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THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON PAGE 1 (THE REVERSE SIDE OF THIS MORTGAGE):

- 1. Mortgagors shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien thereot; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory eviderice of the discharge of such prior lien to the Mortgagee; (4) complete within a reasonable time any buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations in said premises except required by law or municipal ordinance.
- 2. Mortgagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, sumish to the Mortgagore duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statule; any tax or assessment which Mortgagors may desire to contest.
- 3. Mortgagors shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning and windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the Mortgagee, under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to Mortgagee, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy, and shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to the Mortgagee, and in case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration.
- 4. In case of default therein, Mortgages may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore required of Mortgagors in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, purchase hazard insurance, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' less, and any other moneys advanced by Mortgages to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall berome immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate agreed upon in the note, finaction of Mortgages shall never be considered as a weiver of any right accruing to the Mortgages on account of any default hereunder on the part of the Mortgagors.
- 5. The Mortgagee making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public orific, without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tex, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lies or claim thereof.
- 6. Mortgagors shall pay each item of indebtedness herein mentioned, both principal and interest, when due according to the terms hereof. At the option of the Mortgagoe and without notice to Mortgago, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this mortgage shall, notwithstanding anything in the note or in this mortgage to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immortgately in the case of default in making payment of any installment of principal or interest on the note, or (b) when default shall occur and continue for three day; in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagors herein contained.
- 7. If all or any part of the property or an infected in the property is sold or transferred by Mortgagors without Mortgagoe's prior written consent. Mortgagoe, at Mortgagoe's option, and in accordance with federal law; may require immediate payment in full of the entire amount due under the mortgagoe and note. Mortgagoe, at Mortgagoe's option, may waive the right to declar: the hance immediately due and may accept in writing an assumption agreement executed by the person to whom the Mortgagors are transferring or selling the interest in the property. If Mortgagoe does allow Mortgagors' successor in interest to assume the obligation, Mortgagors will be released from further obligation under this management and the note.
- 8. When the indetteness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for attornive' fees, appraiser's fee, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches, and examinations, title insurance policies. Torrens certificates, and similar or and assurances with respect to title as Mortgagee may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which hay be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned is all become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable, with interest thereon at the rate agreed upon in the note, when paid or incurred by Mortgagee in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which the Mortgagee shall be a party, either at partiality, claimant or defendant, by reason of this mortgage or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (b) preparations for the defense of any actual or threatened suit or price ding which might affect the premises or the security hereof.
- 9. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any overplus to Mortgagors, their heirs, legal representations or assigns, as their rights may appear.
- 10. Upon or at any time after the filing of a complaint to forelcose this mortgage, the court in vinich luch complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagors at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same and to the occupied as a homestead or not, and the Mortgagore may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and publis of said premises during the pendency of such toreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagors, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, souts and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The Court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of. (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree toreclosing this mortgage, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to foreclosure sale. (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.
- 11. The Mortgages shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and to make repairs to the premises as it is function it may deem necessary for the proper preservation thereof. Access thereto shall be permitted for those purposes.
