TOGETHER WITH all the improvements now or hereafter erected on the property, and all easements, appurtenances, and fixtures now or hereafter a part of the property. All replacements and additions shall also be covered by this Security Instrument. All of the foregoing is referred to in this Security Instrument as the "Property."

BORROWER COVENANTS that Borrower is lawfully select of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to mortgage, grant and convey the Property and that the Property is unencumbered, except for encumbrances of record. - 1. Payment of Principal and Interest; Prepayment and Late Charges. Borrower shall promptly pay when due the principal of and interest on the debt evidenced by the Note and any prepayment and late charges due under the Note.
- 2. Funds for Trices and Insurance. Lender may estimate the amount of Funds due on the bosis of current data and reasonable estimates of expenditures of future Eacrow Items or otherwise in accordance with applicable law.

The Funds shall be held in an institution whose deposits for insured by a federal agency, instrumentality, or entity (including Lender, if Lender is such an institution) or in any Federal forme Loan Bank. Lender shall apply the Funds to pay the Escriw Items. il. Borrower Not Released; Forhearance By Lender Not a Waiver. Extension of the time for payment or modification of amortization of the sums secured by thix Security Instrument granted by Lender to any successor in interest of Borrower shall not operate to release the liability of the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest. 13. Loan Charges. Borrower hereby represents and agrees that (1) Borrower has not executed any prior assignment of the Rents; (2) Borrower has not performed, and shall not perform any acts which would prevent Lender from exercising its rights inder this Section; and (3) no Rents have been prepaid for more than two months prior to the due dates of such Rents. Borrower shall not becreated collect or accept payments of any Rents (note than two months prior to the due dates of such Rents. Borrower further agrees to execute and deliver to Lender such further assignments of more and revenues of the Property as Lender may from time to time request.

Upon an event of default, the Lender, Lender's agem, or receiver, as applicable, shall be entitled to perform all acts necessary and appropriate for the operation and maintenance of the Property including, but not limited to, the execution, cancellation or modification of leases, the collection of all Rents of the Property, the making of repairs to the Property and the execution or termination of contracts providing for the management or maintenance of the Property, all on such terms as are decined best to protect the security of the Security Instrument Lender or the receiver shall be entitled to receive a reasonable fee for so managing the Property.

All Rents collected subsequent to delivery of written notice by Lender to Borrower of Borrower's default under the Security Instrument shall be applied first to the costs, if any, of taking control of and managing the Property and collecting the Rents, including, but not limited to, attorneys' fees, receiver's fees, premiums on receiver's bonds, costs of repairs to the Property, premiums on insurance policies, taxes, assessments and other charges on the Property, and the costs of discharging any obligation or liability of Borrower as lessor or landlord of the Property and then to the sums secured by this Instrument. Any entering upon and taking and maintaining of control of the Property by Lender. Lender's agent of the receiver and any application of Rents as provided herein shall not cure or waive any default hereunder or invalidate any other right or remedy of Lender under applicable law or provided herein. This assignment of Rents of the Property shall terminate at such time as the Security Instrument ceases to secure indebtedness held by Lender.
