This insuranceshall be maintained in the amounts and for the periods that Lenderrequires. Borrowershall also be in default if Borrower, during the loan application process, gave materially false or inaccurate information or statements to Lender (or failed to provide Lender with any material information) in connection with the loan evidenced by the Note, including, but not limited to, representations concerning Borrower's occupancy of the Property as a principal residence. If this Security Instrumentis on a leasehold, Borrowershall comply with the provisions of the lease. If Borrower acquires fee title to the Property, the leasehold and

fee title shall not be merged unless Lenderagrees to the merger in writing.

6. Charges to Borrower and Protection of Lender's Rights in the Property. Borrower shall pay all governmentator municipalcharges, fines and impositions that are not included in Paragraph 2. Borrowershall pay these obligations on time directly to the entity which is owed the payment. If failure to pay would adversely affect Lender's interestin the Property, upon Lender's

request Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender receipts evidencing these payments.

If Borrowerfails to make these payments or the payments required by Paragraph2, or fails to performany other covenants and agreementscontained in this Security Instrument, or there is a legal proceeding that may significantly affect Lender's rights in the Property (such as a proceeding in bankruptcy, for condemnationor to enforce laws or regulations), then Lender may do and pay whatever is necessary to protect the value of the Property and Lender's rights in the Property, including payment of taxes, hazard insurance and other items mentioned in Paragraph 2.

 - (i) Borrower defaults by failing to pay in full any monthly payment required by this Security Instrumentprior to or on the due date of the next monthly payment, or
 - (ii) Borrowerdefaults by failing, for a period of thirty days, to perform any other obligations contained in this Security Instrument.
- (b) Sale Without Credit Approval. Lender shall, if permitted by applicable law and with the prior approval of the Secretary, require immediate payment in full of all the sums secured by this Security Instrumentif:
 - (i) All or part of the Property, or a beneficial interestin a trust owning all or part of the Property, is sold or otherwise transferred (other than by devise or descent) by the Borrower, and
 - (ii) The Property is not occupied by the purchaseror grantee as his or her principal residence, or the purchaseror granteedoes so occupy the Property, but his or her credit has not been approved in accordance with the requirements of the Secretary.
- (c) No Waiver. If circumstancesoccur that would permit Lenderto require immediate payment in full, but Lenderdoes not require such rivn ents, Lenderdoes not waive its rights with respect to subsequent events.
- (d) Regulations of HUD Secretary. 10. Reinstatement. Borrowerhas a right to be reinstated of Lenderhas required immediate payment in full because of Borrower's failure to pay an amount due under the Note or this Security Instrument. This right applies even after foreclosure proceedings are instituted. To reinstate the Security Instrument, Borrower shall tender in a lump sum all amounts required to bring Borrower's account current including, to the extent they are obligations of Borrower under this Security Instrument, foreclosure costs and reasonable and customary attorneys' fees and expenses properly associated with the foreclosure proceeding. Upon reinstatement by Borrower, this Security Instrument and the obligations that it secures shall remain in effect as if Lenderhad not required immediate payment in full. 11. Borrower Not Released; Forbearance By Lender Not a Waiver. Extension of the time of payment or modification of amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrumentgranted by Lender to any successor in interest of Borrowershall not operate to release the liability of the original Borrower or Borrower's successor'n interest. Lendershall not be required to commence proceedings against any successor in interest or refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument by reason of any demand made by the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest. Any forbearance by Lender in exercising any right or remedy shall not be a waiver of or preclude the exercise of any right or remedy.

12. Successors and Assigns Bound; Joint and Several Liability; Co-Signers. The companisand agreements of this Security Instrumentshall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Lender and Borrower, subject to the provisions of Paragraph 9.b. Borrower's covenants and agreements shall be joint and several. Any Borrower who co-signs this Security Instrument does not execute the Note: (a) is co-signing this Security Instrument only to mortgage, grant and convey that Borrower's interest in the Property under the terms of this Security Instrument; (b) is not personally obligated to pay the some secured by this Security Instrument; and (c) agrees that Lender and any other Borrower may agree to extend, modify, forbeafor relake any accommodations with regard to the terms of this Security Instrumentor the Note without that Borrower's consent.

13. Notices. Any notice to Borrower provided for in this Security Instrumentshall be given by deav ving it or by mailing it by first class mail unless applicable law requires use of anothermethod. The notice shall be directed to the Property Address or any other address Borrower designates by notice to Lender. Any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail to Lender's address stated hereinor any address Lender designates by notice to Borrower. Any notice provided for in this security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given as provided in this paragraph.

14. Governing Law; Severability. This Security Instrumentshall be governed by Federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrumentor the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrumentor the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrumentand the Note are declared to be severable.

15. Borrower's Copy. Borrowershall be given one conformed copy of this Security Instrument.

16. Assignment of Rents. Borrower unconditionally assigns and transfers to Lender all the rents and revenues of the Property. Borrower authorizes Lender or Lender's agents to collect the rents and revenues and hereby directs each tenant of the Property to pay the rents to Lender or Lender's agents. However, prior to Lender's notice to Borrower of Borrower's breach of any covenant or agreement in the Security Instrument, Borrower shall collect and receive all rents and revenues of the Property as trustee for the benefit of Lender and Borrower. This assignment of rents constitutes an absolute assignment and not an assignment for additional security only.

If Lendergives notice of breach to Borrower: (a) all rents received by Borrowershall be held by Borroweras trustee for benefit of Lenderonly, to be applied to the sums secured by the Security Instrument; (b) Lendershall be entitled to collect and receive all of the rents of the Property; and (c) each tenant of the Property shall pay all rents due and unpaid to Lenderor Lender's agent on Lender's written demand to the tenant.

Borrower has not executed any prior assignment of the rents and has not and will not perform any act that would prevent Lender from exercising its rights under this Paragraph 16.

Lender shall not be required to enter upon, take control of or maintain the Property before or after giving notice of breach to Borrower. However, Lender or a judicially appointed receiver may do so at any time there is a breach. Any application of rents shall not cure or waive any default or invalidate any other right or remedy of Lender. This assignment of rents of the Property shall terminate when the debt secured by the Security Instruments paid in full.
