## ILLINOIS STATUTORY SHORT FORM POWER OF ATTORNEY FOR PROPERTY

(NOTICE: THE PURPOSE OF THIS POWER OF ATTORNEY IS TO GIVE THE PERSON YOU DESIGNATE (YOUR "AGENT") BROAD POWERS TO HANDLE YOUR PROPERTY, WHICH MAY INCLUDE POWERS TO PLEDGE, SELL OR OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF ANY REAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHOUT ADVANCE NOTICE TO YOU OR APPROVAL BY YOU. THIS FORM DOES NOT IMPOSE A DUTY ON YOUR AGENT TO EXERCISE GRANTED POWERS, BUT WHEN POWERS ARE EXERCISED, YOUR AGENT WILL HAVE TO USE DUE CARE TO ACT FOR YOUR BENEFIT AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS FORM AND KEEP A RECORD OF RECEIPTS, DISBURSEMENTS AND SIGNIFICANT ACTIONS TAKEN AS AGENT. 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

**Section 3-4 of the Illinois Statutory Short Form  
Power of Attorney for Property Law**

**Section 3-4: Explanation of powers granted in the statutory short form power of attorney for property.** This section defines each category of powers listed in the statutory short form power of attorney for property and the effect of granting powers to an agent. When the title of any of the following categories is retained (not struck out) in a statutory property power form, the effect will be to grant the agent all of the principal's rights, powers and discretions with respect to the types of property and transactions covered by the retained category, subject to any limitations on the granted powers that appear on the face of the form. The agent will have authority to exercise each granted power for and in the name of the principal with respect to all of the principal's interests in every type of property or transaction covered by the granted power at the time of exercise, whether the principal's interests are direct or indirect, whole or fractional, legal, equitable or contractual, as a joint tenant or tenant in common or held in any other form; but the agent will not have power under any of the statutory categories (a) through (o) to make gifts of the principal's property, to exercise powers to appoint to others or to change any beneficiary whom the principal has designated to take the principal's interests at death under any will, trust, joint tenancy, beneficiary form or contractual arrangement. The agent will be under no duty to exercise granted powers or to assume control of or responsibility for the principal's property or affairs; but when granted powers are exercised, the agent will be required to use due care to act for the benefit of the principal in accordance with the terms of the statutory property power and will be liable for negligent exercise. The agent may act in person or through others reasonably employed by the agent for that purpose and will have authority to sign and deliver all instruments, negotiate and enter into all agreements and do all other acts reasonably necessary to implement the exercise of the powers granted to the agent.

(a) **Real estate transactions.** The agent is authorized to: buy, sell, exchange, rent and lease real estate (which term includes, without limitation, real estate subject to a land trust and all beneficial interests in and powers of direction under any land trust); collect all rent, sale proceeds and earnings from real estate; convey, assign and accept title to real estate; grant easements, create conditions and release rights of homestead with respect to real estate; create lend trusts and exercise all powers under land trusts; hold, possess, maintain, repair, improve, subdivide, manage, operate and insure real estate; pay, contest, protest and compromise real estate taxes and assessments; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to real estate which the principal could if present and under no disability.

(b) **Financial institution transactions.** The agent is authorized to: open, close, continue and control all accounts and deposits in any type of financial institution (which term includes, without limitation, banks, trust companies, savings and building and loan associations, credit unions and brokerage firms); deposit in and withdraw from and write checks on any financial institution account or deposit; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to financial institution transactions which the principal could if present and under no disability.

(c) **Stock and bond transactions.** The agent is authorized to: buy and sell all types of securities (which term includes, without limitation, stocks, bonds, mutual funds and all other types of investment securities and financial instruments); collect, hold and safekeep all dividends, interest, earnings, proceeds of sale, distributions, shares, certificates and other evidences of ownership paid or distributed with respect to securities; exercise all voting rights with respect to securities in person or by proxy; enter into voting trusts and consent to limitations on the right to vote; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to securities which the principal could if present and under no disability.

(f) **All other property powers and transactions.** The agent is authorized to: exercise all possible powers of the principal; which is expected to utilize possible types of property and interests in property, except to the extent the principal limits the generality of this category (a) by striking out one or more of categories (a) through (n) or by specifying other limitations in the statutory property power form.

