SECOND MODIFICATION AND EXTENSION AGREEMENT

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THIS MODIFICATION AND EXTENSION AGREEMENT made this 11th day of February, 1994 among BANK OF LINCOLNWOOD, an Illinois banking association ("Bank"), the owner and holder of the Note and Mortgage, hereinafter described, and Bernice June Rajewski, divorced and not since remarried, (hereinafter jointly and severally referred to as "Debtor").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Debtor has executed, as maker, that certain Revolving Credit Note dated November 15, 1989, payable to the Bank in the principal amount of \$4,500.00 ("Note"), secured by a revolving Credit Mortgage dated November 15, 1989 recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County as Document No. 88546824 (Mortgage); and

WHEREAS, there remains a principal balance due on the loan evidenced by the Note in the amount of \$4,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereby agree to modify and extend the terms of payment of the Note and Mortgage covering the real estate located in Cook County, Illinois, legally described as follows:

Lot 36 in Subdivision by John M. Wilson of Subdivision Block 1 and 3 of block 3, Judd & Wilson's Subdivision of Block 6 in Canal Trustees Subdivision of Section 33, Township 39 North, Range 14, East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois.


NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements of the parties hereto, and other good and valuable consideration, the parties have agreed as follows:

1. The maximum amount of the Line of Credit from and after the date hereof shall be \$4,500.00.

2. The Maturity, as defined in the Note and Mortgage, is hereby extended to May 15, 1994.

3. Except as expressly herein provided, all terms of the note, Mortgage and all other loan documents executed in connection therewith, shall remain in full force and effect. The Note, as modified by this Modification and Extension agreement, evidences a "revolving credit" as defined in Illinois Revised Statutes Chapter 17, Paragraph 5405. The lien of the Mortgage secures the payment of the Note, as modified by this Modification and Extension Agreement, and all future advances made on the loan evidenced by the Note, to the same extent as if such future advances were made on the date of the execution of the Mortgage without regard to whether or not there is any Advance made at the time the Mortgage or this Modification and Extension Agreement is executed and without regard to whether or not there is any indebtedness outstanding at the time any Advance is made.

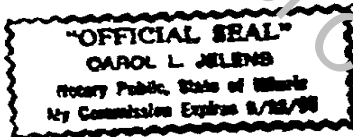

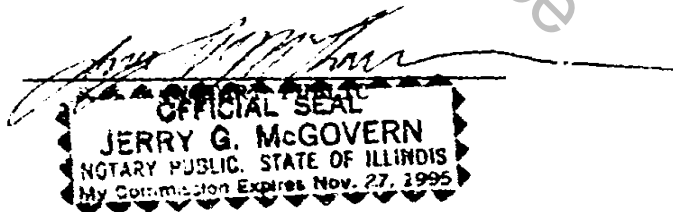
