Mortgagor, on behalf of himself and each and every person claiming by, through, or under the Mortgagor, hereby waives any and all rights to redemption, statutory or otherwise, without prejudice to Mortgagee's right to any remedy, legal or equitable which Mortgagee may pursue to enforce payment or to effect collection of all or any part of the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage, and without prejudice of Mortgagee's right to a deficiency judgment or any other appropriate relief in the event of foreclosure of this Mortgage.

Together with and including all buildings, all fixtures including but not limited to all plumbing, heating, lighting, ventilating, refrigerating, insulating, air conditioning apparatus, and elevators (the mortgagor hereby declaring that it is intended that the items herein enumerated shall be deemed to have been permanently installed as part of the realty), and all improvements now or hereafter existing thereon; the hereditaments and appurtenances and all other rights thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining; and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, all rights of redemption, and the rents, issues, and profits of the above described property (provided, however, that the mortgagor shall be entitled to the possession of said property, and to collect and retain the rents, issues and profits until default hereunder). To have and to hold the same unto the mortgagee and the successors in interest of the mortgagee forever in fee simple or such other estate, if any, as is stated herein, free from all rights and benefit under and by virtue of the homestead exemption laws.

All awards of damages in connection with any condemnation for public use of or injury to any of the property subject to this mortgage are hereby satisfied and shall be paid to mortgagor, who may apply the same to payment of the installments set due under said note, and mortgagor is hereby authorized, in the name of this mortgagor, to execute and deliver valid assignments thereof and to appeal from any such award.

"The will not rent or lease any part of the real estate of said mortgaged property or demerit, or remove, or abandonally after any building without the written consent of the mortgagor.

As we will not voluntarily create or permit to be created any paper subject to the mortgage
any lien or charge inferior or superior to the lien of this paper without written consent of the mortgagor
and trustee, he will keep and maintain the same free from the claim of all persons supplying labor or
material for construction of any and all buildings or improvements now being erected or to be erected on
said premises.

8. The will keep all buildings and other improvements on said property in good repair and condition; will permit, committ, or suffer no waste, impairment, deterioration or said property or any part thereof; will keep the buildings, structures, and other improvements in good repair and condition;

1. The main purpose of communication and agrees as follows:

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3. The mortgagor covenants and agrees that if he shall fail to pay said Indebtedness or any part thereof when due, or shall fail to perform any covenant or agreement of this instrument or the promissory note secured hereby, the entire Indebtedness hereby secured shall immediately become due, payable, and collectible without notice, at the option of the mortgagee or assignee, regardless of maturity, and the mortgagee or his assigns may before or after entry sell said property without appraisalment (the mortgagor having waived and assigned to the mortgagee all rights of appraisalment).

- (iii) at judicial sale pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. 2001(a); or

(ii) at the option of the mortgagor, either by auction or by solicitation of sealed bids, for the highest and best bid complying with the terms of sale and manner of payment specified in the published notice of sale, first giving four weeks' notice of the time, terms, and place of such sale, by advertisement not less than once during each of said four weeks in a newspaper published or distributed in the county in which said property is situated, all other notice being hereby waived by the mortgagor (and said mortgagee, or any person on behalf of said mortgagee, may bid with the unpaid indebtedness evidenced by said note). Said sale shall be held at or on the property to be sold or at the Federal, county, or city courthouse for the county in which the property is located. The mortgagor is hereby authorized to execute for and on behalf of the mortgagor and to deliver to the purchaser at such sale a sufficient conveyance of said property, which conveyance shall contain recitals as to the happening of the default upon which the execution of the power of sale herein granted depends; and the said mortgagor hereby constitutes and appoints the mortgagee or any agent or attorney of the mortgagee, the agent and attorney in fact of said mortgagor to make such recitals and to execute said conveyance and hereby covenants and agrees that the recitals so made shall be effectual to bar all equity or right of redemption, homestead, lower, and all other exemptions of the mortgagor, all of which are hereby expressly waived and, conveyed to the mortgagee; or

- (iii) take any other appropriate action pursuant to state or Federal statute either in state or Federal court or otherwise for the disposition of the property.

In the event of a sale as hereinabove provided in or by mortgagor or any person in possession under the mortgagor shall then become and be tenants holding over and shall forthwith deliver possession to the purchaser at such sale or be summarily dispossessed, in accordance with the provisions of law applicable to tenants holding over. The power and agency hereby granted are coupled with an interest and are irrevocable by death or otherwise, and are granted as cumulative to the remedies for collection of said indebtedness provided by law.

4. The proceeds of any sale of said property in accordance with the preceding paragraphs shall be applied first to pay the costs and expenses of said sale, the expenses incurred by the mortgagee for the purpose of protecting or maintaining said property, and reasonable attorneys' fees; secondly, to pay the indebtedness secured hereby; and thirdly, to pay any surplus or excess to the person or persons legally entitled thereto.

S. In the event said property is sold at a judicial foreclosure sale or pursuant to the power of sale hereinabove granted, and the proceeds are not sufficient to pay the total indebtedness secured by this instrument and evidenced by said promissory note, the mortgagor will be entitled to a deficiency judgment for the amount of the deficiency without regard to appraisement.

6. In the event the mortgagor fails to pay any Federal, state, or local tax assessment, income tax or other tax lien, charge, fee, or other expense charged against the property, the mortgagee is hereby authorized at his option to pay the same. Any sum so paid by the mortgagee shall be added to and become a part of the principal amount of the indebtedness evidenced by said note, subject to the same terms and conditions. If the mortgagor shall pay and discharge the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note, and shall pay such sums and shall discharge all taxes and liens and the costs, fees, and expenses of making, enforcing, and executing this mortgage, then this mortgage shall be canceled and surrendered.

7. The covenants herein contained shall bind and the benefits and advantages shall inure to the respective successors and assigns of the parties hereto. Whenever used, the singular number shall include the plural, the plural the singular, and the use of any gender shall include all genders.


8. No waiver of any covenant herein or of the obligation secured hereby shall at any time thereafter be held to be a waiver of the terms hereof or of the note secured hereby.