(g) **Refrainment plan transactions.** The agent is authorized to: open, continue and deposit funds in any type of retirement plan or individualized pension, profit sharing, stock bonus, employee savings and other retirement plan, individual retirement account, without limitation, to contribute all powers with respect to retirement plans and individual retirement plans or individual retirement accounts; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to safe deposit boxes, sign, renew, terminate or otherwise deal with any type of insurance or annuity contracts which the principal could if present and under no disability.

(h) **Safe deposit box transactions.** The agent is authorized to: open, continue and deposit funds in safe deposit boxes, sign, renew, terminate or otherwise deal with any type of insurance or annuity contracts which the principal could if present and under no disability.

(i) **Business operations.** The agent is authorized to: organize or conduct any business, which may include, without limitation, borrowing which the principal could if present and under no disability; for such purposes, sign, renew, extend, expand, amend, modify and satisfy any notes or other forms of obligation; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to securities and derivatives, buy, sell, expand, contract, terminate or liquidate any business; direct, control, supervise, manage or participate in the administration of any business and engage, compensate, service, manage, retain or other legally separate, buy, sell, expand, contract, terminate or liquidate any farm, whether as a proprietorship, joint venture, partnership, corporation, limited liability company, partnership, corporation, trust or other entity; call and put options on stocks and stock indexes traded on a regulated options exchange and to sell and receive for all such transactions, establish commodity futures contracts and options and accounts for the principal which the principal could if present and under no disability.

(j) **Cameo duty and option transactions.** The agent is authorized to: call and receive exchange of call options or contracts of continuing value for any property interests of the principal; collect and receive for any claim or settlement proceeds and waive or release all rights of the principal; employ agency, the principal or any other contractor, and enter into continuing agreements necessary in connection with litigation; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to options and accounts of any type of business managed, employees, officers, agents, contractors, partners, shareholders, companies, affiliates, settle and dispose of any claim in favor of or against the principal or any other contractor, and sign all documents or instruments necessary to carry out any of the foregoing.

(k) **Claims and litigation.** The agent is authorized to: sue, defend, prosecute, defend, abandon, compromise, arbitrate, settle and dispose of any claim in favor of or against the principal or any other contractor, and file or defend, collect, receive and sign all documents or instruments necessary to carry out any of the foregoing.

(l) **Tax matters.** The agent is authorized to: sign, verify and file all the principal could if present and under no disability, with respect to tax matters which the principal could if present and under no disability, for such purposes; waive rights and sign all documents and instruments which the principal could if present and under no disability; for the principal before any federal, state or local court, referee, commission or taxing body and sign and deliver all tax powers of attorney on behalf of the principal that may be necessary to settle, pay and determine all tax liabilities; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to tax matters which the principal could if present and under no disability.

(m) **Social security, unemployment service benefits.** The agent is authorized to: prepare, sign and file any claim or application for social security, the principal could if present and under no disability, for any benefit or service under any federal, state, local or foreign statute or regulation; collect, defend, prosecute, defend, abandon, compromise, arbitrate, settle and dispose of any claim or benefit or service under any federal, state, local or foreign statute or regulation, and to do all acts necessary to carry out any of the foregoing.

(n) **Retirement plan transactions.** The agent is authorized to: contribute all powers with respect to retirement plans and individual retirement plans or individual retirement accounts; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to other retirement plans or individual retirement accounts; select and change payment options for the principal under any retirement plan, make rollover contributions to another plan and any other type of employee benefit plan; employee savings and other retirement plan, individual retirement account, without limitation, to contribute all powers with respect to retirement plans and individual retirement accounts which the principal could if present and under no disability.

(o) **Insurance and annuity transactions.** The agent is authorized to: procure or bind individual life insurance, annuity contracts, group life insurance or liability insurance; pay premiums or assessments, premiums, contributions, fees, dividends, interest, disability, automatic life insurance, renew, terminate or otherwise deal with any type of insurance or annuity contracts which the principal could if present and under no disability.

(p) **Safe deposit box transactions.** The agent is authorized to: open, continue and have access to all safe deposit boxes, sign, renew, terminate or otherwise deal with any type of insurance or annuity contracts which the principal could if present and under no disability.
