NOW THEREFORE, the Mortgagors to secure the payment of said principal sum of money and said interest in accordance with the terms, provisions, and limitations of this mortgage, and the performance of the covenants and agreements herein contained, by the Mortgagors to be performed, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledge, do by these presents CONVEY AND WARRANT unto the Mortgagee and the Mortgagee's successors and assigns, the following described Real Estate together with all improvements, tenements, ensements and fixtures thereon, and all of his, her, or their estate, right, title and interest therein, situate, lying and being in the VILLAGE OF TORTHFIELD, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS:

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THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS, AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON PAGE 1 ARE:

- 1. Mortgagors shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to the Mortgagee; (4) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinance with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance, or with the consent of mortgagee, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld.
- 2. Mortgagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to the Mortgagee duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagors may desire to contest.
- 3. Mortgagors shall keep all building and improvements now or hereafter situated on sall premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning, windstorm, etc. under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the Mortgagee, under insurance policies payable in the case of loss or damage to Mortgagee, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy; and Mortgagors shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to the Mortgagee and in the case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten (10) days prior to the respective dates of expiration.
- 4. At any time, the Mortgagors shall have the privilege of making prepayments on the principal of the Note, either partially or in full, without penalty, without restriction.
- 5. Mortgagors shall pay each item of indebtedness herein mentioned, both principal and interest, when due according to the terms hereof. At the option of the Mortgagee, and you written notice to Mortgagors, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this Mortgage shall become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any installment of principal or interest on the Note within fifteen (15) days of when due, or (b) when default shall occur and continue for three (3) days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagors herein contained.
- 6. In the case of default herein, Mortgagee may, but need tot, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore required of Mortgagors in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise, or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other moneys advanced by Mortgagee to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, shall be so

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much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the highest rate permitted by Illinois law. Inaction of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to the Mortgagee on account of any default hereunder on the part of Mortgagors.

- When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of the Mortgagee for attorneys' fees, costs of litigation, including obtaining and preparing documentary and expert evidence for trial, court costs and fees, title insurance, and other similar charges as the Mortgagor may reasonably deem necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to of value of the premises. In addition, all expendit expenses of the nature herein mentioned shall become so much In addition, all expenditures and additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable with interest thereon at the highest rate permitted by Illinois law, when paid or included by Mortgagee in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which the Mortgagee shall be mide a party, either as plaintiff, claimant or defendant, by reason of this mortgage or any indebtedness hereby secured: or (b) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure hereof after accrual of such right to foreclose whether or not actually commenced; or (c) preparations for the defense of any actual or threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof.
- 8. The proceeds of any ioreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed first on account of all costs and expenses incurred in conjunction with the foreclosure proceeds; second, to all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third to all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the Note; fourth, any overplus shall be distributed to Mortgagors, their heirs, legal representative or assigns, as their rights may appear.
- 9. Upon or at any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this mortgage the court in which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagors at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be occupied as a homestead or not, and the Mortgagee may be appointed as such received. Such receiver shall have the power to collect the rents, issues, and profits of sail premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagors, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The Court from time to time may authorize the received to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this mortgage, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.

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- 10. No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the Note hereby secured.
- 11. The Mortgagee shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purposes.
- 12. If the payment of said indebtedness or any part thereof be extended or varied or if any part of the security be released, all persons now or at any time hereafter liable therefor, or interested in said premises, shall be held to assent to such extension, variation or release, and their liability and the lien and all provisions hereof shall continue in full force, the right of recourse against all such persons being expressly reserved by the Mortgagee, notwithstanding such extension, variation, or release.
- 13. Mortgagee shall release this mortgage and lien thereof by proper instrument upon payment and discharge of all indebtedness secured hereby and payment of a reasonable fee to Mortgagee for the execution of such release, not to exceed \$50.00.
- 14. The Note which is secured hereby shall be due upon the sale or other alienation of the property unless the written consent of the Mortgagee to such sale or alienation has been previously obtained. This mortgage and all provisions hereof shall extend to and be binding upon Mortgagors and all persons claiming under or through Mortgagors, and the word "Mortgagors" when used herein shall include all such persons and all persons liable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have executed the Note or this mortgage. The word "Mortgagee" when used herein shall include the successors and assigns of the fortgagee named herein and the holder or holders, from time to time, of the Note secured hereby.
- 15. Any notice required by the terms of this mortgage shall be given by mailing such notice by certified mail. Such notice shall be deemed given when mailed in the manner designated herein.
