you and each of you are hereby notified that the Village of Roselle, is considering the annexation of the property hereinafter described pursuant to the provisions of Article 7, Division 1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (Chapter 24 Illinois Revised Statutes) and that such annexation will be discussed at a public hearing on February 21, 1994 at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees at the Roselle Fire Station, 100 E. Maple Avenue, Roselle, Illinois at 7:30 p.m.

That part of the North 780 feet (measured on the West line thereof, the South line being parallel with the North line) lying East of the East line of the West 1120 feet (measured at right angles to said West line) of the East half of the Southeast quarter of Section 34, also the West 78 feet (measured at right angles to the West line thereof) of the North 780 feet (measured on said West line, the South line being parallel with the North line) of the West half of the Southwest quarter of Section 35, all in Township 41 North, Range 10, East of the Third Principal Meridian, Cook County, Illinois; and

The North 780 feet (measured on the West line thereof, the South line being parallel with the North line, except the West 78 feet thereof measured at right angles to said West line, and except the North 50 feet thereof) of that part of the West half of the Southwest quarter lying West of the West line of the East 60 acres of said West half of the Southwest quarter of Section 35, Township 41 North, Range 10, East of the Third Principal Meridian, described as follows: commencing at a point of the North side of said West half of the Southwest quarter of Section 35, 258 feet East of the

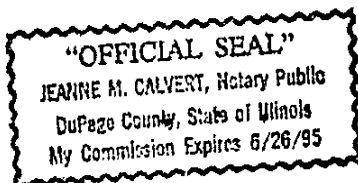
