

(A) If-

(I) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the orier notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, and the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (i) (4), and

(B) In any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manne preactibed in regulations issued by the Sacretary) concerning a change in the texpayor's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is

(3) Required Refilling Period.—in the case of any notice of tien, the term "required refilling period" means-

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and

(B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 10 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such netice of ilen.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien .- Subject to such requlations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which .

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The So cretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, togethor with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or

has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secracry and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon he payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest In resperance read, within the time prescribed by isw (including) any as ahalor of such time), and that is in accordance with such tamuler no as felating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and attent thereon, as may be specified by such
