Section 3-4. Explanation of powers granted in the statutory short form power of attorney for property. This Section defines each category of powers listed in the statutory short form power of attorney for property and the effect of granting powers to an agent. When the title of any of the following categories is retained (not struck out) in a statutory properly power form, the effect will be to grant the agent all of the principal's rights, powers and discretions with respirat to the types of property and transactions covered by the retained category, subject to any luminations on the granted powers that appear on the face of the form. The age will have outhority to exercise each granted power for and in the name of the principal with respect to all of the principal's interests in every type of property or transaction colleted by the granted power all the time of exercise, whether the principal's interests are direct or indirect, whole or fractional, legal, equitable or contractual, as a joint renam or lawrib in common or held in any other form; but the agent will not have power under any of the statutory categories (a) through (b) to make gifts of the principal's property.
