Sec. 6321 Lien For Taxes

If any person (while to pay any fax neglects or refushs to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any obtains) additional amount isothern to tax or assessable periatly together with any costs that may accous in addition theretay shall be altern in fayor of the united States upon all property and rights to property whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is spacifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section \$32) aboil arise at the Smallife assessment is made and shall continue until the Sabrity for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxoayer arising out of such lab ity) is setisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of labally of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The lien imposed by soction 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of amounty interest methods is lienor, or judgment lien checkly only achiev the security method by the Secretary

## in Place For Filling Notice; Form.-

(1) Plane For Filing - The notice referred to in sub-section (a) shall be filed

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lies it situated, and (ii) Personal Property In the case of personal

(ii) Personal Property In the case of personal property, whether langible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to this item is attuated, except that State law marely confirming to reenacting Federal law establishing a net shall filling evitem does not constitute a second office for filling as designated by the laws of such State; or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court-in the office of the Clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by liew designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A). or

(g) Refilling Of Notice.—For purposes of this section:

- (1) General Rule,—Unless notice of tien is refiled in the reanner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) Place For Filing.—A natice or tion refited during the required refiting period shall be effective only-

(A) If-

(i) such notice or lian is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of i.en was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, and the fact of refiting is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the data of a nything of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received write i information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lies in also filled in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refilling Period.—In the case of any notice of tien, the term "required retilling period" means.

(A) the one-year period ending 30 cays after the expitation of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and

(B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 10 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such halice of lien.

Sec. 6025. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Melease Of Lieft, —Subject to such regutations at the Secretary may preaches, the Secretary shall issue a rutificate of release of any iten imposed with respect to any hiernal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on whith.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable. The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully estisfied or two become legally unenforceable, or

(2) Bond Accepted-Thore is furnished to the Secritary and accepted by him a bord that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in review thereor, within the time prescribed by lew (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such the bond and surclies thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103 Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(to Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien-if a notice of lien has been flied pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the systemolog obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
