Failure to make the deposits equired becoming constitute a breach of this agreement, Seller has option to have purchaser pay insurance and assessments directly.

Seller is hereby authorized and directed to use the funds for the payment of the aforementioned taxes, assessments, runts and premiums. Seller shall, upon the request of the fluyer, give the fluyer, an annual accounting of all such funds deposited and disbursed including evidence of vaid receipts for the amounts so disbursed. The funds are hereby pledged as additional security to the Seller for the periodic payments and the unpaid balance of the purchase price.

If the amount of the funds together with the unire periodic deposits of such funds payable prior to the due date of the aforementioned charges shall exceed the amount rear anably estimated as being required to pay said charges one month prior to the time at which they fall due such excess shill be applied first to cure any breach in the performance of the fluyer's covenants or agreements hereunder of which Selter has given written notice to theyer and, second, at theyer's option, as a each refund to theyer or a credit toward theyer's future obligations becounder, if the amount of the funds held by Selter shall not be sufficient to pay all such charges as herein provided, theyer shall pay to Selter any amount necessary to make up the deficiency within 30 days from the date notice is mailed by Selter to theyer requesting payment thereof.

Seller may not charge for so holding and applying the funds avalyting said account, or verifying and compiling said assessments and bills, nor shall buyer be entitled to interest or earnings on the funds, unless otherwise agreed in writing at the time of execution of this agreement. Upon payment in full of all sures use hereunder, Seller shall promptly refund to Buyer any funds so held by Seller.

- 19. PURCHASER'S INTEREST IN IMPROVEMENTS: In the event of the termination of this agreement by lapse of time, forfeiture or otherwise, all improvements, whether finished or unfinished, whether installed or constructed on or about said premises by the Buyer or others shall belong to and become the property of the Seller without liability or obligation or Seller's part to account to the Buyer therefor or for any part thereof.
 - 20. LIBNS: Buyer shall not permit a mechanics' judgment or other lien to attach to the premises.

21. PERFORMANCE:

A. If Buyer

- (1) defaults by failing to pay when due any single installment or payment required to be made to Seller under the terms of this agreement and such default is not cured within ten (10) days of within quotice to Buyer; or
- (2) defaults in the performance of any other covenants or agreements hereof and such descult is not cured by fluyer within thirty (30) days after written notice to thuyer (unless the default involves a dangerous condition which shall be cured forthwith); Seller may treat such a default as a breach of this agreement and Seller shall have any one or more of the following remedies in addition to all other rights and remedies provided at law or in equity:
 - (a) maintain an action for any unpaid installments;
 - (b) deleare the entire balance due and maintain an action for such amount;
 - (c) forfelt the Duyer's interest under this agreement and retain all sums paid as liquidated damages in full satisfaction of any claim against fluyer, and upon fluyer's failure to surrender possession, maintain an action for possession under the Porcible Entry and Detainer Act, subject to the rights of Purchaser to reinstate as provided in that Act.
- 11. As additional scourity in the event of default, fluyer assigns to Seller all unpaid rents, and altrents which accouse thereafter, and in addition to the remedies provided above and in conjunction with any one of the, Seller may collect any rent due and owing and may seek the appointment of a receiver.
- C. If default is based upon the failure to pay taxes, assessments, insurance, or tiens, Setter may elect to make such payments and add the amount in the principal balance due, which amounts shall become immediately due and payable by fluyer to Seller.
- D. Anything contained in subparagraph A through C to the contrary notwithstanding, this agreement shall not be furfaited and determined, if within 20 days after such written notice of stefault, Purchaser tenders to Seller the entire unpaid principal balance of the Purchase Price and accrued interest then outstanding and cures any other defaults of a monetary nature affecting the premises or monetary claims atising from acts or obligations of Purchaser under this agreement,

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22, DEFAULT, FEES:

- A. fluyer or Seller shall pay all reasonable attorney's fees and costs incurred by the other in enforcing the terms and provisions of this agreement, including fortenure or specific performance, in defending any proceeding to which fluyer or Seller is made a party defendant (or creature in the event of Seller's bankruptcy or being declared insolvent) as a result of the acts or omissions of the other party.
- D. (1) All rights and remedies given to theyer or Seller shall be distinct, separate and comulative, and the use of one or more thereof shall not exclude as waive any other right or remedy allowed by law, unless specifically waived in this agreement;
 - (2) no waiver of any breach or default of either party hereunder shall be implied from any omission by the other party to take any action on account of any similar or different breach or default; the payment or acceptance of money after it falls due after knowledge of any breach of this agreement by fluyer or Seller, or after the termination of fluyer's right of possession hereunder, or after the service of any notice, or after commencement of any suit, or after final judgment for possession of the premises shall not reinstate, continue or extend this agreement nor after any such notice, demand or suit or any right hereunder not herein expressly waived.
- 23. NOTICES: All notices required to be given under this agreement shall be construed to mean notice in writing signed by or a cehalf of the party giving the same, and the same may be served upon the other party or his agent personally or by certified or registered mail, return receipt, requested to the parties addressed if to Seller at the address shown in paragraph 3 or if in the fluyer at the address of the premises. Notice shall be deemed made when mailed or served.
- 24. CALCULATION OF INTEREST: Invert for each month shall be added to the unpaid balance on the first day of each month at the rate of one-twellth of the annual interest rate and shall be calculated upon the unpaid balance due as of the last day of the preceding month based upon a 360 day year.
